the evidence is everywhere fundamentalist reading can stir passions and provoke violence that changes the world amid such present day conflagrations this illuminating book reminds us of the sources and profound consequences of christian fundamentalism in the sixteenth century james simpson focuses on a critical moment in early modern england specifically the cultural transformation

that allowed common folk to read the bible for the first time widely understood and accepted as the grounding moment of liberalism this was actually simpson tells us the source of fundamentalism and of different kinds of persecutory violence his argument overturns a widely held interpretation of sixteenth century protestant reading and a crucial tenet of the liberal tradition after exploring the heroism and achievements of sixteenth century english lutherans particularly william tyndale burning to read turns to the bad news of the lutheran bible simpson outlines the dark dynamic yet demeaning paradoxes of lutheran reading its demands that readers hate the biblical text before they can love it that they be constantly on the lookout for unreadable signs of their own salvation that evangelical readers be prepared to repudiate friends and all tradition on the basis of their personal reading of scripture such reading practice provoked violence not only against lutheranism s stated enemies as simpson demonstrates it also prompted psychological violence and permanent schism within its own adherents the last wave of fundamentalist reading in the west provoked 150 years of violent upheaval as we approach a second wave this powerful book alerts us to our peril

a decade of dark humor analyzes ways in which popular and visual culture used humor in a variety of forms to confront the attacks of september 11 2001 and more specifically the aftermath this interdisciplinary volume brings together scholars from four countries to discuss the impact of humor and irony on both media discourse and tangible political reality furthermore it demonstrates that laughter is simultaneously an avenue through which social issues are deferred or obfuscated a way in which neoliberal or neoconservative rhetoric is challenged and a means of forming alternative political ideologies the volume s contributors cover a broad range of media productions including news parodies the daily show with jon stewart the colbert report the onion tv roundtable shows politically incorrect with bill maher comic strips and cartoons aaron mcgruder s the boondocks jeff danzinger s editorial cartoons television drama rescue me animated satire south park graphic novels art spiegelman s in the shadow of no towers documentary fahrenheit 9 11 and other productions along with examining the rhetorical methods and aesthetic techniques of these productions the essays place each in specific political and journalistic contexts showing how corporations news outlets and political institutions responded to and sometimes co opted these forms of humor

garrett stewart begins the deed of reading with a memory of his first hesitant confrontation as a teenager with poetic density in that early verbal challenge he finds one driving force of literature to make language young again in its surprise coming alive in each new event of reading but what exactly happens in the textual encounter to make literary phrasing resonate so deeply with readers to take the measure of literary writing the deed of reading convenes diverse philosophic commentary on the linguistics of literature with stress on the complementary work of stanley cavell and giorgio agamben

sympathetic to recent ventures in form attentive analysis but resisting an emphasis on so called surface reading stewart explores not some new formalism but the internal pressures of language in formation registering the verbal infrastructure of literary prose as well as verse in this mode of contextual reading the context is language itself literary phrasing tapping the speech act s own generative pulse emerges as a latent philosophy of language in its own right whereby human subjects finding no secure place to situate themselves within language settle for its taking place in through and between them stewart watches and hears this dynamics of wording played out in dozens of poems and novels over two centuries of english literary production from wordsworth and shelley to browning and hopkins from poe and dickens through george eliot conrad james and on to toni morrison the deed of reading offers a revisionary contribution to the ethic of verbal attention in the grip of deep reading

a champion is dead and a god has been taken from the game while the remaining gods seem to be no closer to discovering what it is they are playing for they now begin to question the motives of the creator will there be a winner of this epic game or will the one responsible for it all simply watch on as the champions move closer to their inevitable deaths

lucan s relationships to vergil and julius caesar the contributors to this volume are all expert scholars who have published widely on lucan s work and roman imperial literature their essays provide readers with a detailed understanding of and appreciation for the poem s unique features the contributors take special care to include translations of all original latin passages and explain unfamiliar latin and greek terms the volume is enhanced by a map of lucan s roman world and a glossary of key terms
