an intertextual commentary on romans is an exhaustive treatment of the hundreds of old testament citations allusions and echoes embedded in paul s most famous epistle as many scholars have acknowledged to understand paul s engagement with israel s scriptures is to understand romans despite this acknowledgement there is a dearth of reference works in which the primary focus is how the old testament impacts paul s argument from romans 1 1 to 16 27 this four volume commentary aims to provide just such a reference the interplay between romans and its vast sea of old testament pre texts produces unstated points of resonance that illuminate paul s rhetorical argument from the letter s opening to its closing doxology volume 2 examines the scriptural pre texts in romans 5 1 8 39 while this portion of romans contains only one full citation it is teeming with scriptural allusions and echoes that are critical to understanding paul s argumentation crisler leaves no intertextual stone unturned as he probes the subtext of one of the richest sections in the entire pauline corpus from paul s key transition in romans 5 1 to his poetic flourish in 8 31 39 and everywhere in between crisler explores the interplay between the apostle s endless engagement with israel s scriptures and his message to the christians in rome this volume contributes to the commentary s overarching aim which is to provide scholars interpreters and students with verse by verse analysis of how israel

s scriptures impact almost every clause of paul s most famous letter

the collected works of witness lee 1952 volume 2 contains messages given or published by brother witness lee in 1952 historical information concerning brother lee s travels and the content of his ministry in 1952 can be found in the general preface that appears at the beginning of this set the contents of this volume are divided into three sections as follows 1 five messages given in taipei taiwan in the summer of 1952 these messages originally appeared in the periodical the ministry of the word in 1964 and 1965 they were also previously published in a book entitled the vision ministry and leading of the lord s serving ones and are included in this volume under the same title 2 nine messages given in taipei taiwan in the summer of 1952 these messages were previously published in a book entitled how to administrate the church and are included in this volume under the same title 3 thirty four messages given in taipei taiwan on september 22 through november 7 1952 these messages are included in this volume under the title revelations in romans seeing god s complete salvation

the cretaceous was first mentioned in the legend of a geological map largely centred on france published in 1822 by jean baptiste julien d omalius d halloy two hundred years of research have demonstrated that the cretaceous records some of the highest sea levels atmospheric temperatures and extreme events in earth history it was also a time of significant palaeogeographical changes and continental fragmentation this volume draws together a collection of papers from an exceptionally wide geographical area that reflects the varied geological features of cretaceous strata and the enclosed faunas and floras there are geological accounts of areas from the arctic to the antarctic peninsula onshore and offshore environments as well as some terrestrial environments with newly described floras and faunas the application of stable isotope geochemistry to stratigraphical problems and the identification of cyclostratigraphy features quite prominently in many of the areas described

this volume contains a number of the writings categorized under the theme word and faith writings in the volume range from core documents bondage of the will against the heavenly prophets the smalcaid articles and large catechism to luther s own

confession of faith and treatments of moses the gospels and two kinds of righteousness each volume in the annotated luther series contains new introductions annotations illustrations and notes to help shed light on luther s context and interpret his writings for today

the summa theologica is the best known work of italian philosopher scholar and dominican friar saint thomas aquinas 1225 1274 widely considered the catholic church s greatest theologian famously consulted immediately after the bible on religious questions at the council of trent aquinas s masterpiece has been considered a summary of official church philosophy ever since aquinas considers approximately 10 000 questions on church doctrine covering the roles and nature of god man and jesus then lays out objections to church teachings and systematically confronts each using biblical verses theologians and

philosophers to bolster his arguments in volume iii aquinas addresses faith and heresy charity peace and war mercy anger and justice prayer truth and much more this massive work of scholarship spanning five volumes addresses just about every possible query or argument that any believer or atheist could have and remains essential more than seven hundred years after it was written for clergy religious historians and serious students of catholic thought

this book is one of four substantial volumes designed to demonstrate the range of interests of the several protestant nonconformist traditions from the time of their separatist harbingers to the end of the twentieth century in this volume we are concerned with the eighteenth century it was a period in which old dissent the congregationalists baptists presbyterians and quakers had to face challenges from enlightenment thought on the one hand and evangelical revival enthusiasm on the other largely in their own words though with introductions contributed by the editors we enter into the philosophical world of isaac watts richard price and others we overhear doctrinal disputes over the doctrine of the trinity we meet such new arrivals on the religious scene as the moravians sandemanians swedenborgians and methodists calvinistic and arminian we consider the nonconformists views on the church the ministry and the sacraments on church state and society and on christian nurture piety and church life from philosophical tomes to hymns from sacramental questions to prison reform from the most strait laced presbyterian to the most enthusiastic jumper this volume will remind scholars of the intellectual excitements the practical witness and the worship of the eighteenth century nonconformists

this volume supplements tang tales a guided reader volume 1 2010 and presents twelve more tang tales going beyond the standard corpus of these narratives to include six stories translated into english for the first time the rich annotation and translator s notes for these twelve tales provide insights into many aspects of tang material culture and medieval thought including buddhism and daoism in addition to meticulously annotated translations the book offers original texts with some textual notes and commentaries in the form of translator s notes thereby joining the first volume of tang tales as the only collections that introduce students to tang tales while also challenging specialists interested in the field

a few months after crisp died in 1643 were published a small collection of his sermons published under the title christ alone exalted and over the next 3 years 1643 46 where published two additional volumes with prefaces by mr robert lancaster mr george cockayn and mr henry pinnell these messages were all taken down in short hand writing during their delivery and compared with crisp s own sermon notes or taken from them in 1690 a new edition of these sermons was printed with an addition of ten more taken from the author s notes by his son samuel crisp and again in 1755 by john gill this edition is a fresh attempt to assemble together all the sermons of crisp in two volumes accompanied by the explanatory notes of john gill along with every preface and a new biographical sketch which may shed a bit of further light on the life of one who was of that spirit infused determination to preach nothing but christ crucified

the collected works of witness lee 1971 volume 2 contains messages given by brother witness lee from april 13 through june 20 1971 during this period brother lee remained in los angeles until the middle of may he then went to sacramento california for a weekend conference he returned to los angeles and remained there until the end of may at which time he went to san francisco for a weekend conference after returning to los angeles he traveled to houston texas where he remained for two weeks he spent the following week in atlanta georgia the contents of this volume are divided into eight sections as follows 1 twenty three messages given in los angeles california from april 13 through may 27 these messages were previously published in a twenty one chapter book entitled christ as the reality 2 a message given in los angeles california on may 23 it is included in this volume under the title following the lord by discipling the nations and feeding his sheep 3 four messages given in sacramento california on may 14 and 15 these messages are published in this volume under the title enjoying the humanity of jesus for the church 4 one message given in los angeles california on may 16 it is included in this volume under the title keeping the oneness of the body of christ 5 six messages given in san francisco california from may 28 through 31 these messages are included in this volume under the title enjoying christ as the reality of the offerings for the church life 6 three messages given in los angeles california in june the first two messages were given on june 1 and 2 and the exact date of the third message is unknown the three messages are included in this volume under the title miscellaneous messages given to the church in los

angeles 7 seventeen messages given in houston texas from june 4 through 13 these messages were previously published in a book entitled the great mystery christ and the church and are included in this volume under the same title 8 eight messages given in atlanta georgia from june 14 through 20 these messages are included in this volume under the title enjoying christ as the spirit and caring for the oneness and increase of the body of christ

this monument of rabbinical exegesis written at the end of the twelfth century has exerted an immense and continuing influence upon jewish thought its aim is to liberate people from the tormenting perplexities arising from their understanding of the bible according only to its literal meaning this edition contains extensive introductions by shlomo pines and leo strauss a leading authority on maimonides

this volume starts off by ending the last part of the first volume and then going into the human doctrine that is taught in the bible such topics such as the nature of humanity the nature of sin and what makes up the image of god within us is the bulk of the topics that are covered within this work finishing off is some talk on the doctrine of the work and office of christ and the topic of salvation and how that works out theologically

this book deals with the geological record and the evolution of ideas concerning the variscan orogenic belt in france and neighboring regions volume 1 is based on a general introduction concerning the imprint of the variscan period on the geology of france as well as on the particularities of the study of this ancient orogen a history of the concepts applied to the variscan belt is proposed in order to consider this orogen in the history of earth sciences a paleogeodynamic analysis of the variscan cycle sets the general framework for the evolution of the orogen which is then tackled through the prism of the magmatic metamorphic and tectonic record of the early phases from cambrian to lower carboniferous volume 2 proposes an analysis of the late evolution of the variscan orogenic belt reflecting its dismantling in a high temperature context during the upper carboniferous and permian the sedimentary archives are described as well as the questions raised by the specificities of this ancient orogen

a series of private disputation and letters the second book in this three volume set starts to show another view on the bible that challenges the works of john calvin martin luther and others the aspect of self determinism and the role of sin in a believer s life are dominant in arminius s thinking while the other theologians in his time were focusing on the idea of determinism in the role of biblical theology

w e vine s greatest contribution to the church of god was his expository dictionary of new testament words w e vine has put all english speaking bible students in his debt the english reader with little or no knowledge of greek has of course concordances and lexicons these provide a skeleton vine clothes it with the flesh and sinews of living exposition and in so doing makes available for the ordinary reader the expert knowledge contained in the more advanced works in a preface to the dictionary w

e vine wrote in any work in which we engage as servants of christ his word ever applies when ye shall have done all those things that are commanded you say we are unprofitable servants we have done that which was our duty to do

there are few topics connected with biblical interpretation which seem to be more in need of re investigation the old opinions have gone out of vogue without being replaced by any better or indeed by any other system so that the whole subject has been long in a most unsettled state this would be no great evil if typology were merely a matter of curious speculation but embracing as it does some of the most difficult and interesting questions of interpretation its perversion or neglect cannot fail to be attended by the most pernicious consequences under these impressions which have long been forming in this book the difficulties of the subject are distinctly recognized and fairly appreciated the author is acquainted with the history of his subject he does not come to the discussion of it with a few ex parte notions gathered from some recent writer he knows not only where the difficulty lies but what attempts have heretofore been made for its removal this is volume two out of two

the pulpit commentary was first published between 1880 and 1919 and is a highly respected work written by conservative trustworthy men containing over 22 000 pages and 95 000 entries it is one of the largest and best selling homiletic commentary sets of all time it was directed by editors joseph exell and henry donald maurice spence jones and utilized more than 100 authors over a 30 year span when reading this commentary it is not difficult to see why it has remained a favorite amongst pastors for more than 100 years there are three key elements which set this apart from its contemporaries the first being that it gives an exposition or verse by verse annotation of each verse in the bible the second element is that it explores the framework of the text the homiletics finally it supplies the homilies with multiple model sermons from various authors also included is a translation as well as historical and geographical information the evangelical magazine and missionary chronicle declared this commentary bids fair to take a conspicuous place among the ever multiplying aids to the study of the holy
