that are often overlooked examines each sonata in turn addressing questions such as why were they written why did they turn out as they did how did they come into being and how did they reach their final form drawing on the composer's sketches autograph scores and early printed editions as well as contextual material such as correspondence cooper explores the links between the notes and symbols found in the musical texts of the sonatas and the environment that brought them about the result is a biography not of the composer but of the works themselves
