zombie politics and culture in the age of casino capitalism capitalizes upon the popularity of zombies exploring the relevance of the metaphor they provide for examining the political and pedagogical conditions that have produced a growing culture of sadism cruelty disposability and death in america the zombie metaphor may seem extreme but it is particularly apt for drawing attention to the ways in which political culture and power in american society now operate on a level of mere survival this book uses the metaphor not only to suggest the symbolic face of power beginning and ending with an analysis of authoritarianism it attempts to mark and chart the visible registers of a kind of zombie politics including the emergence of right wing teaching machines a growing politics of disposability the emergence of a culture of cruelty and the ongoing war being waged on young people especially on youth of color by drawing attention to zombie politics and authoritarianism this book aims to break through the poisonous common sense that often masks zombie politicians anti public intellectuals politics institutions and social relations and bring into focus a new language pedagogy and politics in which the living dead will be moved decisively to the margins rather than occupying the very center of politics and everyday life

the decades that followed independence from spain in 1821 transformed mexico from a strong stable colony to a republic suffering from economic decline political turmoil regional divisions and class hatred this chaotic state hindered efforts of the young republic to meet the aggressive expansionism of the united states between 1845 and 1848 pedro santoni sheds new light on mexican political history during the conflict a much neglected subject through a comprehensive examination of the only mexican political bloc that wanted war with the united states led by valentin gomez farias this faction was the radical federalists who in 1846 took the name of puros santoni demonstrates the reasons for the failure of the puros efforts to gain political power and coordinate the war effort examining the puros attempts to reestablish federalism in mexico shape public opinion develop a civic militia and forge alliances with senior army officers and opposing political groups santoni maintains that the economic social and political troubles of mexico nullified the puros endeavors to direct armed resistance against the americans he also dispels some of the erroneous notions that the puros and gomez farias were self serving and corrupt and sold out mexico to the united states for example that have been propagated by historians in the past

this set reissues ten books that explore the history of crime and punishment the titles which were originally published between 1970 and 1988 examine many different aspects of historical criminology over a span of over 400 years with particular focus on the nineteenth century this set will be of particular interest to students of both history and criminology

liberal and conservative protestant based volunteering and advocacy projects in a mid sized american city he listened as these groups tried to create bridges with other community groups social service agencies and low income people just as the 1996 welfare reforms were taking effect counter to long standing arguments lichterman discovered that powerful customs of interaction inside the groups often stunted external ties and even shaped religion s impact on the groups comparing groups he found that successful bridges outward depend on group customs which invite reflective critical discussion about a group s place amid surrounding groups and institutions combining insights from alexis de toqueville john dewey and jane addams with contemporary sociology elusive togetherness addresses enduring questions about civic and religious life that elude the popular social capital concept to create broad civic relationships groups need more than the right religious values political beliefs or resources they must learn new ways of being groups

this topical book sheds light on immigrants subjective well being by analysing the main factors associated with self reported life satisfaction among immigrants and natives it thereby draws upon subjective components of well being which are now receiving growing attention in well being research it also fills in a gap in migration research which has not yet focused on the study of immigrants well being starting from a broader focus on europe the book then looks more closely at italy this is a key country in the immigration policy field in europe but where the study of immigrants integration from a subjective perspective has been rarely addressed so far the book provides suggestions for constructing and implementing immigration and integration policies by not only taking into account the needs of the host societies but also the experiences opinions requirements and expectations of immigrants this book is very useful for academic and policy researchers working on immigrant integration issues
