volume 51 sermons 2916 2967 charles spurgeon 19 june 1834 31 january 1892 is one of the church s most famous
preachers and christianity s foremost prolific writers called the prince of preachers he was one of england s most
notable ministers for most of the second half of the nineteenth century and he still remains highly influential among
christians of different denominations today his sermons have spread all over the world and his many printed works
have been cherished classics for decades in his lifetime spurgeon preached to more than 10 million people often up
to ten times each week he was the pastor of the congregation of the new park street chapel later the metropolitan
tabernacle in london for 38 years he was an inexhaustible author of various kinds of works including sermons
commentaries an autobiography as well as books on prayer devotionals magazines poetry hymns and more spurgeon

was known to produce powerful sermons of penetrating thought and divine inspiration and his oratory and writing skills held his audiences spellbound many christians have discovered spurgeon s messages to be among the best in christian literature edward walford wrote in old and new london volume 6 1878 quoting an article from the times regarding one of spurgeon s meetings at surrey fancy a congregation consisting of 10 000 souls streaming into the hall mounting the galleries humming buzzing and swarming a mighty hive of bees eager to secure at first the best places and at last any place at all after waiting more than half an hour for if you wish to have a seat you must be there at least that space of time in advance mr spurgeon ascended his tribune to the hum and rush and trampling of men succeeded a low concentrated thrill and murmur of devotion which seemed to run at once like an electric current through the breast of every one present and by this magnetic chain the preacher held us fast bound for about two hours it is not my purpose to give a summary of his discourse it is enough to say of his voice that its power and volume are sufficient to reach every one in that vast assembly of his language that it is neither high flown nor homely of his style that it is at times familiar at times declamatory but always happy and often eloquent of his doctrine that neither the calvinist nor the baptist appears in the forefront of the battle which is waged by mr spurgeon with relentless animosity and with gospel weapons against irreligion cant hypocrisy pride and those secret bosom sins which so easily beset a man in daily life and to sum up all in a word it is enough to say of the man himself that he impresses you with a perfect conviction of his sincerity more than a hundred years after his death charles spurgeon s legacy continues to effectively inspire the church around the world for this reason delmarva publications has chosen to publish the complete works of charles spurgeon

uniquely qualified to form a women's mission the case is made for a momentum shift in missiological thinking there is a desperate and aching need for a women's mission which could lead the way to a women's missionary movement the emergence of such a mission movement is indeed fraught with skepticism and suspicion from many of those inside the church and leaders in the missionary world but the radical disruptive costly following of Jesus to those outside the camp is our calling

Jesus where are you I prayed every night as I wept I felt I had failed as a priest for I had preached love and the people made genocide then I heard God speak to me Jesus wanted me to use these experiences to evangelize later it was then that I knew my life would be spared God would make a way during the 25th anniversary of the Rwandan genocide Fr. Ubald Rugirangoga tells the dramatic story of how he survived while losing more than eighty of his family members and 45,000 of his parishioners in the killings in the aftermath Fr. Ubald experienced a renewed sense of purpose as a minister of reconciliation and a healing evangelist in his homeland and around the world in forgiveness makes you free he offers five spiritual principles that can help those traumatized by the past to experience healing and peace in Christ in 1994 the world looked on in disbelief and horror as Rwanda erupted in violent bloodshed all across the landlocked African country militant Hutus rose up to exterminate the Tutsi population including women and young children one hundred days later a million bodies littered fields streets and even churches now on the twenty fifth anniversary of the Rwandan genocide a powerful testimony emerges of the power of God to bring peace and reconciliation into hearts full of fear and hate in forgiveness makes you free Fr. Ubald Rugirangoga shares his own dramatic story of how he survived the genocide and its traumatic aftermath he testifies about how God spared his life so that he might help others with deep physical emotional and spiritual wounds to experience peace and healing in retelling the story of how he forgave the man who killed his family and cared for the man's children while he was in prison Fr. Ubald demonstrates how showing mercy can facilitate true forgiveness even in the most painful circumstances of our lives throughout the book Fr. Ubald teaches about five spiritual keys that draw us to Christ the only source of lasting peace be thankful and have faith choose to forgive denounce evil decide to live for Jesus claim the blessing each chapter combines Fr. Ubald's story with reflection questions that guide readers along their own path of healing from fear to faith from shame to freedom from isolation to reconciliation from resentment to mercy and

from conflict to peace the final chapter offers a guided meditation to help those who need to experience the power of god to release those held in bondage by fear and hate and to find the secret of peace an appendix contains information about the mushaka reconciliation project a catechetical tool that has been used successfully by parishes in rwanda and could easily be adapted by parishes in the united states to mediate reconciliation between individuals and groups who have become estranged by violence trauma and ethnic or cultural divisions

this yearlong devotional features one or two verses of scripture for each day of the year a brief meditation and a very brief prayer it focuses on how the light of god suffuses our daily lives

a powerful reflection on human affliction in the stories of some remarkable individuals paul murray is not only an academic a preacher and published poet he is also a superb pastor during his ministry he has dealt with some extraordinary people not least a south african who was convicted of murder and hanged under apartheid drawing on this remarkable experience the reader is offered here a sustained meditation on the meaning of affliction and suffering in a way that is ultimately the story of human triumph and the ultimate victory of the cross the book concludes with paul murray s extraordinary meditations on the seven last words from the cross in which the wealth of his pastoral experience is fully brought to bear scars is the account of men and women of all ages who have survived major crises or tragedies of one kind or another the scourge of drug addiction the misery of long term imprisonment severe illness the burden of remembered violence and the tragedy of child abuse the most striking thing about such people is that whether or not they are aware of the reality of god in their lives they are people of extraordinary compassion they seem to have been initiated into a new dimension of themselves and to have discovered a new wealth within as murray says in his introduction the voices which i have begun to hear are voices to which i myself am still learning to listen these are not just accounts of triumphs and of tragedy they are powerful meditations on something much more profound

as women we have so many unanswered questions often since childhood about our purpose whether we re beautiful why we experience loss if we have a good father and if god is real is he good these questions come in every season of life and we often look to ourselves for the answers which ultimately leads to more questions and a broken identity we have to understand and receive the great gift of being a daughter this comes from seeing god as our loving heavenly father this book provides a picture of the father s faithfulness and deep love for every daughter through laney s experiences it is an invitation to receive a god given identity to walk in the inheritance of who you already are

it matters whether we believe in god or not no one can prove that there isn t a god and no one can prove that there is however we can find signposts this book looks for them and claims to have identified them

religion he taught at oxford and cambridge all the while communicating in a clear winsome manner that ordinary men and women could comprehend he gave us masterpieces like the screwtape letters the chronicles of narnia mere christianity the problem of pain and still more in this fascinating biographical study not a tame lion author terry glaspey points out that lewis life was as compelling as his work glaspey gives readers a glimpse of the character of this extraordinarily gifted man who believed that his sharp mind and rich imagination were to be accompanied by a sense of responsibility to the wider world if lewis were alive today he would see the fruition of trends he warned against many years ago his continued relevance is based on his understanding of the human predicament a predicament that is intellectual and moral as well as spiritual lewis points the way out of this predicament but it s not an easy way it requires submission to god s authority moral discipline and integrity of action lewis shows how our lives can be lived in light of eternity and can demonstrate the hope that endures even in these shadowlands
