the politics of the encounter is a spirited interrogation of the city as a site of both theoretical inquiry and global social struggle the city writes andy merrifield remains important virtually and materially for progressive politics and yet he notes more than forty years have passed since henri lefebvre advanced the powerful ideas that still undergird much of our thinking about urbanization and urban society merrifield rethinks the city in light of the vast changes to our planet since 1970 when lefebvre s seminal urban revolution was first published at the same time he expands on lefebvre s notion of the right to the city which was first conceived in the wake of the 1968 student uprising in paris we need to think less of cities as entities with borders and clear demarcations between what s inside and what s outside and emphasize instead the effects of planetary urbanization a concept of lefebvre s that merrifield makes relevant for the ways we now experience the urban the city from tahrir square to occupy wall street seems to be the critical zone in which a new social protest is unfolding yet dissenters aspirations are transcending the scale of the city physically and philosophically consequently we must shift our perspective from the right to the city to the politics of the encounter says merrifield we must ask how revolutionary crowds form where they draw their energies from what kind of spaces they occur in and what kind of new spaces they produce

this book began when the author realised that when people said they were fascinated by particular biblical passages they were usually ones that presented dramatic encounters between people and between god and people such are the passages interpreted in this book they usually set a vivid scene that heightens the dramatic nature of the encounter and animated dialogue often directly addresses the reader there is also animated action that is vividly striking and often sudden and unexpected these features involve the readers themselves and may question them about what they expect indeed the dramatic encounters provocatively lead to unexpected new life in the future

as a young priest luigi giussani was troubled by catholicism's inability to effectively deal with secularism or laicism in 1954 he began to develop a vision of faith rooted in experience his ideas resonated with students and led to the birth of the gioventù studentesca student youth movement known today as communion and liberation the movement is flourishing in italy and around the world including canada the united states brazil uganda and britain the journey to truth is an experience is the first english translation of *il cammino al vero è un'esperienza* giussani's early works on the christian experience written from 1959-64 it begins with a guide on how to live the christian life within the student youth community followed by a call to base one's relationship with christ on the example set by the apostles and other figures in the new testament giussani concludes by outlining the movement's mission and the possibility for community charity and communion in the christian life

exile constitutes one of the most central experiences in the bible notably in the book of genesis the question has rarely been asked however as to why exile plays such an important role in the lives of biblical characters biblical portraits of exile proposes a philosophical reading largely inspired by the philosophy of emmanuel levinas of the experience of exile in the book of genesis focusing on the 8 central figures of exile adam eve cain the sons of shem abraham rebekah jacob and the sons of levy the book draws out the ethical and redemptive implications of exile and thereby paves the way for a renewed description of the human subject one that situates ethics at its very core

while the 1914 christmas truces have a mythological status in british culture intimate interactions with the enemy are this interdisciplinary edited collection shows a staple of modern warfare spanning multiple conflicts around the world from the nineteenth century to the present russia ukraine war the chapters consider how fellow feeling with the enemy during war has been both fueled and limited by constellations of class gender nationality race religion sexuality and shared experience scrutinizing asymmetries of power in enemy encounters the instability of divisions between allies and enemies and the heterogeneity of experiences within one army or side contributors to this book confront a central question how far is thinking of the enemy as an equal in some way a precondition for non violent interactions with them in war in some cases the ease of fraternization and reciprocity between the lines raises questions about the necessity of a clear feeling of enmity for fighting to continue while in others exclusionary attitudes based on racial or colonial hierarchies or the criminality of irregular warfare result in extreme violence and differential valuations of enemy lives

difficult empathy takes up the question of empathy as fundamentally a rhetorical concern focusing on the ways we encounter and understand one another in what we read and write hear and say the book centres around the argument that empathy as a rhetorical event occurs not simply in the minds of individuals but as a product of the rhetorical situations practices cultures and values in which we engage rather than identifying empathy as a cure all or jettisoning the concept altogether the author acknowledges empathy s potential as well as its limitations by focusing on what makes empathy a hard and ultimately worthwhile practice this nuanced and original study will interest scholars working at the intersection of

rather as participating in a religious mainstream that had been radically altered by the disappearance of any kind of mandatory or regular spiritual direction a problem which was further complicated and exacerbated by the rise of science thus this study contributes to a reconfiguration of our notion of what religious orthodoxy really meant during the period and calls into question our own assumptions about what is or was orthodox and heterodox
