do white people bear moral responsibility for racial disparities are white christians under a spiritual mandate to make racial equity a priority clifford williams taught philosophy at christian colleges for many years including a course on race he has journeyed alongside students as they gained insights about racism in this book he draws from deeply personal stories as he shows the need for white christians to recognize the impact of racism and to cultivate key character traits which enable them to pursue racial equity in succinct and thoughtful prose interwoven with first person accounts of racialized experiences by people of color williams describes the importance of the golden rule the power and effects of racial socialization and the harm racism does to those who harbor it he asks the haunting question why do white people react so strongly to black power he explains why widespread church integration in the united states may never exist he unpacks the concept of white identity and links police brutality to faulty moral perception this book gently explains what white christians need to do to make racial equity a priority

the twenty first century has seen violence thunder back onto the stage of history religious political social cultural and economic constituents and interests thus contribute to the local and global manifestations of violence in our interconnected

and contracting global world firmly embedded within the field of religion the authors of this volume concede that religious motifs and impulses are alive and well in this unfolding of bloodshed it is no wonder then that in our volatile historical age religious fundamentalism and illiberal nationalism have emerged as dominant contemporary movements against this backdrop the contributors to this edited book look back in order to move forward by reflecting upon the truth force satyagraha that grounded and guided mohandas karamchand gandhi 1869 1948 on the heels of several commemorations in 2019 of the 150th anniversary of gandhi s birth we reexamine the truths of his philosophy and nonviolent strategy to resist religious and political fundamentalisms embracing truth was for gandhi the only way to achieve complete freedom poorna swaraj the goal of freedom which gandhi conceptualized as profoundly personal expansively communitarian and organically ecological emanates from a firm grasp of truth

finding our voice is a series of meditations on how to express the deepest sense of who we are in a troubled world what is the core of our being how do we find the language to name that core if the core of our faith is identifying and embodying the prophetic for our time surviving that naming is as challenging as finding our voice often as not the prophetic lands us in hot water we feel alone and abandoned recognizing others in the same situation is crucial to our ability to hold fast with others our voice grows more certain and finds a home even in exile soon the community we left is replaced by a new community of fellow travelers we are not alone

gypsies and the british imagination 1807 1930 is the first book to explore fully the british obsession with gypsies throughout the nineteenth century and into the twentieth deborah epstein nord traces various representations of gypsies in the works of such well known british authors john clare walter scott william wordsworth george eliot arthur conan doyle and d h lawrence nord also exhumes lesser known literary ethnographic and historical texts exploring the fascinating histories of nomadic writer george borrow the gypsy lore society dora yates and other rarely examined figures and institutions gypsies were both idealized and reviled by victorian and early twentieth century britons associated with primitive desires lawlessness cunning and sexual excess gypsies were also objects of antiquarian literary and anthropological interest as nord demonstrates british writers and artists drew on gypsy characters and plots to redefine and reconstruct cultural and racial difference national and personal identity and the individual s relationship to social and sexual orthodoxies gypsies were long associated with pastoral conventions and in the nineteenth century came to stand in for the ancient british past using myths

of switched babies gypsy kidnappings and the gypsies murky origins authors projected onto gypsies their own desires to escape convention and their anxieties about the ambiguities of identity the literary representations that nord examines have their roots in the interplay between the notion of gypsies as a separate often despised race and the psychic or aesthetic desire to dissolve the boundary between english and gypsy worlds by the beginning of the twentieth century she argues romantic identification with gypsies had hardened into caricature a phenomenon reflected in d h lawrence s *the virgin and the gipsy* and thoroughly obscured the reality of gypsy life and history

howard thurman scholars explore the life and work of the twentieth century black theologian and spiritual writer

when justinian became sole ruler of the byzantine empire in a d 527 he ordered the preparation of three compilations of roman law that together formed the *corpus juris civilis* these works have become known individually as the code which collected the legal pronouncements of the roman emperors the institutes an elementary student s textbook and the digest by far the largest and most highly prized of the three compilations the digest was assembled by a team of sixteen academic lawyers commissioned by justinian in 529 to cull everything of value from earlier roman law it was for centuries the focal point of legal education in the west and remains today an unprecedented collection of the commentaries of roman jurists on the civil law commissioned by the commonwealth fund in 1978 alan watson assembled a team of thirty specialists to produce this magisterial translation which was first completed

and published in 1985 with theodor mommsen's latin text of 1878 on facing pages this paperback edition presents a corrected english language text alone with an introduction by alan watson links to the three other volumes in the set volume 1 books 1-15 volume 3 books 30-40 volume 4 books 41-50

in 1935 at the height of his powers howard thurman one of the most influential african american religious thinkers of the twentieth century took a pivotal trip to india that would forever change him and that would ultimately shape the course of the civil rights movement in the united states when thurman 1899-1981 became the first african american to meet with mahatma gandhi he found himself called upon to create a new version of american christianity one that eschewed self-imposed racial and religious boundaries and equipped itself to confront the enormous social injustices that plagued the united states during this period gandhi's philosophy and practice of satyagraha or soul force would have a momentous impact on thurman showing him the effectiveness of nonviolent resistance after the journey to india thurman's distinctly american translation of satyagraha into a black christian context became one of the key inspirations for the civil rights movement fulfilling gandhi's prescient words that it may be through the negroes that the unadulterated message of nonviolence will be delivered to the world thurman went on to found one of the first explicitly interracial congregations in the united states and to deeply influence an entire generation of black ministers among them martin luther king jr. visions of a better world depicts a visionary leader at a transformative moment in his life drawing from previously untapped archival material and obscurely published works quinton dixie and peter eisenstadt explore for the first time thurman's development into a towering theologian who would profoundly affect american christianity and american history

like dye cast into water liberal assumptions color everything american from ideas about human nature to fears about big government not the dreaded l word of the 1988 presidential campaign liberalism in its historical context emerged from the modern faith in free inquiry natural rights economic liberty and democratic government expressed in the nation building acts of revolution and constitution writing liberalism both structured and limited americans sense of reality for two centuries the nation's scholars were unable to break away from liberalism's pervasive hold on the american mind until the last generation when they recovered the lost world of classical republicanism ornate aristocratic prescriptive and concerned with the common good this form of republicanism held sway among the founding fathers before the triumph of liberal thought with its simple egalitarian rational and individualistic emphasis the two concepts as joyce appleby shows

posed choices for eighteenth century thinkers much as they have divided twentieth century scholars entering one of the liveliest debates in the scholarly world about our ideological roots appleby follows the labyrinthine controversies that these two perspectives have generated in their day and in ours in doing so she addresses the tensions that remain to be resolved in the democratic societies of the late twentieth century the complex relations between individual and community personal liberty and the common good aspiration and practical wisdom
