this introductory book to catholic social teaching covers not only the official documents and encyclicals but also gives a sense of the movements and people who embodied the struggle for social justice in the last 100 years

the impact of the industrial revolution on the social structures of industrialized nations posed a difficult challenge to the catholic church and its popes in the struggle for human and economic status should the church side with the new working class or with capitalist barons who along with the old aristocracy identified themselves as upholders of christian civilization in this history of papal social teaching joe holland tells how the popes at first backed the status quo then with the accession of pope leo xiii in 1878 a seismic shift took place leo s encyclical rerum novarum was the first authoritative church voice to declare that laboring people have rights the right to fair wages to decent living conditions the right to organize labor unions and even to strike henceforth the notion of civilization at least for the church would be grounded in the lives and aspirations of working people modern catholic social teaching traces this historic shift as it played out in the writings of leo and the popes who followed him pius x benedict xv pius xi and pius xii these popes supported leo s encyclical and even elaborated it as european history experienced the emergen

charles e curran offers the first comprehensive analysis and criticism of the development of modern catholic social teaching from the perspective of theology ethics and church history curran studies the methodology and content of the documents of catholic social teaching generally understood as comprising twelve papal letters beginning with leo xiii's 1891 encyclical *rerum novarum* two documents from vatican ii and two pastoral letters of the u.s. bishops he contends that the fundamental basis for this body of teaching comes from an anthropological perspective that recognizes both the inherent dignity and the social nature of the human person thus do the church's teachings on political and economic matters chart a middle course between the two extremes of individualism and collectivism the documents themselves tend to downplay any discontinuities with previous documents but curran's systematic analysis reveals the significant historical developments that have occurred over the course of more than a century although greatly appreciative of the many strengths of this teaching curran also points out the weaknesses and continuing tensions in catholic social teaching today intended for scholars and students of catholic social ethics as well as those involved in catholic social ministry this volume will also appeal to non catholic readers interested in an understanding and evaluation of catholic social teaching

catholic social teaching is a relatively new and growing body of theology its foundation can be found in the bible and tradition of the church however it began to be formalized beginning in 1891 with the writing of pope leo s revolutionary social letter encyclical on the new things rerum novarum it subsequently has been woven through all the many social encyclicals written by the modern popes right up to the current pope francis this book is written about the many themes of catholic social teaching found in these social letters as well as an emphasis particularly on distributive justice as found in every modern papal social letter additionally these letters often discuss the current failures of modern economic systems capitalism communism and socialism to meet the needs of a majority of people in the world particularly the poor and marginalized although these social letters never propose any new economic system the heavy emphasis on distributive justice found in all of them is used as a basis to discuss a proposed and untried economic system called distributism distributism was first introduced to the world in the early 1900 s by

catholic writer and theologian g k chesterton and hilaire belloc

this is a time marked by extensive reflection on how decent jobs and fair working conditions can be secured amidst considerable change in the labour market it is apparent that technological and environmental changes are causing transformations in the jobs available to be performed and the way in which work is organized these developments stand alongside enduring injustices such as low pay poor conditions and precarious working relationships labour market disadvantage continues to affect disproportionately women and other social groups such as minority ethnic communities migrants and persons with disabilities the covid 19 pandemic exposed the undervalued nature of many frontline jobs the president of the european commission observed

although the virtues are implicit in catholic social teaching they are too often overlooked in this pioneering study andrew m yuengert draws on the neo aristotelian virtues tradition to bring the virtue of practical wisdom into an explicit and wide ranging engagement with the church s social doctrine practical wisdom and the virtues clarify the meaning of christian personalism highlight the irreplaceable role of the laity in social reform and bring attention to the important task of lay formation in virtue this form of wisdom also offers new insights into the church s dialogue with economics and the social sciences and reframes practical political disagreements between popes bishops and the laity in a way that challenges both laypersons and episcopal leadership yuengert s study respects the church s social tradition while showing how it might develop to be more practical by proposing active engagement with practical wisdom he demonstrates how catholic social teaching can more effectively inform and inspire practical social reform
