for over a century the danish thinker søren kierkegaard 1813 55 has been at the center of a number of important discussions concerning not only philosophy and theology but also more recently fields such as social thought psychology and contemporary aesthetics especially literary theory despite his relatively short life kierkegaard was an extraordinarily prolific writer as attested to by the 26 volume princeton university press edition of all of his published writings but kierkegaard left behind nearly as much unpublished writing most of which consists of what are called his journals and notebooks kierkegaard has long been recognized as one of history's great journal keepers but only rather small portions of his journals and notebooks are what we usually understand by the term diaries by far the greater part of kierkegaard's journals and notebooks consists of reflections on a myriad of subjects philosophical religious political personal studying his journals and notebooks takes us into his workshop where we can see his entire universe of thought we can witness the genesis of his published works to be sure but we can also see whole galaxies of concepts new insights and fragments large and small of partially or almost entirely completed but unpublished works kierkegaard's journals and notebooks enables us to see the thinker in dialogue with his times and with himself kierkegaard wrote his journals in a two column format one for his initial entries and the second for the extensive marginal comments that he added later this edition of the journals reproduces this format includes several photographs of original manuscript pages and contains extensive scholarly commentary on the various entries and on the history of the

manuscripts being reproduced volume 9 of this 11 volume series includes five of Kierkegaard's important journals journals nb26 through nb30 which span from June 1852 to August 1854 this period was marked by Kierkegaard's increasing preoccupation with what he saw as an unbridgeable gulf in Christianity between the absolute ideal of the religion of the New Testament and the official state sanctioned culture of Christendom which embodied by the Danish people's church Kierkegaard rejected with increasing vehemence crucially Kierkegaard's nemesis Bishop Jakob Peter Mynster died during this period and in the months following Kierkegaard can be seen moving inexorably toward the famous attack on Christendom with which he ended his life

this volume provides a comprehensive review of the effects of climate variability on hydrological and human systems in the Holocene last 10 000 years with a view to predicting similar effects in the future it will be of value to researchers and professionals in hydrology climatology geology and historical geography

published here for the first time is much of a final and long anticipated work on philosophy of history by the great Oxford philosopher and historian R. G. Collingwood 1889-1943 the original text of this uncompleted work has only recently been discovered it is accompanied by further shorter writings by Collingwood on historical knowledge and inquiry selected from previously unpublished manuscripts held at the Bodleian Library Oxford all these writings besides containing entirely new ideas discuss further many of the issues which Collingwood famously raised in the *Idea of History* and in his autobiography the volume includes also two conclusions written by Collingwood for lectures which were eventually revised and published as *The Idea of Nature* but which have relevance also to his philosophy of history a lengthy editorial introduction sets these writings in their context and discusses philosophical questions to which they give rise the editors also consider why Collingwood left the *Principles of History* unfinished at his death and what significance should be attached to the fact that it contains no reference to the idea of historical understanding as re-enactment this volume will be a landmark publication not just in Collingwood studies but in philosophy of history generally

this study offers the first comprehensive account of Emerson's philosophy since his philosophical rehabilitation began in the late 1970s it builds on the historical reconstruction proposed in the author's previous book *Emerson's Metaphysics* and like that study draws on the entire Emerson corpus the poetry and sermons included the aim here is expository the overall though not exclusive emphasis is on identity as

the first term of emerson s metaphysics of identity and flowing or metamorphosis this metaphysics or general conception of the nature of reality is what grounds his epistemology and ethics as well as his esthetic religious and political thought acknowledging its primacy enables a general account like this to avoid the anti realist overemphasis on epistemology and language that has often characterized rehabilitation readings of his philosophy after an initial chapter on emerson s metaphysics the subsequent chapters devoted to the other branches of his thought also begin with their necessary foundation in identity which is the law of things and the law of mind alike perception of identity in metamorphosis is what characterizes the philosopher the poet the scientist the reformer and the man of faith and virtue identity of mind and world is felt in what emerson calls the moral sentiment identity is emerson s answer to the sphinx riddle of life experienced as a puzzling succession of facts and events

originally published in 1961 russian marxist philosophy of science originated among men and women who gave their whole lives to rebellion against established authority the original tension within marxist philosophy between positivism and metaphysics was repressed but not resolved in this first phase of soviet marxism in this volume the author correlates the development of ideas with trends in the cultural revolution and against this background it is possible to understand why debates over general philosophy gave way to conflicts over specific sciences in the aftermath of the first five year plan and why there was a genuine crisis in soviet biology
