fulfilling the needs of teachers gives teacher educators the power to reach a teacher's mind and soul this book guides educators through a five step process for creating design tasks design tasks are multi dimensional professional learning activities that develop teachers understandings skills and abilities by presenting knowledge in a context that affects his or her beliefs attitudes and emotions

this book addresses a topic that has received surprisingly little attention to date the health and social needs of young adults with physical disabilities following an extensive review of the contemporary literature on the subject the authors report an in depth study on a large sample of physically disabled 18 to 25 year olds living in two survey areas one urban and one semirural the study which included pediatric examinations and interviews by a social psychologist found that a large proportion of subjects face social and medical problems for instance they have serious health needs that are not being met by the statutory services they left school with less than adequate skills to enable them to lead an independent adult life they are without a daytime occupation or attend day centers that are described as unstimulating places they do not receive all the financial benefits to which they are entitled they are isolated from their peers and lack the social skills to interact with others in a positive and successful way parents and guardians were also found to receive little physical or emotional support these findings underline the need for a better system of

providing and coordinating services for this client group and the authors call for the formation within each local health authority area of an adult disability service that would have a clinical and planning role in terms of health care and that would act as a linchpin in the coordination of health educational social and voluntary services although this work relates specifically to service provision in the united kingdom it is felt that the conclusions and recommendations are also broadly applicable to the situation in other countries

what do babies and young children really need this impassioned dialogue cuts through all the theories platitudes and controversies that surround parenting advice to define what every child must have in the first years of life the authors both famed advocates for children lay out the seven irreducible needs of any child in any society and confront such thorny questions as how much time do children need one on one with a parent what is the effect of shifting caregivers of custody arrangements why are we knowingly letting children fail in school nothing is off limits even such an issue as whether every child needs or deserves to be a wanted child this short hard hitting book the fruit of decades of experience and caring sounds a wake up call for parents teachers judges social workers policy makers anyone who cares about the welfare of children

the fao expert workshop on mud crab aquaculture held in singapore brought together leading experts to address critical challenges and emerging opportunities in the sustainable farming of scylla spp mud crabs driven by escalating demand for both hard shell and soft shell mud crabs the sector faces constraints such as overfishing habitat degradation reliance on wild seedstock and unsustainable farming practices the workshop provided a collaborative platform to evaluate the current state of the industry identify technological innovations and set a course for advancing sustainability and resilience in mud crab aquaculture central to the discussions was the transition from capture based to hatchery based production systems to secure consistent and high quality seedstock experts highlighted the importance of domestication and selective breeding to enhance aquaculture yields the development of formulated feeds reducing reliance on wild sourced feed and the integration of advanced technologies such as probiotics and recirculating aquaculture systems ras were identified as critical pathways to address water quality biosecurity and production efficiency challenges innovative farming system approaches were presented including sustainable polyculture systems and the adoption of cellular farming techniques to mitigate cannibalism and improve survival rates the potential of the soft shell crab sector for value addition through enhanced post harvest practices packaging and processing was also discussed though key

bottlenecks such as limited seedstock availability forced moulting practices and inconsistent farming standards need to be adequately addressed broader ecological concerns such as the overexploitation of wild populations and the degradation of mangrove habitats were highlighted experts advocated strengthened fishery management habitat restoration and policy interventions to mitigate these issues additionally the role of advanced technologies such as iot enabled systems digital training tools and automation was underscored as transformative for achieving scalability and operational efficiency in mud crab farming aligned with fao s blue transformation initiative the workshop outlined a comprehensive strategy to promote sustainable development in the mud crab aquaculture sector key recommendations included establishing broodstock banks deploying cost effective disease screening enhancing international collaboration and scaling capacity building programmes to share knowledge and technologies across diverseaquaculture contexts by fostering innovation improving productivity and addressing environmental challenges the outcomes of the workshop aim to strengthen global food security enhance aquaculture value chains and sustain the livelihoods of communities dependent on mud crab production

this is the report of technical meeting on strengthening data on the unmet care needs of older persons held 10 11 june 2024 in kobe japan brought together international academics members of the consortium for advancing research and evaluation in tracking unmet health social care needs of older populations caretrack and world health organization who technical staff from regional offices and headquarters to address the critical issue of unmet health and social care needs among older persons the discussions underscored the urgency of understanding and measuring these unmet needs to advance universal health coverage by 2030

this book provides a historical inquiry into the quantification of needs in humanitarian assistance needs are increasingly seen as the lowest common denominator of humanity standard definitions of basic needs however set a minimalist version of humanity both in the sense that they are narrow in what they compare and that they set a low bar for satisfaction the book argues that we cannot understand humanitarian governance if we do not understand how humanitarian agencies made human suffering commensurable across borders in the first place the book identifies four basic elements of needs as a concept as a system of classification and triage as a material apparatus and as a set of standards drawing on a range of archival sources including the united nations refugee agency unher médecins sans frontières msf and the sphere project the book traces the concept of needs from its emergence in the 1960s right through to the present day and united nations secretary general ban ki moon s call for evidence based humanitarianism finally the book assesses how the international governmentality of needs has played out in a recent humanitarian crisis drawing on field research on central african refugees in the cameroonian borderland in 2014

2016 this important historical inquiry into the universal nature of human suffering will be an important read for humanitarian researchers and practitioners as well as readers with an interest in international history and development

this edited volume presents selected papers capturing herbert kelman s unique and seminal contributions to the social psychology of conflict analysis and resolution with a special emphasis on the utility of concepts for understanding and constructively addressing violent and intractable conflicts central concepts covered include perceptual processes basic human needs group and normative processes social identity and intergroup trust which form the basis for developing interactive methods of conflict resolution

in discussions of firm strategy proactivity is often mentioned as an enabler of effective goal accomplishment and high performance however it is rarely explained what more precisely being more proactive actually entails or even indeed defined what is meant by the term proactivity in this particular context this dissertation seeks to investigate proactivity and its role in shaping firms market strategies from prior research on proactivity in the strategic marketing domain we know that proactive firms on average develop more radical innovation are better at managing complex and highly competitive environments and seem to achieve higher business performance however few if any of these prior studies properly define proactivity and take a more holistic perspective on its impact on firms market strategies in this dissertation i propose a definition of proactivity through three main proactive characteristics being future oriented taking the initiative and driving change thus a proactive firm does not wait for things to happen and then react to those events instead it keeps a long term horizon on its scanning for market intelligence and takes action before things happen in order to create the change needed to improve its situation while certainly not all proactive actions are successes particularly not if the firm lacks proper awareness of the situation or exceeds its capabilities in its striving to shape events proactive firms do have access to a broader set of opportunities than their less proactive competitors to understand how proactivity influences market strategies it is first necessary to understand market strategy itself a bit closer i define market strategies as firms strategies for creating customer value according to the market orientation literature the basis of achieving long term high firm performance is to consistently provide customers with superior value to that of the competition thus firms market strategies are squarely at the center of their efforts to become more successful to study these strategies and the effects they have it is necessary to go beyond strategy documents and study the actual activities that firms perform to implement them a market strategy in my conceptualization can thus be perceived as a coherent set of activities aimed at fulfilling certain goals leading to the creation of customer value these activities can then be further categorized according to the strategic orientations that drive the firm s strategy making with customer orientation competition orientation and innovation orientation being the orientations that have the most impact on market strategies from this conceptual foundation the dissertation takes four different approaches to investigating proactive market strategies each presented in one of the four appended papers in the first paper a conceptual typology of different types of market strategies based on different value creation logics which are the combinations of responsiveness and proactivity that influence a firm s value creation efforts is presented in the second paper the market strategies of five proactive firms are investigated to find three generic proactive market strategies each representing a typical way for firms to employ proactivity in their market strategies the third paper uses fuzzy set qualitative comparative analysis to investigate the configurations of proactivity market environment and different market strategies that consistently lead to high market strategic effectiveness finally the fourth paper goes more in depth in exploring the activities that firms employ to create value for customers with particular focus on the different activities that are performed during different stages of contact with a customer through this thorough investigation of proactive market strategies this dissertation presents a holistic view of proactivity and its impact on firms market strategies and their associated activities as this is the first proper holistic view of proactivity in market strategy and also the first attempt to properly define proactivity in the market strategic context the dissertation also provides directions originally published in 1968 the study described in this title began in a very small way in late 1960 at that time some oxfordshire county councillors and children's department officials were very conscious that the number of children in care in the county was high in comparison with the national average this meant that expenditure was also high the county's position however was not unique oxford city was in a similar position but other neighbours did not appear to have the same problem a small research project was launched to investigate and it soon became apparent that there was a large and complex problem to be solved the problem was of striking persistent and puzzling variations in the proportion of children in care in the different local authority children's departments of england and wales this seemed to warrant a larger investigation on a country wide basis and this book outlines the findings of that project
