in this prose adaptation of the classic graphic novel tony stark selects a dangerous upgrade for iron man to tackle a deadly new enemy after revealing his secret identity as iron man tony stark aims to engineer a better world he is shifting the focus of stark industries from destructive weapons to life improving technologies with his revelation and his plan tony expects fame and adulation but he is only going to get more trouble after suffering a tragic public failure tony knows he must improve iron man if he ever hopes to defeat a devastating new threat one solution is a potentially lethal techno organic virus known as extremis it will grant tony more power than he has ever known and test his spirit to the breaking point adapted from the graphic novel by warren ellis and adi granov praise for iron man extremis javins is a masterful writer when it comes to convincing the reader of the sensory details of travel of locations and their character and even more adept at portraying characters in a psychologically realistic way the dialogue is as sharp appealing and funny as the films are known for and are windows into character personality as well the beat

tony evans life has reached a breaking point his longtime wife has filed for divorce and left with their daughter nicki in tony s darkest hour he is laid off from the only career he has ever known as a reporter for the san francisco chronicle tony has become a fading relic in today s information age and feels pushed aside until he is summoned to san quentin prison s death row at the request of serial killer and condemned prisoner reynaldo ramirez ramirez asks tony to publish the tales of his murderous exploits during his final week on death row

an initially dismissive tony soon discovers that he cannot turn the request down after he learns that ramirez s evil extends beyond his prison cell he has had tony s beloved daughter kidnapped if the stories fail to appear in the paper she dies tony struggles against the clock to glean the significance of every story that ramirez tells searching for clues to his daughter s whereabouts tony complies with the requests in order to buy time and to uncover the secrets which will keep his daughter from becoming reynaldo ramirez s final victim can tony find nicki before the final tolling of the zero hour

this multiple protagonist series with numerous points of view pov centres around five college students about to begin their academic careers three of those five are boys who were childhood buddies and the other two are females who they met in college a side story about ms editor and mr author who are writing and editing the main story is also included in the series this section contains three storylines 1 the main ml and fl 2 the side characters of this section and 3 ms editor and mr author first story the female lead on her first day of college noticed a group of three boys arguing with college professors and she thought that they were delinquents later she became friends with those boys and started liking one of them they are both completely opposite in everything the only thing that is the same about them is that they are both human beings but she doesn t know that the boy she likes already has a partner which is more than a girlfriend but less than a wife why it s because they have been married for some years and their father and mother have also been friends since childhood before our female lead confesses to him her own mom requests that she find a stranger a boy whom she meets in the garden that stranger helped her mom make a big decision that is going to change their lives for real still our female lead ignored her mom s request to find that stranger a boy and planned to confess the boy she liked from her friend circle neglecting everything she confessed to him in the garden he second story our second male lead s note he s a side character in this part college doesn t start as he thought it would on his first day of college he fell in love at first sight when he saw a very beautiful girl coming near his bus stop he thought college life was going to be fun but he didn t know that the author had planned something else for his tale the girl whom he thought would be his future partner left their bus in a private car he recovered from the tragic first day of college but not fully after a few days his one and only girl friend on whom he had a crush for many years directed him to date one of the girls with whom he became friends in college he accepted that request from his friend but also told her that he would wait for love at first sight no matter how long it took side story ms editor and mr author mr author is writing the main story and ms editor is his partner and is helping him in his work they have been a couple since their college days but still they re not living together it s because according to mr author it s very hard to control himself around ms editor in his own apartment and also ms editor is a professional editor and earns at least five times more money than mr author who has only published a 20 page essay until now mr author gets a great response from everyone who reads that essay and that s why he decided to become an author mr author is an independent author

when tony caruso is hired to go undercover for the u s fish and wildlife service he has no idea that his life will change forever in the remote mountains of oregon he is tasked to track down an asian ring of smugglers who are killing black bears for gallbladders and shooting elk and deer in velvet for their antlers he narrowly escapes with his life but follows the smugglers to portland eventually he ends up in the southern cascades in the mushroom fields where he must fight not only the asian game smugglers but asian gangs from san francisco and seattle as tony tightens the noose around the smugglers the case becomes personal now he must encounter these brutal killers in the remote forest where his survival depends on his own military training and his favorite sidekick panzer his giant schnauzer and former german military working dog

english is not the native language of the author miguel estrada reason why he felt the need to write in simple easy reading english language this mix of fiction non fiction romantic adventurous book novel he bases the fiction part of his book in one of his many love songs

hes written besides adding a little humor he also explores how abandonment can sometimes haunt even the most successful among us in the non fiction part he likes to share with the world all the struggles and adversities he endured growing up as a multi racial child in a small village of the atlantic coast of his native panama in central america and all the difficulties he went through as he hitchhiked his way from his country to the u s not knowing for sure where he was going let alone the english language he also speaks of the government corruption that goes on in his country and many other third world countries which compelled him to leave home in search of a better life for him and his family he also emphasizes a great deal of gratitude throughout his book but most of all he emphasizes gratitude through the whole book

manchild tells the heartbreaking story of a young boy named jon born and raised in brooklyn new york the child along with his mother endure endless persecution both physically and psychologically throughout the story the boy beaten severely abused and sexually assaulted before the age of seven sets the journey for early manhood with a strong and unbroken will to survive men war among one another in the streets of new york inner city neighborhoods provide the background for bookmaking numbers racketing and loan sharking animal instincts versus violent intelligence make for formidable opponents the child fades to the background at times as the madness continues but just as the adults are jon is always there as well take the journey but be prepared to encounter a scenario that will propel you to levels far beyond human comprehension perhaps you may smile every now and then but it will not last very long anger alone will drive you through this story like a runaway train

wichita private detective mitch roberts is asked by a distraught father to find his son the search leads roberts into a dead end of drug dealing and crooked cops not to mention the dangerous carlotta granger daughter of a police captain gaylord dold is the author of fifteen works of fiction including the highly acclaimed private detective series featuring mitch roberts a well as numerous contemporary crime thrillers many of his novels have been singled out for awards and praise by a number of critics and writer's organizations
