we know we're supposed to forgive but we just can't forget and it's that struggle in our soul that keeps our hurts and hearts from being healed creating a gap between our pain and the peace we're so desperate for to seem completely unbridgeable when it comes to forgiveness we so easily confuse God's love with our own and find ourselves frustrated and confused without a clear understanding of what God is really asking us to do it's through the forgiveness factor that you'll come to clearly understand what God means when he says to forgive and more than likely it's not what you think it's in uncovering the truth about forgiveness by revealing the lies that you'll be set free from the burden that forgiveness seems to bring you'll realize that you're only giving up your hope for a different past realizing that wrongs may never be made right but they can be forgiven

this book explores forgiveness as a philosophical matter responding to the curious omission of forgiveness in much of western philosophy it examines common themes and divergences on forgiveness in the works of augustine kierkegaard and arendt these writers understood forgiveness as a paradox it must be contained to be given augustine granted yet not granted kierkegaard and forgotten the moment it is given as if never given at all arendt drawing on these insights can forgiveness be then thought of as a hidden existential capacity and not as a magnanimous display of mercy can we imagine forgiveness as undoing the transgression we see and secretly engaging with the imperceptible impossibility of undoing what has indeed been done

a provocative analysis of how christianity helped legitimize the death penalty in early modern europe then throughout the christian world by turning execution into a great cathartic public ritual and the condemned into a christ like figure who accepts death to save humanity the public execution of criminals has been a common practice ever since ancient times in this wide ranging investigation of the death penalty in europe from the fourteenth to the eighteenth century noted italian historian adriano prosperi identifies a crucial period when legal concepts of vengeance and justice merged with christian beliefs in repentance and forgiveness crime and forgiveness begins with late antiquity but comes into sharp focus in fourteenth century italy with the work of the confraternities of mercy which offered christian comfort to the condemned and were for centuries responsible for burying the dead under the brotherhoods influence the ritual of public execution became christianized and the doomed person became a symbol of the fallen human condition because the time of death was known this ideal sinner could be comforted and prepared for the next life through confession and repentance in return the community bearing witness to the execution offered forgiveness and a christian burial no longer facing eternal condemnation the criminal in turn publicly forgave the executioner and the death provided a moral lesson to the community over time as the practice of christian comfort spread across europe it offered political authorities an opportunity to legitimize the death penalty and encode into law the right to kill and exact vengeance but the contradictions created by christianity s central role in executions did not dissipate and squaring the emotions and values surrounding state sanctioned executions was not simple then or now

conflicts in nagaland india

looking at the experiences of women in early modern portugal in the context of crime and forgiveness this study demonstrates the extent to which judicial and quasi judicial records can be used to examine the implications of crime in women's lives whether as victims or culprits the foundational basis for this study is two sets of manuscript sources that highlight two distinct yet connected experiences of women as participants in the criminal process one consists of a collection of archival documents from the first half of the seventeenth century a corpus called querelas in which formal accusations of criminal acts were registered this is a rich source of information not only about the types of crimes reported but also the process that plaintiffs had to follow to deal with their cases the second primary source consists of a sampling of documents known as the perdão de parte the term refers to the victim's pardon unique to the iberian peninsula which allowed individuals implicated in serious conflicts to have a voice in the judicial process by looking at a sample of these pardons found in notary collections from the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries abreu ferreira is able to show the extent to which women exercised their agency in a legal process that was otherwise male dominated

the author's starting point is the interweaving of forgiveness and resentment in the works of jewish writers after the holocaust

most especially hannah arendt and jean améry to make sense of the catastrophe and to point to a way forward for both victims and perpetrators the insights of these two writers and of several jewish novelists and poets including bruno schulz paul celan and aharon appelfeld are used to develop accounts of forgiveness and resentment in other cases of mass atrocity around the world the author offers a critical rereading of primary sources that aim to separate resentment from nonviolent resistance and forgiveness from reconciliation forgiveness and resentment are not as they might first appear mutually exclusive together with arendt améry and walter benjamin it is argued that it is through the interaction between them that victims of mass atrocity become agents of personal and cultural change together forgiveness and resentment interrupt the present reframe the past and shape the future they can reduce the chasm that separates memory and trust by fashioning new connections between identity and alterity which can open paths to truly ethical coexistence for victims and perpetrators and their descendants

in the forgiveness of sins tim carter examines the significance of forgiveness in a new testament context delving deep into second century christian literature on sin and the role of the early church in mitigating it this crucial spiritual issue is at the core of what it means to be christian and carter s thorough and erudite examination of this theme is a necessity for any professional or amateur scholar of the early church carter s far reaching analysis begins with st luke who is often accused of weakness on the subject of atonement but who in fact uses the phrase forgiveness of sins more frequently than any other new testament author carter explores patristic writers both heterodox and orthodox such as marcion justin martyr and origen he also deepens our understanding of second temple judaism and the theological context in which christian ideas about atonement developed useful to both the academic and the pastoral theologian the forgiveness of sins is a painstaking clear eyed exploration of what forgiveness meant not only to early christians such as tertullian irenaeus and luke but to jesus himself and what it means to

christians today

when scottish lay theologian thomas erskine s book the unconditional freeness of the gospel was published in 1828 it provoked a storm of controversy throughout his calvinist homeland the ideas expressed in the book were violently attacked as being radical unwarranted and heretical and yet by the turn of the twentieth century those same ideas that had been so heatedly condemned when first presented had become common stock in the christian world ideas such as the universal fatherhood of god the universal atonement of christ and a gospel that was meant to be proclaimed freely to all people this new and unabridged edition of thomas erskine s classic work has been fully and helpfully annotated it includes an introduction to thomas erskine and his theology by the editor richard leimbach and a final chapter consisting of further readings from erskine s letters and books the book will surely be a welcomed addition for anyone interested in the development of christian theology in the early nineteenth century
