with his engaging blend of travelogue conversations with a wise and charismatic spiritual father and musings on the big questions of life and death professor markides takes us as companions on his journey of discovery the insights that he communicates with such enthusiasm are timely ones here at last is a writer who challenges the seeker after mystical understanding and eastern spirituality to discover christianity dr elizabeth theokritoff independent scholar and co editor of the cambridge companion to orthodox christian theology in inner river kyriacos markides scholar researcher author and pilgrim takes us on a thrilling quest into the heart of christian spirituality and mankind s desire for a transcendent experience of god from maine s rugged shores to a cypriot monastery to greece s remote mt athos and ultimately to an egyptian desert markides encounters a diverse cast of characters that allows him to explore the worlds of the natural and the supernatural of religion and spirit and of the seen and the unseen inner river will appeal to a wide range of readers from christians seeking insights into their religion and its various expressions to scholars interested in learning more

about the mystical way of life and wisdom that have been preserved in the heart of orthodox spirituality perhaps most important however is the bridge it offers contemporary readers to a christian life that is balanced between the worldly and the spiritual

studying chess is about finding patterns and learning from examples that illustrate those patterns best this e book focuses on patterns based on material left on the board bishops of opposite color and rooks it explains the ideas of bishop endgames alone and then shows how the strategy changes when rooks are also present on the board the level of a reader who could benefit from this book the most is between 1600 and 2200 elo however other chess players should also be able to learn from it because this topic is not often discussed in chess literature yet can improvement in playing such simplified positions can dramatically increase one s chess strength the format was specifically designed for e readers most chapters have examples from practical games of chess champions of the past and present such as botvinnik kasparov and carlsen followed by puzzles for the reader to solve that should reinforce newly learned concepts and help get a better sense of the combination of pieces bishops and rooks discussed throughout the book there are also questions for the reader to answer at the key moments of the games to see solutions for puzzles and questions just go to the next page instructive mistakes by lower rated players are also demonstrated throughout the chapters

radical reads 2 picks up where the first volume left off featuring 101 radical young adult books that have come out since its publication author joni richards bodart defends their inclusion in library collections and school curricula after introducing each book with lists of characters and major themes she also suggests a number of booktalk and book report ideas also identifying books with mature themes in her risks section included as well is a section that lists the awards that the books have won and a section of book reviews

gross anatomy the study of anatomical structures that can be seen by unassisted vision has long been a subject of fascination for artists for most modern viewers however the anatomy lesson the technically precise province of clinical surgeons and medical faculties hardly seems the proper breeding ground for the hybrid workings of art and theory we forget that in its early stages anatomy pursued the highly theatrical spirit of renaissance

dictators endgames examines the political role of the military in dictators endgames large scale nonviolent mass protests in autocracies that demand the regime leader s removal from office it addresses the question why some militaries defend an embattled autocrat by violently cracking down on the protestors whereas others side with the opposition or decide to stage a coup d latt the book introduces a systematic definition and operationalization of the dictator s endgame as a situation of non violent mass mobilization in which the dictator s political survival depends on the loyalty of the military leaders the theoretical argument proposed in this book focuses on the strategic calculations of military leaders and offers a systematic explanation why the armed forces opt for repression of the demonstrators shift their loyalty from the dictator to the opposition or remove the autocrat in a coup during

the mass protests the theory s predictions are empirically tested in a multi method research design that combines statistical analyses and case studies drawing on the original dictator s endgame dataset of all 40 endgames that took place between 1946 and 2014 the study identifies the conditions and processes through which militaries determine the outcome of dictators endgames and thus affect the survival and future political development of authoritarian regimes
