if you d asked me at 10 what my plans were for the next few years fighting an eating disorder would not have made the list gen s early teenage years were the hardest of her life struggling with anorexia and poor mental health she spent time in and out of hospitals and clinics which also had a huge impact on her family but with treatment and support gen was able to turn her life around changing her behaviours and attitude toward food and her body as well as sharing the insights from gen s own lived experience and challenging stereotypes around eating disorders bite back

includes practical tips and activities from gen and her team that helped with recovery answers to frequently asked questions about the cause and treatment of eating disorders advice on how you can support a loved one going through it i hope my story helps you feel seen that it inspires you and is a reminder that there is a beautiful life waiting for you keep fighting

a second year doctoral student from a midwestern family frye is twenty three when she marries a german professor ten years her senior previously sheltered frye seeks new vistas but instead finds herself confined by the demands of her life wife to a volatile and domineering husband mother of two young daughters and aspiring academic with her dissertation completed she finally realizes that the only way to wrest her identity and freedom from her husband s grip is by leaving him she boards a bus with her two young children to embark on a new life in biting the moon frye powerfully recounts her struggle for independence and a successful career while remaining devoted to her daughters despite the many promises of the women s movement liberation from domestic work and the ability to influence social policy she wrestles with the complex often ambivalent relationship between feminism and motherhood interwoven with literary references from charlotte brontë to virginia woolf to tillie olsen biting the moon invites the reader along on frye s quest for self expression and a life beyond the shadows of others this deeply felt courageous portrait of a woman s life will be intimately familiar to an older generation of mothers and an inspiration to a younger generation

teen readers have always been fascinated by monsters but lately it seems like every other young adult ya book is about vampires zombies or werewolves these works are controversial since they look at aspects of life and human nature that adults prefer to keep hidden from teenagers but this is also why they are so important they provide a literal example of how ignoring life s hazards won t make them go away and demonstrate that ignorance of danger puts one at greater risk in they suck they bite they eat they kill the psychological meaning of supernatural monsters in young adult fiction joni bodart examines six different monsters vampires shapeshifters zombies unicorns angels and demons in ya literature bodart first discusses the meaning of these monsters in cultures all over the world subsequent chapters explore their history and most important incarnations comparing the same kind of creatures featured in different titles this volume also contains interviews with authors who provide additional insight and information and the bibliography includes a comprehensive list of titles featuring the various monsters analyzing the most important and well written series and titles for teens they suck they bite they eat they kill will be useful for parents teachers and anyone else hoping to understand why teens want to read books in this genre and what some of the benefits of reading them might be

this lively collection of essays explores the narrative riches of the twilight stories themselves even as it looks seriously at the ways they have been marketed and taken up both by their passionate fans and by critics who see them as evidence of a range of cultural and political problems janice radway author of reading the romance women patriarchy and popular literature professor of communication studies rhetoric and gender studies and american studies northwestern university

in a sweeping synthesis of american history mary ryan demonstrates how the meaning of male and female has evolved changed and varied over a span of 500 years and across major social and ethnic boundaries she traces how at select moments in history perceptions of sex difference were translated into complex and mutable patterns for differentiating women and men how those distinctions were drawn and redrawn affected the course of american history more generally ryan recounts the construction of a modern gender regime that sharply divided male from female and created modes of exclusion and inequity the divide between male and female blurred in the twentieth century as women entered the public domain massed in the labor force and revolutionized private life this transformation in gender history serves as a backdrop for seven chronological chapters each of which presents a different problem in american history as a quandary of sex ryan s bold analysis raises the possibility that perhaps if understood in their variety and mutability the differences of sex might lose the sting of inequality

quest narratives are as old as western culture in stories like the odyssey the lord of the rings star wars and harry potter men set out on journeys fight battles and become heroes women traditionally feature in such stories as damsels in need of rescue or as the prizes at the end of heroic quests these narratives perpetuate predominant gender roles by casting men as active and women as passive focusing on stories in which popular teenage heroines buffy summers katniss everdeen and disney s princess merida embark on daring journeys this book explores what happens when traditional gender roles and narrative patterns are subverted the author examines representations of these characters across various media film television novels posters merchandise fan fiction and fan art and online memes that model concepts of heroism and girlhood inspired by feminist ideas

a feminist reader in early cinema marks a new era of feminist film scholarship the twenty essays collected here demonstrate how feminist historiographies at once alter and enrich ongoing debates over visuality and identification authorship stardom and nationalist ideologies in cinema and media studies drawing extensively on archival research the collection yields startling

in reframing trauma in contemporary fiction film tarja laine provides insights into how cinema engages its spectator emotionally with the pathology of memory that lies at the heart of trauma by arguing that cinema communicates the inability to process a traumatic event by means of its aesthetic specificity laine demonstrates that traumatic cinema can be an important source of ethical knowledge both within and beyond the cinematic world the films discussed in this book do not necessarily narrate trauma but embody that aspect of trauma which resists narrativization this is why there are modes of affective engagement beyond storytelling by which spectators can meaningfully relate to trauma scholars of film studies media studies and philosophy will find this book of particular interest

based on new zealand election study nzes data from a sample of 2 830 eligible voters a bark but no bite explores a puzzle while there was a lot of talk about inequality before the 2014 general election in new zealand and during the campaign concern about inequality appeared to have no tangible effect on the election outcome this book shows that by its attention to the concerns of middle ground voters the national government had reduced the potential of policy differences to drive voter choices perceptions of competence and effective leadership were national's strongest suit crowding out voter concerns over matters of policy when voters did consider policy inequality and related concerns were second to the economy traditional priorities about health and education and perceptions of party differences on these matters had faded into the background meanwhile voters doubted the opposition labour party's ability to govern effectively in an alternative coalition to that of the national led government labour's policies were too many in various ways they would have chipped away at inequality but lacked a coherent narrative and presentation this book confirms that labour's proposal to increase the age for receipt of new zealand superannuation gained labour no new votes hopes that the missing million people who failed to turn out to vote in 2011 would vote in 2014 and give an advantage to the left were unfulfilled a comprehensive study of the 2014 election this book provides a detailed account of all these findings and a host of others

this book explores the ways in which anorexic women use their eating to control their bodies it argues that the female body in modern western culture is understood as open and accessible and female appetite as dangerous and voracious anorexia attempts to resist both these constructions in the creation of a closed desireless body since anorexic women resist the power of collective ideologies their resistance cannot work the closed body becomes its own prison

this book is a feminist reading of gender performance and construction of the female role players onnogata of the kabuki theatre it is not limited to a theatre arts focus rather it is a mapping and close analysis of transformative genders through several historical periods in japan the seventeenth through the twentieth centuries

this book offers an original interdisciplinary analysis of the relations between myth identity and social reality involving elements of narratology theory linguistics philosophy anthropology and social theory harnessed to support an argument firmly located in the area of literary criticism this analysis yields a fairly extensive reinterpretation of the concept of myth which is applied to the examination of the relationship between narrative and social reality as represented in texts by contemporary scottish and irish women writers the main theoretical sources are mikhail bakhtin s theories of heteroglossia jacques derrida s theories of citationality and judith butler s theories of subjectivity the analysis framework developed in the book uses these theories to create a new way of understanding how literary texts change readers worldviews by enticing them to accept alternative possibilities of cultural expression of identity and social order the texts analysed in this book reconfigure naturalised stories that have become normative and constraining in conveying identities and visions of legitimate social orders the book s focus on feminine identities places it alongside feminist analyses of reconstructions of fairy tales myths or canonical stories that establish what counts as legitimate feminine identity studied here for the first time together the writers whose texts form the interest of this book continue the revisionist work begun by other women writers who engage with the male generated literary philosophical and humanist tradition they share a view of narratives as tools for continually negotiating our identities social worlds and socialisation scenarios while the high level theoretical discourse of the first part of the book requires specialised knowledge the second part of the book offering close readings of the texts is both lively and accessible and should engage the interest of the general reader and academic alike this book is written for all those who are interested in the power words have to hold sway over our inner and outer social worlds

in brilliant imperfection eli clare uses memoir history and critical analysis to explore cure the deeply held belief that body minds considered broken need to be fixed cure serves many purposes it saves lives manipulates lives and prioritizes some lives over others it provides comfort makes profits justifies violence and promises resolution to body mind loss clare grapples with this knot of contradictions maintaining that neither an anti cure politics nor a pro cure worldview can account for the messy complex relationships we have with our body minds the stories he tells range widely stretching from disability stereotypes to weight loss surgery gender transition to skin lightening creams at each turn clare weaves race disability sexuality class and gender together insisting on the nonnegotiable value of body mind difference into this mix he adds environmental politics thinking about ecosystem loss and restoration as a way of delving more deeply into cure ultimately brilliant imperfection reveals cure to be an ideology grounded in the twin notions of normal and natural slippery and powerful necessary and damaging all at the same time

that had been denied them for centuries in other branches of scientific investigation look wherever you will in any branch of psychology or neuroscience in the last century and a half and what you will find are a plethora of women whose discoveries fundamentally changed how we view the brain and its role in the formation of our perceptions and behaviors a history of women in psychology and neuroscience tells the story of 267 women whose work opened new doors in humanity's ongoing attempt to learn about its own nature from christine ladd franklin's late 19th century studies of how the brain perceives color to virginia johnson's pioneering studies of the human sexual response and augusta dejerine klumpke's early association of neurological conditions with their underlying brain regions to may britt moser's nobel winning discovery a century later of the grid cells that allow us to mentally model our surroundings here are the stories of when and how we learned how memories are formed what role an enriched environment plays in mental development why some individuals are better able to cope with chronic stress than others how societal stereotypes unconsciously feed into our daily interactions with other people what role evolution might have played in the formation of our social habits what light the practices of sign language might shed on our brain's basic capacity for language how children internalize the violence they experience from others and hundreds of other tales of the women who dug deep into the structures of the human mind to uncover layer by layer the answers to millennia old questions of what humans are and why they behave as they do

the essays in this collection use the interpretative lens to interrogate the meanings of meyer's books making a compelling case for the cultural relevance of twilight and providing insights on how we can read popular culture to our best advantage

elena ferrante's neapolitan novels achieved stunning global success in part because of the mystery surrounding their pseudonymous author english speaking readers were tantalized by her enigmatic biography as well as what they took to be her authentic portrayal of working class naples however we now know that the person behind the writing is most likely anita raja a prominent translator of german literature whose background is very different from ferrante's supposed life in finding ferrante alessia ricciardi revisits questions about ferrante's identity to show how the problem of authorship is deeply intertwined with the novels literary ambition and politics going beyond the local and national cultures of naples and italy ricciardi reads ferrante's fiction as world literature foregrounding raja's work as a translator she examines the novels engagement with german literature and criticism particularly goethe walter benjamin and christa wolf while also tracing the influence of italian thinkers such as antonio gramsci carla lonzi and the milan women's bookstore collective considering central questions of sexuality work politics and place ricciardi demonstrates how intertextual resonances reshape our understanding of lila and elena the protagonists of the neapolitan quartet as well as the characters and language of ferrante's other books this bold reconsideration of one of today's most acclaimed authors reveals ferrante's works as fiercely intellectual showing their deep concern with feminist and cultural politics and the ethical and political stakes of literature
