an environmental history of the world is a concise history from ancient to modern times of the interaction between human societies and the other forms of life that inhabit our planet this original work follows a chronological path through the history of mankind in relationship to ecosystems around the world each chapter concentrates on a general period in human history which has been characterised by large scale changes in the relationship of human societies to the biosphere and gives three case studies that illustrate the significant patterns occurring at that time little environmental or historical knowledge is assumed from the reader in this introduction to environmental history

from the outset society in Japan has been shaped by its environmental context the lush green mountainous archipelago of today with its highly productive lowlands supports a population of more than 127 million people and one of the most advanced economies in the world how has this come about and at what environmental cost

conrad totman one of the world's foremost scholars on japanese here provides a comprehensive and detailed account of the country's environmental history from its beginnings to the present day professor totman traces the country's development through successive historical phases as early agricultural society based on non intensive forms of cultivation gave way to more intensified forms with each stage came greater utilisation of natural resources but a steady reduction in the richness of the indigenous biosystem by the late seventeenth century the country was well on the way to ecological disaster yet japan's isolation in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries led to an unusually enlightened set of environmental policies and the system of regenerative forestry brought in during the tokugawa period prevented certain devastation of the country's forests at the end of the nineteenth century however the country began to go to the opposite extreme as industrialisation brought with it a period of unprecedented change growth and diversification led to a surge in environmental pollution as it became necessary to look beyond the country's domestic natural resources to meet the demand for foodstuffs fossil fuels and the raw materials necessary to an advanced industrial economy the population was particularly badly affected and some of the problems that emerged especially from the 1960s onwards provided important test cases not just for japan but worldwide what makes the japanese story particularly instructive is that the country's boundaries are uncommonly clear and the nature timing and extent of external influences on its history are unusually identifiable the japanese experience therefore not only yields important insights into the processes of environmental history it offers important lessons for the wider environmental history of the planet and for our understanding of current global ecological problems a work of immense erudition and reflecting a lifetime of scholarship japan an environmental history will be welcomed by all with an interest in environmental history and the historical development of japan

efforts to protect rainforests to help us better understand current issues and debates surrounding their conservation and use while interest in rainforests and the movement for their conservation are often mistakenly portrayed as features of the last few decades the debate over human usage of rainforests stretches well back into the nineteenth century in the modern world rainforests are generally considered the most attractive of the ecosystems being seen as lush vibrant immense mysterious spiritual and romantic rainforests hold a special place both providing a direct link to gondwanaland and the dinosaurs and today being the home of endangered species and highly rich in biodiversity they are also a critical part of australia s heritage indeed large areas of australian rainforests are now covered by world heritage listing however they also represent a dissonant heritage what exactly constitutes rainforest how it should be managed and used and how much should be protected are all issues which remain hotly contested debates around rainforests are particularly dominated by the contradiction of competing views and uses seeing rainforests either as untapped resources for agriculture and forestry versus valuing and preserving them as attractive and sublime natural wonders australia fits into this global story as a prime example but is also of interest for its aspects that are exceptional including the intensity of clearing at certain periods and for its place in the early development of national parks this book will be of great interest to students and scholars of environmental history australian history and comparative history

These differences are usually negligible for typical applications. 2. How does the manufacturing process impact the lifespan of DVD-Rs and DVD+Rs? Variations in manufacturing processes can influence a disc's longevity. High-quality discs from reputable brands generally exhibit better longevity than cheaper alternatives. 3. What is the impact of laser power on DVD-R and DVD+R burning performance? Higher laser power generally leads to faster burning speeds but can also increase the risk of disc damage if not properly controlled. This is handled automatically by most burners, but understanding the underlying principle is helpful for troubleshooting. 4. Are there any significant differences in the data density between DVD-R and DVD+R? While both formats offer similar storage capacities, the data arrangement and encoding methods can lead to minor differences in data density, impacting retrieval speeds and error rates. However, these differences are typically insignificant for everyday use. 5. Can I mix and match DVD-R and DVD+R discs in a single multi-session recording? Generally, this is not recommended. While some burners might attempt it, inconsistent performance and data corruption are possible. It's best to stick to a single format per disc.
