this cultural journey down memory lane showcases how major western figures events and places have been portrayed in folk legends art literature and popular culture ever since the days of the 49ers and george armstrong custer the old west has been america s most potent source of legend but it is sometimes hard to separate fact from fiction did you know for example that annie oakley was a talented marksman who shot an estimated 40 000 rounds per year while practicing and performing for buffalo bill cody s wild west show in the late l800s or that many interpreters believe that the wonderful wizard of oz is not just a fairy tale but also a populist allegory these are just two of the folk legends dissected and examined in this veritable cultural geography the volume covers everything from billionaire howard hughes and composer aaron copeland to aztlan the legendary first city of the aztecs and area 51 the top secret u s air force base at groom lake nevada that has fascinated ufo and conspiracy buffs

the history of latina o participation and representation in american television whose stories are told on television who are the heroes and heroines held up as intriguing lovable and compelling which characters are fully realized rather than being cardboard villains and sidekicks and who are our storytellers the first ever account of latino a participation and representation in us english language television latino tv a history offers a sweeping study of key moments of chicano a and latino a representation and authorship since the 1950s drawing on archival research interviews with dozens of media professionals who worked on or performed in these series textual analysis of episodes and promotional materials and analysis of news media coverage mary beltrán examines latina o representation in everything from children s television westerns of the 1950s chicana o and puerto rican activist led public affairs series of the 1970s and sitcoms that spanned half a century to latina and latino led series in the 2000s and 2010s on broadcast cable and streaming outlets including george lopez ugly betty one day at a time and vida through the exploration of the histories of latina o television narratives and the authors of those narratives mary beltrán sheds important light on how latina os have been included and more often not in the television industry and in the stories of the country writ large

mexican americans are rapidly becoming the largest minority in the united states playing a vital role in the culture of the american southwest and beyond this a to z guide offers comprehensive coverage of the mexican american experience entries range from figures such as corky gonzales joan baez and nancy lopez to general entries on bilingual education assimilation border culture and southwestern agriculture court cases politics and events such as the delano grape strike all receive full coverage while the definitions and significance of terms such as coyote and tejano are provided in shorter entries taking a historical approach this book s topics date back to the 1848 treaty of guadalupe hidalgo a radical turning point for mexican americans as they lost their lands and found themselves

thrust into an alien social and legal system the entries trace mexican americans experience as a small conquered minority their growing influence in the 20th century and the essential roles their culture plays in the borderlands or the american southwest in the 21st century

larger than life offers eleven essays that touch on new mexico s history through its people places and events

this question and answer book contains 400 reminders of what is known and what is sometimes forgotten or misunderstood about a city that was founded more than 400 years ago not a traditional history book this group of questions is presented in an apparently random order and the answers occasionally meander off topic as if part of a casual conversation

in western new mexico in 1905 there rode a notorious outlaw from the mexican border named henry coleman with a colt 45 strapped to his hip coleman alias street hudspeth from the well to do texas family came to be either despised as a deceitful rustler and ruthless murderer or admired as a man of honor and great courage a popular and charismatic cowman who was fast with a gun no one seemed indifferent in less than a decade coleman who was fluent in spanish and popular with many of the hispanics of the area became as famous in the western part of the state as billy the kid was in lincoln county sheriff elfego baca of socorro county who was careful not to confront coleman referred to him as the last of the bad men of new mexico especially spellbinding are the recollections of how coleman came to be associated with several murders also intriguing is how he died so violently at the hands of a posse of cattlemen in october 1921 from her ranch on largo creek not far from where coleman was said to have committed more than one murder eleanor williams worked hard to interview anyone who had known him or had any knowledge of his daring deeds williams first published coleman s story in the new mexico electric news a monthly electrical co op magazine from 1964 to 1965 award winning historian jerry thompson edited and annotated it with additional historical context also included is a short biography of williams by her daughter helen cress

this work demonstrates that not everything that disney touched turned to gold in its first 100 years the company had major successes that transformed filmmaking and culture but it also had its share of unfinished projects unmet expectations and box office misses some works failed but nevertheless led to other more stunning and lucrative ones others shed light on periods when the disney company was struggling to establish or re establish its brand in addition many disney properties popular in their time but lost to modern audiences emerge as forgotten gems by exploring the studio s missteps this book provides a more complex portrayal of the history of the company than one would gain from a simple recounting of its many hits with essays by writers from across the globe it also asserts that what endures or is forgotten varies from person to person place to place or generation to generation what one dismisses someone else recalls with deep fondness as a magical disney memory

brian behnken offers a sweeping examination of the interactions between mexican origin people and law enforcement both legally codified police agencies and extralegal justice across the u s southwest especially arizona california new mexico and texas from the 1830s to the 1930s representing a broad colonial regime police agencies and extralegal groups policed and controlled mexican origin people to maintain state and racial power in the region treating mexicans and mexican americans as a foreign population that they deemed suspect and undesirable white americans justified these perceptions and the acts of violence that they spawned with racist assumptions about the criminality of mexican origin people but behnken details the many ways mexicans and mexican americans responded to violence including the formation of self defense groups and advocacy organizations others became police officers vowing to protect mexican origin people from within the ranks of law enforcement mexican americans also pushed state and territorial governments to professionalize law enforcement to halt abuse the long history of the border region between the united states and mexico has been one marked by periodic violence but behnken shows us in unsparing detail how mexicans and mexican americans refused to stand idly by in the face of relentless assault

schaefer profiles pioneers of the west the doctors explorers and cowboys who settled the challenging landscape and built communities in the old west

in june 1949 hopalong cassidy then roy rogers the lone ranger zorro davy crockett the cisco kid matt dillon bat masterson the cartwrights hec ramsey paladin have gun will travel no television genre has generated as many enduring characters as the western gunsmoke death valley days bonanza maverick and wagon train are just a few of the small screen oaters that became instant classics then shows such as lonesome dove and the young riders updated and redefined the genre the shows tended to fall into categories such as juvenile westerns marshals and sheriffs wagon trains and cattle drives ranchers antiheroes bounty hunters gamblers and hired guns memorable pairs indians single parent families e g the big valley the rifleman and bonanza women blacks asians and even spoofs there are 85 television westerns analyzed here the characters the stories and why the shows succeeded or failed many photographs a bibliography and index complete the book

this is the first biography of the legendary officer cipriano baca scion of a prestigious spanish lineage tracing their heritage to the first settlers in nuevo mexico baca was well educated and a successful businessman before beginning a 52 year career as a peace officer tenderhearted by nature he could be cold as steel even lethal doing his duty he was a man of honor and principle in an age of greed and selfishness baca was first an undercover range detective next a deputy sheriff and a deputy u s marshal in 1901 the territorial governor appointed him the first sheriff of the newly formed luna county and in 1905 the territorial governor selected him as the first man to become the lieutenant of new mexico s newly established territorial rangers written with the full cooperation of the baca family and utilizing public and private records this biography presents the truth about a complicated man one revelation baca discovered who was the real killer of pat garrett and the motive behind the murder of the man who killed billy the kid

these entertaining stories from old west history include cowboys indians lawmen lawbreakers entertainers prostitutes priests and politicians they all helped shape the myth and legend of the american west this book reveals the stories of characters like mary fields cleophas dowd and judge roy bean and offers glimpses of gunfights holdups mining claim battles and more

standoffs saloons and sunsets spring to mind when one envisions the rough and tumble early days of the american frontier

william a keleher always had an active curiosity and this made him an outstanding newspaperman and an indefatigable researcher of historical events it led him into many intellectual adventures that resulted in a whole series of books of new mexicana in this personal narrative he gives readers a glimpse behind the scenes of his career not only as a writer but as a lawyer the pages of this last book are full of rich anecdotes and little known episodes involving such men as governor clyde tingley senator bronson cutting elfego baca and senator dennis chavez here is the story of how a bank was saved how political careers were initiated and blocked the story of an editor who wrote the editorials on both sides of an important question for the competing newspapers previously unpublished stories about eugene manlove rhodes and how elfego baca collected an insurance settlement there is also the account of franz huning whose castle was partly in new albuquerque partly in old albuquerque and a story of visiting the old town jail to see an albuquerque editor serving a term for contempt like his other books memoirs is essential for anyone interested in the history and culture of the american southwest william a keleher 1886 1972 observed first hand the changing circumstances of people and places of new mexico born in lawrence kansas he arrived in albuquerque two years later with his parents and two older brothers the older brothers died of diphtheria within a few weeks of their arrival as an adult keleher worked for more than four years as a morse operator and later as a reporter on new mexico newspapers bidding a reluctant farewell to newspaper work keleher studied law at washington lee university and started practicing law in 1915 he was recognized as a successful attorney being honored by the new mexico state bar as one of the outstanding attorneys of the twentieth century one quickly observes from his writings and writings about him that he lived a fruitful and exemplary life he is also the author of turmoil in new mexi a new mexican shaman and pi is up against a shape shifting adversary who haunts his worst nightmares in a fascinating and absolutely eerie mystery thrilling detective after a savage confrontation with his archenemy sonny baca is confined to a wheelchair the doctors don t know if he ll ever walk again and now the chicano pi is plagued by disturbing dreams of his female ancestors being abducted the reality is even more chilling in present day santa fe the mayor s sixteen year old daughter has disappeared the four black feathers found on consuelo romero s bed confirm sonny s fears three more girls will go missing before raven s master plan becomes a terrifying reality a charismatic chameleonlike power broker who also possesses a shaman s gifts raven lures radical environmentalists into committing terrorist acts under the guise of antinuclear protests but his true agenda is to bring down sonny once and for all by obliterating sonny s dreams the portal into the spirit world he will destroy his past and his future the only way to fight back is for sonny to enter raven s own dream state but can he rid the world of an evil that refuses to die rich in atmosphere and setting this stellar series offers both edge of your seat mystery and one man s journey into the complex landscape of the soul

in walks in literary santa fe you will explore the storytelling traditions and cultural history of new mexico and familiar landmarks this guidebook reveals the stories of historical and legendary figures that have lived in and written about the land of enchantment and its storied capital city an entertaining reference on regional literature and culture for residents and visitors alike this volume includes a southwest literary timeline southwest literature bibliography a list of new mexico s literary classics plus contact details for local literary organizations booksellers and publishers along with information on regional writers retreats and conferences for nearly fifty years fort bridger played a role in all major events of the 19th century rocky mountain frontier and westering experience founded in 1842 by mountain man jim bridger this southwestern wyoming post was one of the most important outfitting points for travelers on the oregon trail riders of the pony express the overland stage and the union pacific railroad trappers buffalo hunters forty niners soldiers and outlaws would pass through what is now the fort bridger state historic site this post or fort is used as a basis for an illustrated account of the rocky mountain west the book explores reasons why american indian behavior varied between helpfulness and aggression toward mountain men and emigrants also detailed are weapons of the frontier fort bridger s role in the 1857 mormon war the 1867 wind river mountains gold rush and the great diamond hoax of 1872 several appendices are presented including a discussion of gender in the westering movement and a selected chronology of frontier history interesting and highly detailed excerpts are taken from such primary sources as a trapper s journal and an 1850 account of buffalo butchering

the rugged scenery of the new mexico territory formed a dramatic backdrop for get rich quick schemes and brazen acts of violence the cast included serial killers cattle thieves train robbers and other evildoers who simply did not know when to quit roving bandits like the black jack ketchum gang disturbed the peace along with outlaw lawmen like albuquerque s milton yarberry donna blake birchell recounts the incredible exploits and fantastic tales of new mexico s shamelessly dangerous characters
