kenyatta and his army escape from an impeding ambush on his farm by hijacking a plane they believe will take them to africa but the plan must suddenly change when the pilots attempt to save the plane fails

urban books popular girls from da hood series is back bringing readers more dramatic tales about the lives of some tough resourceful women who can hold their own when things get rough on the streets this time family bonds are put to the test jakki and school boy are more than first cousins they re best friends and partners in crime with a reputation for getting theirs by any means necessary the pair are ultimately forced to defend not only their family name but their loyalty to each other with both wanting to stand at the head of the table jakki and school boy feud proving that there s definitely no honor amongst thieves family or not sanaa a well known gambling house owner is at the top of her game but after she decides to inject phony currency into her business all hell breaks loose guns are drawn and opposing forces take sides luckily for sanaa her father and her brothers are well versed in the operations of the underworld with millions of dollars still to be claimed all the wolves come out and the hunting season begins will the love of that mean green shatter families and friends or will the players prove that money can t buy everything with a gritty and promiscuous reputation star is indeed her mother s child when she meets rello a low level hustler selling dreams of a better life star jumps at the opportunity to lock him down however when the connect s package comes up short star s lies start to unravel and the true intentions of this wannabe wifey to a kingpin are revealed

with roots that stretch from west africa through the black pulpit hip hop emerged in the streets of the south bronx in the 1970s and has spread to the farthest corners of the earth to the break of dawn uniquely examines this freestyle verbal artistry on its own terms a kid from queens who spent his youth at the epicenter of this new art form music critic william jelani cobb takes readers inside the beats the lyrics and the flow of hip hop separating mere corporate rappers from the creative mcs that forged the art in the crucible of the street jam the four pillars of hip hop break dancing graffiti art deejaying and rapping find their origins in traditions as diverse as the afro brazilian martial art capoeira and caribbean immigrants turnstile artistry

epiphany wright keisha moore and shana scott spent their teenage years as best friends in the hood of south side jamaica queens as adults their friendship is put to the test when envy built up animosity hidden betrayal and the bad boys in their lives cause more havoc every day becomes a struggle to keep it tight with all that s riding against them when drastic situations occur will these girls be down for one another or be just plain sheisty

kraig holmes is a hard working independent contractor living in baltimore he s an average guy with one exception a painful secret haunts him daily kraig had a one time sexual experience with a man he knew little about it propelled him into a lifestyle

of promiscuity and an insatiable appetite for dangerous sex when the guy disappeared into thin air kraig was left hurt and devastated now kraig has developed a taste for the married men who pursue him while he s working on their homes when his sexual escapades spiral out of control and out into the open he quickly tries to get things under wraps then the unexpected happens a chance encounter with his one night stand from college kraig is hurt when he discovers the man doesn t even remember him kraig vows to set up the man who turned him out and disappeared what kraig doesn t know is that his victim isn t the lay down and take it type he has a few cards up his sleeve that will deliver damaging blows to kraig s life when it s all said and done the truth with be revealed and there will be consequences m t pope delivers another hot scandalous tale full of lust infidelity and over the top drama

revealing the roots of johnnie wise s family tree the author takes readers to nigeria where a beautiful sixteen year old girl preparing to marry a much older man escapes with her young lover on the night before the arranged marriage is to take place on a dutch slave ship bound for america where she becomes josephine baptiste

this book is dedicated to the strugglers to their personal struggle and the struggles of anyone they carry the struggle of single mothers and fathers kids of separated parents siblings raising siblings first generation college kids that guy on the corner and the falsely accused the struggle of dreamers lovers fighters those with broken hearts those with pain and those discriminated against through your struggle be an inspiration and never give in you re not struggling alone

header the newest line up from urban books kensingtonhernandez delivers the third novel in her powerful urban saga set in flint michigan where the good die young and the innocent don t stay that way for long

destiny was once an innocent young girl tricked into selling her own body but now she s as tough as the most seasoned

professionals on her street then a tragic turn of events forces her to open her heart once again when her pimp mack jones is shot she stays behind during his recovery after mack has regained his strength she decides to leave the life behind her and mack is forced to make a decision will he stay with what he has always known or take a chance at love

it s been four years since the tragic suicide death of yadira cruz and thirty eight year old correction officer sean daniels life was finally on the right track he was married to the beautiful milan he had a successful law enforcement career a supportive family and great friends but when sean s ex lover brandi wallace suddenly re enters his life he sees everything that he worked so hard to build flashing before his eyes brandi is a very attractive woman and part of a shameful past that sean desperately tries to forget but the temptation to rekindle their steamy romance becomes very hard for sean to resist and the persistent brandi will not be stopped she insists on reminding him that they have unfinished business to tend to and she won t quit until she get what she wants

many times in my adult life i have had what i would call an awake out of body experience during these times i was peeking in at my life in a dream state thinking this cannot be my life i found myself asking the questions of what happened to the child who outsmarted the world and what happened to the teen who had all the answers and confidence to boot and the young adult who never settled for can t well somewhere along the way the only thing left of who i was once was were just shreds of an almost non existent life now don t get me wrong there were some good times along the way but it certainly was not always smooth sailing but what came later in life was no comparison to the early years not that long ago my life was filled with disappointment brokenness worry anxiety and fear i survived breakups and breakdowns sadness and pain grief and loss beyond description all of which led to a one way ticket to depression central getting off the road to depression was very difficult for me but there is no job too hard for god if you can relate to the paralyzing despair that i went through then please know that i fellowship with you and understand the grip depression and anxiety can have on your life however i want you to know that your destination does not have to be a one way ticket to the land of despair instead your journey can bring you to a place of joy and peace if you simply trust and believe in god

funny passionate and straight from the soul vera wright turner thinks she has it all under control until she meets and greets herself born on the flip side of the hustler s game she is the child of a fifteen year old drug addict who placed her in a trash dump with a note that read please forgive me my mother s only fifteen well that is of little consolation to vera as she lives her gold diggin life full speed ahead everything comes to a crashing halt when she realizes that she can run but she can t hide facing up to the flip side of the game is the only way she will survive

the author analyzes the way the girls discuss pleasure in becoming the eye of the reader use film to decode the genres of literature master forms such as fantasy and gothic describe the differences between reading and viewing films and identify

only with animal rather than human characters blackford intertwines the vivid voices of her girl respondents with her own story of moving beyond her feminist and multicultural assumptions of how children are shaped by the stories we tell in literature this breakthrough text presents surprising findings about how girls appreciate literature and what they enjoy about reading

an engaging examination of black girl magic and its significance in american literature in light and legacies author janaka bowman lewis examines black girlhood in american literature from the mid twentieth century to the present the representation of black girlhood in contemporary literature has long remained underexplored through this literary history of black girl magic lewis offers one of the first studies in this rapidly growing field of study light and legacies poignantly showcases the activist dimensions of creative literature through work by women writers such as toni morrison and toni cade as vectors of protest these stories reflect historical events while also creating an enduring space of liberation and expression the book provides didactic and reflective portrayals of the black experience an experience that has long been misunderstood in a work both enlightening and personal lewis brilliantly weaves accounts of her own journey together with the liberating stories that shaped her and so many others

the uncontested center of the black pulp fiction universe for more than four decades was the los angeles publisher holloway house from the late 1960s until it closed in 2008 holloway house specialized in cheap paperbacks with page turning narratives featuring black protagonists in crime stories conspiracy thrillers prison novels and westerns from iceberg slim s pimp to donald goines s never die alone the thread that tied all of these books together and made them distinct from the majority of american pulp was an unfailing veneration of black masculinity zeroing in on holloway house street players explores how this world of black pulp fiction was produced received and recreated over time and across different communities of readers kinohi nishikawa contends that black pulp fiction was built on white readers fears of the feminization of society and the appeal of black masculinity as a way to counter it in essence it was the original form of blaxploitation a strategy of mass marketing race to suit the reactionary fantasies of a white audience but while chauvinism and misogyny remained troubling yet constitutive aspects of this literature from 1973 onward holloway house moved away from publishing sleaze for a white audience to publishing solely for black readers the standard account of this literary phenomenon is based almost entirely on where this literature ended up in the hands of black male working class readers when it closed holloway house was synonymous with genre fiction written by black authors for black readers a field of cultural production that nishikawa terms the black literary underground but as street players demonstrates this cultural authenticity had to be created promoted and in some cases made up and there is a story of exploitation at the heart of black pulp fiction s origins that cannot be ignored

in this gripping and action packed sequel to corrupt city the aftermath of the assassination is explored revealing what happened to everyone involved with trickery in each chapter this book will have you cheering for the bad guys while wondering who can be trusted who is behind the foul events that unfold and where the corruption will end you won t be able to put this book down until you unveil all the clues

is surrounded by the lavish things in life but will she let her past forfeit her future how much can she take before she eventually breaks will the gunshot wound to her fiance or the horrible secret revealed cause her to go insane this immaculate drama filled love story will have you on edge from the beginning to the end with its many twists and turns

with this book cheryl hicks brings to light the voices and viewpoints of black working class women especially southern migrants who were the subjects of urban and penal reform in early twentieth century new york hicks compares the ideals of racial upl
