this book first published in 2004 makes a compelling case for truthmaking and its importance in philosophy

political theorists jeremy elkins and andrew norris observe that american political culture is deeply ambivalent about truth on the one hand voices on both the left and right make confident appeals to the truth of claims about the status of the market in public life and the role of scientific evidence and argument in public life human rights and even religion on the other hand there is considerable anxiety that such appeals threaten individualism and political plurality this anxiety elkins and norris contend has perhaps been greatest in the humanities and in political theory where many have responded by either rejecting or neglecting the whole topic of truth the essays in this volume question whether democratic politics requires discussion of truth and if so how truth should matter to democratic politics while individual essays approach the subject from different angles the volume as a whole suggests that the character of our politics depends in part on what kinds of truthful inquiries it promotes and how it deals with various kinds of disputes about truth the contributors to the volume including prominent political and legal theorists philosophers and intellectual historians argue that these are important political and not merely theoretical questions

our era is profoundly marked by the phenomenon of exile and it is has become increasingly urgent to rethink the concept of exile and our stance towards it this renewed reflection on the problem of exile brings to the fore a number of questions regarding the traditionally negative connotation of exile is there not another way to understand the condition of exile permeated with references to the stranger the other and exteriority the philosophy of emmanuel levinas signifies a positive understanding of exile this original and compelling book distills from levinas s philosophy a wisdom of exile for the first time shedding a positive light on the condition of exile itself abi doukhan argues that levinas s philosophy can be understood as a comprehensive philosophy of exile from his ethics to his thoughts on society love knowledge spirituality and art thereby presenting a comprehensive view of the philosophy of levinas himself as well as a renewed understanding of the wealth and contribution of exile to a given society

domesticated glory critically examines the marriage between evangelicalism and american politics the study begins by engaging popular political pundits who wish to transform christianity into an arm of the state it then moves to examine some of the theological foundations proposed as support for the church s propping up of american political ideology finally the study provides a more robust politics of the church by outlining how the church might act as a politics in itself thus the church may gain a political voice as church in such a way as to make the world know it stands in need of redemption this is a far cry from the liberal attempt of the social gospel and many modern evangelicals to transform the world into a pseudo church by cultural or social control unlike attempts to engage culture on its own terms in the political arena or to escape politics by avoiding any public testimony to the gospel this study lays out a way for the church to act as church in the public square witnessing to a gospel concerned primarily about the universe s king and his future kingdom

a collection of essays grounded in state of the art research that explores contemporary debates at the interface between literature and philosophy it brings together diverse schools of thought and provides both a useful overview and an examination of one of the most fascinating cross disciplinary encounters in the humanities today

scientific realism is the position that the aim of science is to advance on truth and increase knowledge about observable and unobservable aspects of the mind independent world which we inhabit this book articulates and defends that position in presenting a clear formulation and addressing the major arguments for scientific realism sankey appeals to philosophers beyond the community of typically anglo american analytic philosophers of science to appreciate and understand the doctrine the book emphasizes the epistemological aspects of scientific realism and contains an original solution to the problem of induction that rests on an appeal to the principle of uniformity of nature

the frankfurt school refers to the members associated with the institut fur sozialforschung institute for social research which was founded in frankfurt in 1923 the work of this group is generally agreed to have been a landmark in twentieth century social science it is of seminal importance in our understanding of culture progress politics production consumption and method this set of six volumes provides a full picture of the school by examining the important developments that have occurred since the deaths of the original core of frankfurt scholars all the major figures adorno horkheimer marcuse benjamin are represented in particular the important post war work of jurgen habermas is fully assessed the collection also covers the work of many of the minor figures associated with the school who have been unfairly neglected in the past resulting in the most complete survey and guide to the oeuvre of the frankfurt school

the twenty first century has seen violence thunder back onto the stage of history religious political social cultural and economic constituents and interests thus contribute to the local and global manifestations of violence in our interconnected and contracting global world firmly embedded within the field of religion the authors of this volume concede that religious motifs and impulses are alive and well in this unfolding of bloodshed it is no wonder then that in our volatile historical age religious fundamentalism and illiberal nationalism have emerged as dominant contemporary movements against this backdrop the contributors to this edited book look back in order to move forward by reflecting upon the truth force satyagraha that grounded and guided mohandas karamchand gandhi 1869 1948 on the heels of several commemorations in 2019 of the 150th anniversary of gandhi s birth we reexamine the truths of his philosophy and nonviolent strategy to resist religious and political fundamentalisms embracing truth was for gandhi the only way to achieve complete freedom poorna swaraj the goal of freedom which gandhi conceptualized as profoundly personal expansively communitarian and organically ecological emanates from a firm grasp of truth

are statements of fact true or only more or less useful this question is of vital importance because it cuts to the core of the nature of truth it leads to decisive choices in modern philosophy beneath the concept truth serious problems defy and resist philosophic analysis revealing and resolving them is the early focus of philosophy that works the way things are people mix up what they mean by truth and get bound up in fallacies that condemn human knowledge to seemingly pointless relativism but an adequate understanding of truth transforms philosophy and individual understanding improves thinking itself and strengthens education organizations and society showing how so much progress is possible is the business end of this book the payoff of its thoughtful investigations into truth and knowledge philosophy that works is an intellectual adventure an impassioned story about navigating philosophy from its backwaters down a great river of advancing civilization the philosopher disillusioned with academic philosophies begins an investigation into the many meanings of truth he makes a lasting discovery that changes what philosophy itself can achieve and what it can mean he faces daunting tasks but reconfigures philosophy confusion concerning truth resolves into clear understanding who should join the adventure not only philosophers this is a book for everyone who likes to think it has power narrative conviction and a soulful center that resonates through its pages from the introduction albert einstein once mentioned that humanity cannot solve its vexing problems at the same level of thought that produced the crisis a higher level of thinking will require a philosophic transformation that s what philosophy that works is all about despite postmodern skepticism a simplistic true and false outlook on reality remains the commonplace of a civilization this is the level that has produced the crisis this book describes a basic change in the dominant paradigm of the age it shows that a colossal mistake underlies the commonsense outlook an error that has prevented consensus about what is real and therefore what life can mean it penetrates the problem to its heart

no one has figured more prominently in the study of german philosopher gottlob frege than michael dummett this highly acclaimed book is a major contribution to the philosophy of language as well as a systematic interpretation of frege indisputably the father of analytic philosophy frege philosophy of language remains indispensable for an understanding of contemporary philosophy harvard university press is pleased to reissue this classic book in paperback

with 342 years of colonialism and apartheid in south africa a book of this calibre is essential to contribute to scholarly debates on the decolonisation of the media after the democratic dispensation in 1994 there was a narrow pursuit of transformation and media freedom while neglecting decolonisation patriarchal tendencies

and the plight of black women journalists who are often vilified while discharging their duties it was two decades after democracy that the rhodesmustfall movement which later evolved into feesmustfall movement reignited debates on decoloniality in the academia moreover the book is published during the second wave of feesmustfall student protests and the demand for decolonised free education is inevitable as no permanent solution to student funding crisis was crafted in the same vein the book advocates for decolonised pedagogy in universities including journalism curriculum that ownership of the media is still skewed towards white and with only few black companies gradually joining the industry also brings into doubt media freedom editorial independence ethics and integrity among media practitioners therefore the decoloniality movement seeks to confront these structural challenges head on via dialogue to ensure the integrity of the journalism profession decolonising journalism in south africa is published at a time in which journalism serves a watchdog and a critique of a democratic government and needs to follow a bottom up social justice approach and become a voice to the voiceless therefore this book seeks to revolutionise the media in a way that even the language of reporting of certain issues needs to be changed to a balanced kind of reporting characterised by principles of no fear or favour

this book offers the first genuinely systematic treatment of hegel s eschatology in the literature it is an investigation into hegel s project to demonstrate the ultimate unity of thought and being consciousness and reality self and world the author traces the project through hegel s epistemology metaphysics and philosophy of history the grand synthesis creates a basic tension an ambivalence that reaches its most acute formulation in hegel s eschatological language of a final completion or fulfillment of history this conflicts with his dialectic and heracletian metaphysics of becoming berthold bond concludes that a substantially new approach to hegel s eschatology is needed

this is the third volume of hilary putnam s philosophical papers published in paperback for the first time the volume contains his major essays from 1975 to 1982 which reveal a large shift in emphasis in the realist position developed in his earlier work while not renouncing those views professor putnam has continued to explore their epistemological consequences and conceptual history he now crucially sees theories of truth and of meaning that derive from a firm notion of reference as inadequate

this book proposes a new solution to the problem of vagueness there are several different ways of addressing this problem and no clear agreement on which one is correct the author proposes that it should be understood as the problem of explaining vague predicates in a way that systematizes six intuitions about the phenomenon and satisfies three criteria of adequacy for an ideal theory of vagueness the third criterion which is called the criterion of precisification is the most controversial one it is based on the intuition that a predicate is vague only if it is imprecise the author considers some different definitions of linguistic imprecision proposing that a predicate is imprecise if and only if there is no sharp boundary between objects to which its application yields some particular truth value and objects to which its application does not yield that truth value the volume critically reviews the current theories of vagueness and proposes a new one the theory of vagueness as arbitrariness which defines a vague predicate as an arbitrary predicate that must be precisified in order to contribute to a sentence that has truth conditions the main advantages of this theory over the current alternatives are that it satisfies all three criteria and systematizes the relevant intuitions

in this newest book the author presents a theory of art which is at once universal in its general conception and historically grounded in its attention to aesthetic practices in diverse cultures the author argues that especially today art not only enjoys a special kind of autonomy but also has important social and political responsibilities deutsch posits that an art work has as its intentionality the striving to be aesthetically forceful meaningful and beautiful with each of these dimensions culturally situated working from traditional imitation and expression theories he argues that the manner of an artwork s coming into being and one s experience of it constitutes an integral whole selected aspects of painting poetry dance architecture films and music are offered to deepen an understanding of the concepts presented also included are several inter connected themes focusing on the difficult and controversial issues of interpreting art truth in art and the relations between art and morality and art and religion

leading scholars discuss donald davidson s work in relation to a wide range of contemporary philosophical issues and approaches the work of the philosopher donald davidson 1917 2003 is not only wide ranging in its influence and vision but also in the breadth of issues that it encompasses davidson s work includes seminal contributions to philosophy of language and mind to philosophy of action and to epistemology and metaphysics in dialogues with davidson leading scholars engage with davidson s work as it connects not only with aspects of current analytic thinking but also with a wider set of perspectives including those of hermeneutics phenomenology the history of philosophy feminist epistemology and contemporary social theory they link davidson s work to other thinkers including collingwood kant derrida heidegger and gadamer the essays demonstrate the continuing significance of davidson s philosophy not only in terms of the philosophical relevance of the ideas he advanced but also in the further connections and insights those ideas engender

using the thomist notion of wisdom as a key for interpretation coelho traces the flowering of the universal viewpoint into a mature theological method one that holds out the hope of an effective transcultural mediation of meanings and values
