the many canons of tibetan buddhism is one of the first publications to include scholarship on both the mainstream tibetan canons of translated buddhist classics and the alternative canons of literature of the nyingma sectarian traditions

one of the greatest american dramatists of the 20th century tennessee williams is known for his sensitive characterizations poetic yet realistic writing ironic humor and depiction of harsh realities in human relationship his work is frequently included in high school and college curricula and his plays are continually produced critical companion to tennessee williams includes entries on all of williams

s major and minor works including a streetcar named desire cat on a hot tin roof the glass menagerie a novel a collection of short stories two poetry collections and personal essays places and events related to his works major figures in his life his literary influences and issues in williams scholarship and criticism appendixes include a complete list of williams s works a list of research libraries with significant williams holdings and a bibliography of primary and secondary sources

tennessee williams plays are performed around the world and are staples of the standard american repertory his famous portrayals of women engage feminist critics and as america s leading gay playwright from the repressive postwar period through stonewall to the growth of gay liberation he represents an important and controversial figure for queer theorists gross and his contributors have included all of his plays a chronology introduction and bibliography

meticulously edited and annotated tennessee williams s notebooks follow his growth as a writer from his undergraduate days to the publication and production of his most famous plays from his drug addiction and drunkenness to the heights of his literary accomplishments

the plays of tennessee williams are some of the greatest triumphs of the american theatre if williams is not the most important american playwright he surely is one of the two or three most celebrated rivaled only by eugene o neill and arthur miller in a career that spanned almost five decades he created an extensive canon of more than 70 plays his contributions to the american theatre are inestimable and revolutionary the glass menagerie 1945 introduced poetic realism to the american stage a streetcar named desire 1947 explored sexual and psychological issues that had never before been portrayed in american culture cat on a hot tin roof 1955 dared to challenge the political and sexual mores of the eisenhower era and his plays of the 1970s are among the most innovative works produced on the american stage but williams was far more than a gifted and prolific playwright he created two collections of poetry two novels four collections of stories memoirs and scores of essays because of his towering presence in american drama williams has attracted the attention of some of the most insightful scholars and critics of the twentieth century the 1990s in particular ushered in a renaissance of williams research including a definitive biography a descriptive bibliography and numerous books and scholarly articles this reference book synthesizes the vast body of research on tennessee williams and offers a performance history of his works under the guidance of one of the leading authorities on williams expert contributors have written chapters on each of williams works or clusters of works each chapter includes a discussion of the biographical context of a work or group of writings a survey of the bibliographic history an analysis of major critical approaches which looks at themes characters symbols and plots a consideration of the major critical problems posed by the work an overview of chief productions and film and

author annette j saddik researches tennessee williams much neglected later work from 1961 to 1983 and argues that it deserves a central place in american experimental drama offering a new reading of williams career she challenges the conventional wisdom that his later work represents a failure of his creative powers

under the ancestors eyes presents a new approach to korean social history by focusing on the origin and development of the indigenous descent group martina deuchler maintains that the surprising continuity of the descent group model gave the ruling elite cohesion and stability and enabled it to retain power from the early silla fifth century to the late nineteenth century this argument underpinned by a fresh interpretation of the late fourteenth century kory chosn transition illuminates the role of neo confucianism as an ideological and political device through which the elite regained and maintained dominance during the chosn period neo confucianism as espoused in korea did not level the social hierarchy but instead tended to sustain the status system in the late chosn it also provided ritual models for the lineage building with which local elites sustained their preeminence vis à vis an intrusive state though neo confucianism has often been blamed for the rigidity of late chosn society it was actually the enduring native kinship ideology that preserved the strict social status system by utilizing historical and social anthropological methodology and analyzing a wealth of diverse materials deuchler highlights korea s distinctive elevation of the social over the political

index to the lines of descendants in the gruben section and a surname index to the lines of descendants in the krmer section of the book
