die herrschaft von königinnen gehört aktuell zu den am stärksten diskutierten mediävistischen forschungsfeldern gleichwohl können in diesem themenfeld aufgrund der oft sehr lückenhaften quellenlage oft nur hypothetische ergebnisse gewonnen werden die vorliegende studie gestattet hingegen aufgrund einer breiten quellenbasis empirisch gesicherte aussagen zur regionalen herrschaft in der krone aragón zu tätigen als fallbeispiel dafür dient eleonore von sizilien als gemahlin peters iv königin in der krone aragón 1349 1375 ihre handlungsspielräume werden sowohl in ihrem wirken als consors ihres gemahls als auch als dessen statthalterin untersucht einen besonders wichtigen aspekt dafür stellt die koordination der regierung zwischen den beiden monarchen dar die sich anhand ihrer korrespondenz detailliert herausarbeiten lässt darüber hinaus werden die sozialen verbindungen mit den führenden gruppen der krone aragón untersucht durch die untersuchung dieser verschiedenen felder kann gezeigt werden dass die herrschaftsausübung der königin für die monarchie essentiell ist damit lassen sich die rolle der herrscherin als politische akteurin sowie das verständnis der monarchie als vielgliedrige regierungsform besser konturieren

der spanische nationalstolz hat durch die herausforderung der erstarkten katalanischen unabhängigkeitsbewegung und das problematische verhältnis des baskenlandes und galiciens zum zentralstaat einen neuen impuls erhalten rechtsradikale tendenzen etwa durch die partei vox aber auch die von prominenten intellektuellen und politikern vertretenen position dass es einen spanischen nationalismus überhaupt nicht gibt prägen die gesellschaftliche auseinandersetzung xosé m núñez seixas skizziert die historische entwicklung spaniens vom verlust der einstigen gröÙe über den blutigen bürgerkrieg und die diktatur francos bis zu den nationalistischen und patriotischen diskursen im europäischen kontext er untersucht den spanischen staatsnationalismus ebenso wie die politischen konzepte des patriotismus und nationalismus und nähert sich so der frage was es heute bedeutet spanier zu sein

religion and politics have historically clashed in modern spain but the complexity of the controversial and sometimes violent relationships between catholic values and modern political regimes continue to ride a precarious line of spiritual accommodation versus public policy leading experts on religious spanish tradition and recent historiographic findings set out to define and interrogate grey areas in the last two centuries beyond the

reductive conventional notion of an ever warring two spains the soul of the nation unravels the role of religion in the country s public life following the imperial crisis of 1808 when the catholic monarchy put the role of the church at heart of political and cultural debates

argentine cinema and national identity covers the development of argentine cinema since the late 1950s to the mid 1970s concentrating on the historical film genre and the gauchesque this cultural history investigates the way argentine cinema positioned itself when facing the competition of american films

the public authorities have not successfully resolved the management of the traumatic memory of the wars dictatorships and massacres to which the european project was always intended to be a counterpoint the conflict of memories and the public discourses about the past are latent on ideological political and cultural levels however if in the past the conflict concerning memories tended to develop inside the borders of countries it has now leapt into the european arena this has also led to the confrontation and questioning of the great narratives established in the common memory especially with countries of the east joining the european union each community group or nation maintains common memories that do not always fit in or converge with a general overall account the origins of the ub solidarity foundation s european observatory on memories lie in these debates and through this book which includes the contributions of specialists in multiple disciplines and the speeches that were given at the first international symposium memory and power a transnational perspective it hopes to present some of the key challenges that this conflict of memories has in store for us in the present and in the future

reclaiming al andalus focuses on the construction of the scholarly discipline of orientalist studies in spain special attention is paid to the impact that the elaboration of a series of historical interpretations of the legacy left by muslim and jewish culture in spain had over the writing of national history in the period of the bourbon restoration a historiographical

account of spains orientalism tackles the problematized issues that both arabist and hebraist scholars sought to address orientalist scholarship thereby became inextricably linked to different interpretations of the historical shaping of spanish national identity political circumstances of the day impacted on the approach these scholars took as they engaged with the iberian semitic past and this at a critical moment in the crystallization of modern spanish nationalism a common thread running through the work of these orientalist scholars was the tendency to nationalize or hispanicize cultural activity of the semitic populations that lived on the iberian peninsula in medieval times this hispanization was instrumentalized in diverse ways in order to serve nation building efforts hence orientalist scholarship became integrated into the national debates that were shaping spanish cultural and political life at the turn of the century reclaiming al andalus explains how regenerationist projects taking form after the national crisis of 1898 and different polemical discussions around religion state affairs deeply influenced the writings of academic orientalism the intertwined connection between orientalist scholarship and nationalist debates in spain has hitherto been understudied this book not only contributes to the general debate on modern orientalism but most importantly presents a profound new viewpoint to the ongoing debate on the conflictive history of spanish nationalism

the aspiration of an atlas is to cover the whole world by compiling cartographical material representing territories from across the five continents this book intends to contribute to that ideally comprehensive yet always unfinished atlas with pieces gathered from all of the earth s regions however its focus is not so much of a geographical nature although maps and geographical reflections are not absent in its pages but of a historical analytical one as such the atlas engages in the historical analysis of interpreters of both language and cultures in multiple interpreting settings and places including in zones which are less frequently studied in specialized literature in different historical periods and at various scales all the interpreters described in the book share the ability to speak two or more languages and to use them as vehicles otherwise their individual socio professional

statuses vary so much that there is no similarity between a venetian dragoman in istanbul and a prisoner of war or between a locally recruited interpreter and a missionary each contributor has approached the specific spatial and temporal dimensions of their subject as perceived through their different methodological lenses this multifaceted perspective which is expected to provide fertile soil for future interdisciplinary research has been possible thanks to a balanced combination of scholars from history and from translation and interpreting studies

archaeology is intimately connected to the modern regime of vision a concern with optics was fundamental to the scientific revolution and informed the moral theories of the enlightenment and from its inception archaeology was concerned with practices of depiction and classification that were profoundly scopic in character drawing on both the visual arts and the depictive practices of the sciences employing conventionalised forms of illustration photography and spatial technologies archaeology presents a paradigm of visualised knowledge however a number of thinkers from jean paul sartre onwards have cautioned that vision presents at once a partial and a politicised way of apprehending the world in this volume authors from archaeology and other disciplines address the problems that face the study of the past in an era in which realist modes of representation and the

philosophies in which they are grounded in are increasingly open to question

history on film film on history has established itself as a classic treatise on the historical film and its role in bringing the past to life in the fourth edition of this widely acclaimed text robert a rosenstone argues that to leave history films out of the discussion of the meaning of the past is to ignore a major means of understanding historical events this book examines what history films convey about the past and how they convey it demonstrating the need to learn how to read and understand this new visual world and integrating detailed analysis of films such as schindler s list glory october and reds advocating for the dramatic feature as a legitimate way of doing history this edition includes a new preface and a new chapter that focuses on films produced in latin america africa the middle east india and east asia examining the codes and conventions of how these films tell us about the past and providing guidance on how to effectively analyse films as historical interpretations this book is an essential introduction to the field for students of history and film

seeing in spanish brings together 22 chapters which share a focus on aspects of visual cultures from the spanish speaking world together these chapters address film photography cover art body art posters television architecture ekphrasis biography murals graffiti and digital photo montage between don quixote and daddy yankee the essays move from the seventeenth century to the present and traverse europe the americas and cyberspace the book is divided into five sections the first of these on spain includes chapters on the representation of women on lp covers in spain in the 60s and 70s portrayals in spanish cinema of saint teresa luis buñuel s adaptation of tristana urban and rural space in recent spanish documentary film catalan television fine art in don quixote and visions of adoption in three narratives by spanish writers and filmmakers the second section on mexico and peru includes chapters on the fragmentary body in images of

mexico the art of abraham Ángel jesús ruiz durand s agrarian reform posters diego rivera s murals and the role of artistic production in staging the 2006 oaxaca conflict the third section on cuba looks at the portrayal of women and of children in recent cinema from the island it also examines nancy morejón s celebration of the life and art of exiled cuban artist ana mendieta section four includes chapters on chile and argentina it addresses street art and graffiti new forms of publishing chilean cinema after pinochet and violeta parra s appliqué and collage works section five embraces colombia bolivia and virtual spaces the contributions to this last section of the book examine childhood in colombian cinema the online creativity of pro and anti fans of reggaeton and the photographic diaries of t ifor rees the uk s first ambassador to bolivia in addition to the geo political structure which underpins the book s five sections the introduction suggests pathways through the contributions focussed on public art and graffiti women children cyberspace and diplomacy and reconstruction and disintegration seeing in spanish includes 50 illustrations stills from films photographs reproductions of paintings and screen grabs from the internet which complement the chapters analyses of aspects of hispanic visual cultures to aid accessibility footnotes throughout the book provide english translations of all references from texts in other languages taken together the book s 22 chapters make a valuable contribution to the existing literature on figures like don quixote and saint teresa they also break new ground in approaches to novel areas of scholarship such as sleeve design artisanal book production and digital image manipulation the book will appeal to students and scholars of spain and latin america as well as to a general readership with an interest in the visual cultures of the spanish speaking world
