a new history of christianity in china written by one of the world s the leading writers on christianity in china looks at christianity s long history in china its extraordinarily rapid rise in the last half of the twentieth century and charts its future direction provides the first comprehensive history of christianity in china an important understudied area in both asian studies and religious history traces the transformation of christianity from an imported western religion to a thoroughly chinese religion contextualizes the growth of christianity in china within national and local politics offers a portrait of the complex religious scene in china today contrasts china with other non western societies where christianity is surging

this book s compelling analysis examines the narratives surrounding us china relations from early american perspectives to the present day revealing enduring perceptions of china that continue to significantly influence policy decisions as revealed through discourse americans find china to be an amalgam of the curious and fantastic a swirling kaleidoscope of emotion and intellectual challenge 19th century depictions of china amounted to an odd assortment of images that did not add up to a single cohesive vision 20th century perceptions about china merged ancient philosophers with political leaders knitted ancient philosophy with socialist ideals and amplified the exotic while minimizing the more mundane evoking a spectrum of american passions hopes and fears in the 21st century this swirling kaleidoscope continues to shape american perspectives on china the book offers a unique examination of the complex history of the modern world s most important bilateral relationship through the lens of discourse analysis it provides a fresh perspective unveiling previously overlooked narratives illuminating the dynamics between these global powerhouses and suggesting pathways for the future

angela ki che leung s meticulous study begins with the classical annals of the imperial era which contain the first descriptions of a feared and stigmatized disorder modern researchers now identify as leprosy she then tracks the relationship between the disease and china s social and political spheres theories of contagion prompted community and statewide efforts at segregation religious traditions buddhism and daoism ascribed redemptive meaning to those suffering from the disease and evolving medical discourse chinese doctors have contested the disease s etiology for centuries leprosy even pops up in chinese folklore attributing the spread of the contagion to contact with immoral women leung next places the history of leprosy into a global context of colonialism racial politics and imperial danger a perceived global pandemic in the late nineteenth century seemed to confirm westerners fears that chinese immigration threatened public health therefore battling to contain if not eliminate the disease became a central mission of the modernizing state building projects of the late qing empire the nationalist government of the first half of the twentieth century and the people s republic of china stamping out the curse of leprosy was the first step toward achieving hygienic modernity and erasing the cultural and

economic backwardness associated with the disease leung's final move connects china's experience with leprosy to a larger history of public health and biomedical regimes of power exploring the cultural and political implications of china's sino western approach to the disease

it took the death of tiny baby rose for a young man to demonstrate that every single life has value even those of fragile disabled children she seemed insignificant but her life mattered and sharing her story means she will never be forgotten hundreds of children have received love hope and opportunity because of rose's short life and that number grows daily china's oasis is the story about international china concern and david gotts who started it at the age of 22 icc provides love hope and opportunity for china's abandoned and disabled children they operate orphanages in three locations in china changsha hengyang and sanmenxia supported by eight national offices around the world over three hundred children have received full time life changing care and the same number again have been adopted we hold many firsts for ngo work in china this book shows that ordinary people can do extraordinary things through faith and love

welsh baptist missionary to china timothy richard 1845 1919 was once widely regarded as one of the greatest missionaries whom any branch of the church whether roman catholic russian orthodox or protestant has sent to china today few have heard of richard and his remarkable lifetime of ministry in china as the first critical examination of richard's missionary identity this groundbreaking historical study traces the narrative of richard's early life in wales and his formative first two decades of service in china richard's adaptations to the common evangelistic techniques of his day his interest in learning from grassroots chinese sectarian religions his integration of evangelism and famine relief during the north china famine 1876 79 his strategic decision to evangelize chinese elites and his complicated relationships with hudson taylor and other china missionaries are all explored through the writings and personal letters of richard and his contemporaries the resulting portrait represents a significant revision to existing interpretations of this influential china missionary emphasizing his deep empathy for the people of china and his abiding evangelical identity readable and relevant encountering china provides a new generation with an introduction to this lost legend of china mission

is religion disappearing from american life less than 50 percent of americans now hold membership in any religious institution and even fewer attend worship services the decline in christian churches is especially pronounced among the young and cuts across all denominations but for methodists and like minded protestants concerns are deeper than shrinking denominational membership polls show disconcerting ignorance about religious and spiritual matters even among churchgoers our values as a society are in large measure molded by religion what shape will protestant christianity take in the twenty first century and of methodism and beyond that what kind of community will we be dawsey proposes returning to the roots of christianity and with anecdotes and stories and a sweeping grasp of church history he examines those essential practices and beliefs necessary to revitalize american churches key he argues is

rediscovering christianity as a philosophy of living john wesley characterized the practice of religion as first doing no harm second doing good and third keeping the ordinances of faith loving god and god s creation the doing of christianity marks the path for becoming the churches and individuals christians were called to be

the core argument of this book is that china poses both challenges and creates opportunities for africa and that the transformative potentials of china africa engagements can be compared to africa s experiences with european colonialism however it would be patently misleading to claim any equivalence between african experiences of european colonialism with africa s engagements with china although china does not replicate the exact colonial model its actions have all elements of dependent relations thus underpinning neo colonialism with chinese characteristics analysing china s growing economic relations with africa this book posits that africa s underdevelopment situation with china does not indicate a significant point of departure from the colonial model of development because china s actions in africa although not exactly colonial have all possibilities of neocolonialist model with chinese characteristics as such the author argues that china s increasing trade fdi inflow and influence on the economic growth and development in africa will result in a long term negative impact in development outcomes and capacity building governance practice democratic transition and human rights for future self reliance and sustainable development

it was not the european and american churches which evangelised africa but the mission societies the missions from the great awakening such as the london missionary society and church missionary society or the holy ghost fathers and the white fathers which started the process of sub saharan africa becoming a christian continent are well known and documented less known and less documented are the interdenominational faith missions which began in 1873 with the aim of visiting the still unreached areas of africa north africa the sudan belt and the congo basin missions such as the africa inland mission or sudan interior mission gave birth to some of the big churches like ecwa in nigeria and africa inland church in kenya it is the aim of this book to describe faith missions and their theology and to present an overview of the early development of faith missions insofar as they touched africa

george d johnson s what will a man give in exchange for his soul is an extensive study of men and women who gave their lives to christ for the sake of others men have exchanged their souls for much power wealth and success when the envious pharisees asked christ which was the greatest commandment in the law in essence he told them that loving god and their fellow man are the only two laws for which men can exchange their souls anything apart from this means they will fall short of god s expectations and johnson s sophisticated treatise illustrates this fact

from 1807 when the first protestant missionary arrived in china to the 1920s when a new phase of growth began thousands of missionaries and chinese christians labored often under very adverse conditions to lay the groundwork for a solid healthy and self sustaining chinese church following an introduction that sets the scene and surveys the entire period builders of the chinese church contains the stories of nine leading pioneers seven missionaries and two chinese here we meet robert morrison the heroic translator liang fa the first chinese evangelist missionary scholar james legge j hudson taylor founder of the china inland mission converted opium addict pastor hsi overcomer of demons griffith john and jonathan goforth both indefatigable preachers and the idealistic advocates of education and reform w a p martin and timothy richard readers will be inspired by their courage devotion and sheer perseverance in arduous work and will gain an understanding of the roots of the two branches of today s chinese protestantism

in 1927 Chiang Kai-shek the head of China's military academy and leader of the Kuomintang KMT began the northern expeditions to bring China's northern territories back under the control of the state. It was during this period that the KMT purged communist activities, fractured the army, and sparked the Chinese civil war which would rage for over twenty years. The communists led by General Mao Tse-tung were for much of the period forced underground and concentrated in the Chinese countryside. As the author argues, this resulted in China's war featuring unusually high levels of espionage and sabotage and increased the military importance of information gathering. Based on newly declassified material, Panagiotis Dimitrakis charts the double crossings, secret meetings, and bloody assassinations which would come to define China's future uniquely. The Secret War for China gives equal weighting to the role of foreign actors, the role of British intelligence in unmasking communist international Comintern agents in China, for example, and the allies' attempts to turn nationalist China against the Japanese. The Secret War for China also documents the clandestine confrontation between Mao and Chiang and the secret negotiations between Chiang and the Axis powers whose forces he employed against the CCP. Once the Second World War was over, in his turn Mao employed nationalist forces who had defected during the last three years of the civil war. About 105 out of 869 KMT generals defected to the CCP. This book is an urgent and necessary guide to the intricacies of the Chinese civil war, a war which decisively shaped the modern Asian world.

After two volumes mainly introductory, Dr. Needham now embarks upon his systematic study of the development of the natural sciences in China. The sciences of the earth follow: geography and cartography, geology, seismology, and mineralogy. Dr. Needham distinguishes parallel traditions of scientific cartography and religious cosmography in East and West, discussing orbocentric wheel maps, the origins of the rectangular grid system, sailing charts, and relief maps. Chinese survey methods and the impact of Renaissance cartography on the East. Finally, and here Dr. Needham's work has no Western predecessors, there are full accounts of the Chinese contribution to geology and mineralogy.

the lingua franca role of english coupled with its status as the official language of asean has important implications for language policy and language education these include the relationship between english the respective national languages of asean and thousands of local languages how can the demand for english be balanced against the need for people to acquire their national language and mother tongue while many will also need a regional lingua franca they are learning english as the first foreign language from primary school in all asean countries might not this early introduction of english threaten local languages and children s ability to learn or can english be introduced and taught in such a way that it can complement local languages rather than replace them the aim of this book is to explore questions such as these and then make recommendations on language policy and language education for regional policymakers the book will be important for regional policymakers and language education professionals it should also benefit language teachers especially but by no means exclusively english language teachers the book will be of interest to all who are interested in the development of english as an international language and the possible implications of this upon local languages and cultures andy kirkpatrick is chair professor of english as an international language at the hong kong institute of education and director of the institute s research centre into language education and acquisition in multilingual societies his research interests include the development of regional varieties of english and the history of chinese rhetoric much research has been carried out on varieties of english used in southeast asia but how intelligible these varieties are to others and whether a shift towards an international standard variety occurs in interactions between people from the region has been much less discussed this volume which provides a comprehensive account of the roles and functions of english in asean and gives a linguistic description of the english spoken in the region followed by an approach to teaching english called the multilingual model is therefore a welcome contribution to studies on english in asia azirah hashim professor of english university of malaya
