i was born in paris france at 3 00 pm on september 6th 1939 to a french father and a russian mother only six days after hitler s nazis invaded poland within six 6 months my parents travel to shanghai china where my mother believe it or not has just accepted a position with macy s department store this trip to china sets the stage for me now just one year old to be taken again by my parents to travel this time to kobe japan in 1940 to be introduced to my new grandparents so begins my adventure as my parents spend a month in kobe and then return to shanghai in order to put their affairs in order before returning to japan to join me her parents and my grandparents then the pearl harbor attack takes place and they find themselves stranded in china while i m stranded in japan with my grandparents who are in their mid sixties now with the responsibility of taking care of their one 1 year old grandson i can only imagine what their thoughts were as they considered what lay ahead this book charts my experiences close calls and adventures for the next ten 10 years while living in war torn and post war japan i have also been blessed with a vivid memory making it possible for me to relive many of my early experiences to the point that the more i wrote the more details i remembered my research has been limited to checking spelling and certain geographic facts and i m writing this book as seen through the eyes of a ten 10 year old although i m now in my mid sixties nevertheless i have tried to be as accurate as possible and stand by this narrative

a dying race is the account of my life some of my abductions were traumatic and still haunt me to this day i can only relay some of the message i received i don t know why i was selected but i can guarantee you we are not alone my story begins as a young hispanic boy trying to overcome racism i was born in 1971 and had some speech and learning disabilities my father fell in love with my mother when they first met in a small church in frederick colorado my mother was teaching sunday school my father was one of her students he was twelve years old and she was seventeen when my father told the story he would always say i told the other students that someday i d marry her on his fifteenth birthday my father proposed to my mother who was one of fourteen children in an abusive home money was always tight in our own large family but there was plenty of love my epiphany came years later i replied it s about thirty feet above your van it quickly shined a beam of light on the top of the van just for an instant then quickly flew away our phones disconnected in the middle of all the excitement so i quickly called him back did you see it shoot off he replied what i continued after our phones disconnected a beam of light came down on the top of the van didn t you see it writing this book has been therapeutic and an attempt to put this in my past so i can move on

i ve read and studied the history of slavery most of my life i know that there are many who would like to know more about the history of slavery the inhuman treatment of a people kept in bondage writing this book i feel will give those who want to know more like the younger generation regardless of their ethnic background to know and understand what slavery was about growing up in the south in the civil rights era i have experienced first hand the cruelty of one human being to another as a child i heard the many stories of slavery from my grandparents who learned from their parents about slaves in america this part of history was not taught in schools but my novel although a fiction tells the true story of a people that lived in human bondage

there is no available information at this time

louisiana is the bayou state a state that seems to have experienced more than its share of storms in recent years the story is set in the 1950s those were the years they were my years my world my generation the life and legends of louisiana bayou country come alive in this historical fiction fantasy the cast of characters alone make for action packed adventure and thrilling entertainment

fans of the alaskan classic one man s wilderness will enjoy reading this memoir of how its author sam keith and its subject dick proenneke first met after serving as a us marine during world war ii and attending college on the gi bill sam keith decided to seek adventure and acceptance in alaska he arrived on kodiak island in july 1952 where he secured a job as a laborer on the adak navy base he befriended a group of like minded men there including dick proenneke who shared a love of the outdoors hard work and self reliance keith explored the wilds of south central alaska while working on the navy base and later as a stream guard and enforcement patrolman in his hunting and fishing trips with dick and his friends keith found almost everything he sought but at the end of three years keith decided to go outside to pursue other dreams dick proenneke tells him sam you know right well you don t want to leave this country don t give up on it me and you got to figure something out in 1973 keith went on to write one man s wilderness an alaskan odyssey based on his dear friend s journals and photography it was reissued in 1999 and won a national outdoor book award noba in 2003 portions of text from the book and some of proenneke s 16mm movies were used in alone in the wilderness which began appearing on us public television stations the documentary follows proenneke as he builds a log cabin with only hand tools and includes reflections on wildlife weather and the natural scenery he sees around him sam keith passed away in 2003 but in 2013 his son in law children s book author illustrator brian lies discovered in an archive box in their garage a book manuscript originally written in 1974 after the publication of one man s wilderness first wilderness is the story of keith s own experiences at times harrowing funny and fascinating along with the original manuscript are photos and excerpts from his journals letters and notebooks woven in to create a compelling and poignant memoir of search and discovery
