regional transformation has emerged as a major topic of research during the past few decades much of it seeking to understand how a region changes into a zone of conflict or cooperation and how and why some regions remain in perpetual conflict although the leading theoretical paradigms of international relations have something to say about regional order a comprehensive treatment of this subject is missing from the literature this book suggests that cross paradigmatic engagement on regional orders can be valuable if it can generate theoretically innovative testable propositions and policy relevant ideas the book brings together scholars from the dominant ir perspectives aiming to explain the regional order issue through multidimensional and multi causal pathways and seeking meeting points between them using insights from ir theory the contributors offer policy relevant ideas which may benefit conflict ridden regions of the world

object relations theory and clinical psychoanalysis is a collection of kernberg s papers published or presented during the period from 1966 to 1975 with some new material included as well

metaphors constitute a fundamental way in which humans understand the world around them this book offers a comprehensive analysis of metaphors in theories of international relations until recently conscious attention to metaphors in theories of international relations has been haphazard and sporadic this book examines the metaphors that inform the major paradigms in international relations theory readers will discover that the vast majority of the terminology cataloguing defining and naming theories concepts and analytical tools pertaining to the study of international relations are metaphorical in nature the book concludes that metaphors are an essential element in all aspects of international relations theory

beginning with the basic premise that public relations can best be understood as a specialized type of communication the contributors to this volume establish public relations as a vital and viable realm for communication research and theory development through the application of communication theories they attempt to explain and predict public relations practices and then use these practices to develop communication theories their discussions fall into three distinct categories metatheory theory and examples of applications of theories an ideal volume for professionals and students in communication journalism and related fields

w r d fairbairn 1889 1964 challenged the dominance of freud s drive theory with a psychoanalytic theory based on the internalization of human relationships fairbairn assumed that the unconscious develops in childhood and contains dissociated memories of parental neglect insensitivity and outright abuse that are impossible the children to tolerate consciously in fairbairn s model these dissociated memories protect developing children from recognizing how badly they are being treated and allow them to remain attached even to physically abusive parents attachment is paramount in fairbairn s model as he recognized that children are absolutely and unconditionally dependent on their parents kidnapped children who remain attached to their abusive captors despite opportunities to escape illustrate this intense dependency even into adolescence at the heart of fairbairn s model is a structural theory that organizes actual relational events into three self and object pairs one conscious pair the central ego which relates exclusively to the ideal object in the external world and two mostly unconscious pairs the child s antilibidinal ego which relates exclusively to the rejecting parts of the object and the child s libidinal ego which relates exclusively to the exciting parts of the object the two dissociated self and object pairs remain in the unconscious but can emerge and suddenly take over the individual s central ego when they emerge the other is misperceived as either an exciting or a rejecting object thus turning these internal structures into a source of transferences and reenactments fairbairn s central defense mechanism splitting is the fast shift from central ego dominance to either the libidinal ego or the antilibidinal ego a near perfect model of the borderline personality disorder in this book david celani reviews fairbairn s five foundational papers and outlines their application in the clinical setting he discusses the four unconscious structures and offers the clinician concrete suggestions on how to recognize and respond to them effectively in the heat of the clinical interview incorporating decades of experience into his analysis celani emphasizes the internalization of the therapist as a new good object and devotes entire sections to the treatment of histrionic obsessive and borderline personality disorders

bringing together leading scholars from asia and the west this book investigates how the dynamics of china s rise in world politics contributes to theory building in international relations ir the book demonstrates how the complex and transformative nature of

china's advancement is also a point of departure for theoretical innovation and reflection in IR more broadly in doing so the volume builds a strong case for a genuinely global and post western IR it contends that non western countries should not only be considered potential sources of knowledge production but also original and legitimate focuses of IR theorizing in their own right

this book calls for a reappraisal of liberalism in IR theory based on the first comprehensive analysis of the ideas by David Hume Ludwig von Mises and Friedrich Hayek and a new perspective on Adam Smith and international relations the analysis shows that classical liberalism differs substantially from other forms of liberalism

international relations IR theory has seen a proliferation of competing and increasingly trenchant worldviews with no consensus on how to evaluate their relative strengths and weakness this innovative new text provides an original interpretation of how best to navigate the clash of perspectives in contemporary IR theory the book provides a systematic overview of the main worldviews such as realism liberalism and constructivism and their associated theoretical underpinnings placing liberal internationalism at the heart of the debate it argues that the main division in IR theory is between liberal internationalism and its critics Griffiths examines both the strengths and weaknesses of liberal internationalism as a worldview and also explores the competing worldviews that have been generated by the perceived flaws of this perspective examination of crucial policy issues is incorporated throughout the text restoring the relevance of theory for those who wish to understand those policy issues moreover this book revitalises the *raison d'être* of contemporary IR theory and shows the role it can play in making sense of the twenty first century

globalization has been contested in recent times among the critical perspectives is cosmopolitanism yet with the exception of normative theory international relations as a field has ignored cosmopolitan thinking this book redresses this gap and develops a dialogue between cosmopolitanism and international relations the dialogue is structured around three debates between non universalist theories of international relations and contemporary cosmopolitan thought the theories chosen are realism post marxism and postmodernism all three criticize liberalism in the international domain and therefore cosmopolitanism as an offshoot of liberalism in the light of each school's respective critique of universalism the book suggests both the importance and difficulty of the cosmopolitan perspective in the contemporary world Beardsworth emphasizes the need for global leadership at nation state level re embedding of the world economy a cosmopolitan politics of the lesser violence and cosmopolitan political judgement he also suggests research agendas to situate further contemporary cosmopolitanism in international relations theory this book will appeal to all students of political theory and international relations especially those who are seeking more

articulation of the main issues between cosmopolitanism and its critics in international relations

a well established community of american scholars has long dominated the discipline of international relations recently however certain strands of continental theorizing are being introduced into the mainstream this is a critical examination of european approaches to international relations theory suggesting practical ways of challenging mainstream thought freidrichs presents a detailed sociological analysis of knowledge production in existing european ir communities namely france italy and scandinavia he also discusses a selection of european schools and approaches

since the 1980s the discipline of international relations has seen a series of disputes over its foundations however there has been one core concept that although addressed in various guises had never been explicitly and systematically engaged with in these debates the human this volume is the first to address comprehensively the topic of the human in world politics it comprises cutting edge accounts by leading scholars of how the human is or is not theorized across the entire range of ir theories old and new the authors provide a solid foundation for future debates about how why and to which ends the human has been or must not be built into our theories and systematically lay out the implications of such moves for how we come to see world politics and humanity's role within it
