draws on firsthand accounts from elvis's wife priscilla his friends and family the memphis mafia and his spiritual advisors looks at key teachers who influenced him including yogananda h p blavatsky and manly p hall examines elvis's efforts as a natural healer the significance of his ufo encounters and his telekinetic psychic and astral traveling abilities elvis presley the most successful solo artist in history and an emblematic cultural figure of the western world has been widely perceived as a conservative southern christian however the truth about the man has been missed writer and researcher miguel conner reveals how elvis was a profound mystic occultist and shaman beginning with the unusual circumstances of his birth and his stillborn twin brother conner traces the diverse thread of mysticism that runs through elvis presley's life drawing on firsthand accounts from the people closest to him including his wife priscilla the memphis mafia and his spiritual advisors he shows how elvis studied seminal 19th and 20th century occultists including h p blavatsky manly p hall g i gurdjieff and p d ouspensky and was a devotee of indian yogi paramahansa yogananda conner argues that elvis was well versed in the esoteric practices of sex magic meditation astrology and numerology and had a deep familiarity with kabbalah gnosticism theosophy and eastern traditions he also reveals how elvis was a natural healer telekinetic psychic and astral traveler who had significant mystical experiences and ufo encounters looking at the conspiratorial and paranormal aspects of elvis's life the author explores the elvis visitations that have occurred since the king's death and the general high weirdness of his life as conner convincingly argues elvis was not just a one of a kind rock and roller he was the greatest magician america ever produced

there is no other way to put it elvis is the king note the present tense even though elvis supposedly died nearly forty years ago he has lived on in our hearts as a sound as an image and as an especially vigorous personality in fact it's safe to say no other

the reverend howard finster 1916 2001 was called the backwoods william blake and the andy warhol of the south and he is considered the godfather of contemporary american folk and visionary art this book is the first interpretive analysis of the intertwined artistic and religious significance of finster s work within the context of the american outsider art tradition finster began preaching as a teenager in the south in the 1930s but it was not until he received a revelation from god at the age of sixty that he began to make sacred art a modern day noah who saw his art as a religious crusade to save the world before it was too late finster worked around the clock often subsisting on a diet of peanut butter and instant coffee he spent the last years of his life feverishly creating his environmental artwork called paradise garden and what would ultimately number almost fifty thousand works of bad and nasty art this was visionary work that obsessively combined images and text and featured apocalyptic biblical imagery flying saucers from outer space and popular cultural icons such as elvis presley marilyn monroe henry ford mona lisa and george washington in the 1980s and 90s he developed cult celebrity status and he appeared in the venice biennale and on the tonight show his work graced the album covers of bands such as r e m and talking heads this book explores the life and religious artistic significance of finster and his work from the personal perspective of religion scholar norman girardot friend to finster and his family during the later years of the artist s life

on a lazy sunday in 1954 twelve year old jerry schilling wandered into a memphis touch football game only to discover that his

team was quarterbacked by a nineteen year old elvis presley the local teenager whose first record that s all right had just debuted on memphis radio the two became fast friends even as elvis turned into the world s biggest star in 1964 elvis invited jerry to work for him as part of his memphis mafia and jerry soon found himself living with elvis full time in a bel air mansion and later in his own room at graceland over the next thirteen years jerry would work for elvis in various capacities from bodyguard to photo double to co executive producer on a karate film but more than anything else he was elvis s close friend and confidant elvis trusted jerry with protecting his life when he received death threats he asked jerry to drive him and priscilla to the hospital the day lisa marie was born and to accompany him during the famous lost weekend when he traveled to meet president nixon at the white house me and a guy named elvis looks at presley from a friend s perspective offering readers the man rather than the icon including insights into the creative frustrations that lead to elvis s abuse of prescription medicine and his tragic death jerry offers never before told stories about life inside elvis s inner circle and an emotional recounting of the great times hard times and unique times he and elvis shared these vivid memories will be priceless to elvis s millions of fans and the compelling story will fascinate an even wider audience

a thought provoking exploration of bruce springsteen s iconic album born in the u s a a record that both chronicled and foreshadowed the changing tides of modern america on june 4 1984 columbia records issued what would become one of the best selling and most impactful rock albums of all time an instant classic bruce springsteen s born in the u s a would prove itself to be a landmark not only for the man who made it but rock music in general and even the larger american culture over the next 40 years in there was nothing you could do veteran rock critic steven hyden shows exactly how this record became such a pivotal part of the american tapestry alternating between insightful criticism meticulous journalism and personal anecdotes hyden delves into the songs that made and didn t make the final cut including the tracks that wound up on its sister album 1982 s nebraska he also investigates the myriad reasons why springsteen ran from and then embraced the success of his most popular and most misunderstood lp as he carefully toed the line between balancing his commercial ambitions and being co opted by the machine but the book doesn t stop there beyond springsteen s own career hyden explores the role the album played in a greater historical context documenting not just where the country was in the tumultuous aftermath of vietnam and watergate but offering a dream of what it might become and a perceptive forecast of what it turned into decades later as springsteen himself reluctantly

barry gifford has been writing gritty american tales for the past forty years his novels stories poetry and films have helped shape the american neo noir genre the new york times book review says that he can sum up in a few words the cruelty horror and crushing banality that shape an entire life andrei codrescu calls gifford a great comic realist while pedro almodóvar likens him to the surrealist filmmaker luis buñuel and jonathan lethem describes his style as william faulkner by way of b movie film noir porn paperbacks and sun records rockabilly in the roy stories gifford brings his signature style to a collection of tales following the character of roy who has made appearances in a number of gifford's previous story collections roy lives a mystical kind of life skinning crocodiles in southern florida at age nine in the 1940s and playing in the back alleys of chicago in the 1950s this deep feeling boy observes every detail in his surroundings with a sense of dark humor and an openness that will clutch readers tightly by the heart and lead them on a historical journey

over the course of the last six decades elvis presley has sold more than a billion records his music has touched nearly every modern listener despite an avalanche of books on his life there are surprisingly few about his musical creativity in counting down elvis his 100 finest songs mark duffett urges readers to put aside the misleading stereotypes and rumor filled debates about elvis and listen once again to the legend who emerged from memphis elvis had a unique approach to music one that was both powerful and versatile in a career stretching across more than twenty years presley changed the face of popular music drawing together genres from country and blues to contemporary folk and placing a unique stamp on all of them counting down elvis his 100 finest songs explores the full range of presley recordings from his earliest numbers to posthumous hits combing through gold records and unpolished gems to distill the best that presley has to offer

in legend light separates the world the world is divided into two parts some people show their talents on the gorgeous stage while others are unknown in the dark the girl wants to go to the stage from the shadow but she never has the courage to step up it wasn't until he appeared she remembers her first meeting with elvis at that time the sun rises behind the dark clouds the rainbow appears and the young man appears in front of her he looks at her as soft as the breeze astrid is a common girl without any friends she is often bullied ridiculed ignored and forgotten in order to get other's attention she is often late for school and she does not turn in her homework one day she inadvertently breaks into another world signs a contract with count justice adopts the young dragon elvis and promises to be his master at the same time she also meets the talented and popular young master bai of milo college with the help of young master bai and elvis astrid gradually becomes brave and confident however she is immersed in love with young master bai and gradually neglects elvis after an incident of misunderstanding astrid wants to break the contract elvis sadly leaves at this time because he stays in the human world for too long but never finds the mysterious magic elvis turns into a black cat wandering around when she learns of his feelings for her astrid finally gives up the idea of breaking the contract

she wants to help him return to his own world within the limited time otherwise elvis may disappear forever love makes people happy and makes people willing to give this is the secret of love and the ultimate interpretation of love magic will astrid and elvis understand
