nigeria despite being the african country of greatest strategic importance to the u s remains poorly understood john campbell explains why nigeria is so important to understand in a world of jihadi extremism corruption oil conflict and communal violence the revised edition provides updates through the recent presidential election

this book reflects on nigeria s fourth republic the country s longest democratic period since it gained independence from great britain it argues that although constitutional or political democracy has lasted for over two decades in nigeria and seen three successful democratic changes of power nigeria s democracy remains largely militarised during nigeria s fourth republic political and socio economic affairs have been increasingly dominated by a pervasive military presence and ideology which has seen a redistribution of resources and

government funds away from social programmes into an increase in security budgets weapons proliferation and internal military interventions and occupations this institutionalisation of violence has turned the country into a national security state where the rule of force and violence rather than dialogue and compassion reflect everyday reality whilst acknowledging the history of militarisation during colonial and military rule this book makes a compelling argument for considering the distinct character of the nigerian nation state s path to militarisation over the last 20 years of experimentation with democracy this book s fresh insights into the fourth republic s path to militarisation will be of interest to researchers of african politics security and development

the problems and challenges of the niger delta predate nigeria as a republic the resultant violence can be traced to 1966 when the late isaac boro and his colleagues attempted to secede from nigeria due in large part to the underdevelopment of the region historical reality aside since 1970 oil has displaced agriculture as nigeria s primary revenue earner and it has for the last four decades been the nation s breadbasket but in spite of this the niger delta remains vastly underdeveloped and has been given the least federal presence these deficiencies led to high unemployment social dislocations youth restiveness and extralegalities it was these realities that bred disaffection with the government and the multinational oil companies and eventually to violent militancy between 2003 and 2009 it also led to low intensity conflict between militant youths and the nigerian government in the summer of 2009 however the nigerian government extended an offer of presidential pardon amnesty to the militants the amnesty program was intended to bring peace and quiet to the region however this has not been the case in spite of the financial and political resources that have been expended the region continues on the path of volatility this book looks at the issue of nationhood the cause and cost of the crisis past approaches and current efforts at solving the crisis in addition it offers a tenable solution to the decades old crisis furthermore the case is made that unless there is a fundamental restructuring of the nigerian state and its governing structure and institutions the problems of the region and the larger problems that makes the country such a difficult to place to live in and govern is likely to continue

nigeria seems to be in the news all of the time for something be it regime changes co operation internal strife or oil policies the most populous country in africa and the largest in area in the west african state nigeria was an early twentieth century colony that became an independent nation in 1960 a country of great diversity because of the many ethnic linguistic and religious groups that live within it borders nigeria is also a country with a long past this book brings together current issues and a detailed historical background

the contributors to this book examine the conceptual issues relating to the link between conflict and poverty as well as presenting case studies of countries often regarded as hot spots for conflict in africa they also explore the roles of regional and sub regional bodies and institutions in addressing the causes of poverty and mitigating the impacts of conflict on vulnerable and marginalized groups africa is often regarded as the epicentre of conflicts worldwide virtually every part of the continent is currently engulfed in one form of conflict or another beyond the loss of life conflicts have brought untold hardship to millions and have derailed social and economic development on the continent written by african academics this book is divided into three sections the first of which discusses the factors that fuel conflicts and the nature and impacts of conflicts on vulnerable groups the second section comprises case studies of south sudan central african republic nigeria ethiopia south africa uganda and cameroon these countries are representative of the sub regional dynamics of africa west east central and south reflecting the diversity of the continent the final section examines the role of key institutions and bodies in africa in mitigating the impact of conflict on the socioeconomic lives of the people in the region bodies discussed include the african union economic community of west african states southern african development community and the east african community the book will be an invaluable resource for researchers academics and policymakers working in the areas of law political science human rights peace studies development studies and african studies

movements and terrorist organizations as well as state policies that instigate intrastate conflicts in african states it examines and documents the tactics that are used by anti government forces states counterterrorism responses and the human security impacts of insecurity on citizens across various communities in africa the contributors extensive research methods include case studies that explore activities of terrorist organizations like al shabaab al qaeda boko haram and the islamic state it presents new and productive insights about counterterrorism strategies deployed by selected african states the african union and the u s a historically rich and politically focused analysis of states as co conspirators in terrorism induced insecurity in africa this book challenges existing literature on terrorism that largely focuses on the actions of non state entities it provides practical insights to policymakers that desire to end insecurity and promote inclusive governance in africa

in exploring the connections between religion violence and cities the book probes the extent to which religion moderates or exacerbates violence in an increasingly urbanised world originating in a five year research project conflict in cities and the contested state concerned with belfast jerusalem and other ethno nationally divided cities this volume widens the geographical focus to include diverse cities from the balkans the middle east nigeria and japan in addressing the understudied triangular relationships between religion violence and cities contributors stress the multiple forms taken by religion and violence while challenging the compartmentalisation of two highly topical debates links between religion and violence on the one hand and the proliferation of violent urban conflicts on the other hand their research demonstrates why cities have become so important in conflicts driven by state building fundamentalism religious nationalism and ethno religious division and illuminates the conditions under which urban environments can fuel violent conflicts while simultaneously providing opportunities for managing or transforming them this book was published as a special issue of space and polity
