and songs storybooks letters the bible and the qur an as well as school texts in languages they do not speak fluently gregory argues that in order for literacy tuition to be successful reading must make sense children must feel part of a community of readers there is no common method which they use to learn but rather a shared aim to which they aspire making sense of a new world through new words eve gregory is professor of language and culture in education at goldsmiths university of london

the avignon papacy 1309 1377 represented the zenith of papal power in europe the roman curia s move to southern france enlarged its bureaucracy centralized its authority and initiated closer contact with secular institutions the pope s presence also attracted leading minds to avignon transforming a modest city into a cosmopolitan center of learning but a crisis of legitimacy was brewing among leading thinkers of the day the avignon papacy contested considers the work of six fourteenth century writers who waged literary war against the catholic church s increasing claims of supremacy over secular rulers a conflict that engaged contemporary critics from every corner of europe unn falkeid uncovers the dispute s origins in dante s paradiso and monarchia where she identifies a sophisticated argument for the separation of church and state in petrarch

s writings she traces growing concern about papal authority precipitated by the curia's exile from rome marsilius of padua's theory of citizen agency indicates a resistance to the pope's encroaching power which finds richer expression in william of ockham's philosophy of individual liberty both men were branded as heretics the mystical writings of birgitta of sweden and catherine of siena in falkeid's reading contain cloaked confrontations over papal ethics and church governance even though these women were later canonized while each of the six writers responded creatively to the implications of the avignon papacy they shared a concern for the breakdown of secular order implied by the expansion of papal power and a willingness to speak their minds

in chains of babylon daryl j maeda presents a cultural history of asian american activism in the late 1960s and early 1970s showing how the movement created the category of asian american to join asians of many ethnicities in racial solidarity drawing on the black power and antiwar movements asian american radicals argued that all asians in the united states should resist assimilation and band together to oppose racism within the country and imperialism abroad as revealed in maeda s in depth work the asian american movement contended that people of all

asian ethnicities in the united states shared a common relationship to oppression and exploitation with each other and with other nonwhite peoples in the early stages of the civil rights era the possibility of assimilation was held out to asian americans under a model minority myth maeda insists that it was only in the disruption of that myth for both african americans and asian americans in the 1960s and 1970s that the full asian american culture and movement he describes could emerge maeda challenges accounts of the post 1968 era as hopelessly divisive by examining how racial and cultural identity enabled asian americans to see eye to eye with and support other groups of color in their campaigns for social justice asian american opposition to the war in vietnam unlike that of the broader antiwar movement was predicated on understanding it as a racial specifically anti asian genocide throughout he argues that cultural critiques of racism and imperialism the twin chains of babylon of the title informed the construction of a multiethnic asian american identity committed to interracial and transnational solidarity

until now ghelly chernov s work on the theory of simultaneous interpretation si was mostly accessible only to a russian speaking readership finally chernov s major work originally published in russia in 1987 under the title *Введение в теорию одновременного перевода* introduction to simultaneous interpretation and widely considered a classic in interpretation theory is now available in english as well adopting a psycholinguistic approach to professional si chernov defines it as a task performed in a single pass concurrently with the source language speech under extreme perception and production conditions in which only a limited amount of information can be processed at any given time being both a researcher and a practitioner chernov drew from a rich interpreting corpus to create the first comprehensive model of simultaneous interpretation his model draws on semantics pragmatics russian activity theory and the si communicative situation to formulate the principles of objective and subjective redundancy and identify probability prediction as the enabling mechanism of si edited with notes and a critical foreword by two active si researchers robin setton and adelina hild this book will be useful to practicing interpreters in providing a theoretical basis for appreciating the syntactic and other devices that can be used by both students and experienced interpreters in fine tuning their performance in the booth

the story of how the lisu of southwest china were evangelized one hundred years ago by the china inland mission is a familiar one in mission circles the subsequent history of the lisu church

however is much less well known songs of the lisu hills brings this history up to date recounting the unlikely story of how the lisu maintained their faith through twenty two years of government persecution and illuminating how lisu christians transformed the text based religion brought by the missionaries into a faith centered around an embodied set of christian practices based on ethnographic fieldwork as well as archival research this volume documents the development of lisu christianity both through larger social forces and through the stories of individual believers it explores how the lisu most of whom remain subsistence farmers have oriented their faith less around cognitive notions of belief and more around participation in a rhythm of shared christian practices such as line dancing attending church and festivals evangelizing working in one another's fields and singing translated western hymns these embodied practices demonstrate how christianity developed in the mountainous margins of the world's largest atheist state a much needed expansion of the lisu story into a complex study of the evolution of a world christian community this book will appeal to scholars working at the intersections of world christianity anthropology of religion ethnography chinese christianity and mission studies
