this is a book of stories writes henry louis gates and all might be described as narratives of ascent as some remarkable men talk about their lives many perspectives on race and gender emerge for the notion of the unitary black man gates argues is as imaginary as the creature that the poet wallace stevens conjured in his poem thirteen ways of looking at a blackbird james baldwin colin powell harry belafonte bill t jones louis farrakhan anatole broyard albert murray all these men came from modest circumstances and all achieved preeminence they are people gates writes who have shaped the world as much as they were shaped by it who gave as good as they got three are writers james baldwin who was once regarded as the intellectual spokesman for the black community anatole broyard who chose to hide his black heritage so as to be seen as a writer on his own terms and albert murray who rose to the pinnacle of literary criticism there is the general turned political figure colin powell who discusses his interactions with three united states presidents there is harry belafonte the entertainer whose career has been distinct from his fervent activism there is bill t jones dancer and choreographer whose fierce courage and creativity have continued in the shadow of aids and there is louis farrakhan the controversial religious leader these men and others speak of their lives with candor and intimacy and what emerges from this portfolio of influential men is a strikingly varied and profound set of ideas about what it means to be a black man in america today

a black man s notes on ancient egypt is karl c pierce s personal study of his own black history from the beginning of mankind throughout the text pierce explores several familiar questions who were the early humans where did they come from what was the role of africa and its people in the development of civilization why is ancient egypt so critical to this story this story is unique as it is not told from an academic viewpoint but from that of a truth seeking black man intent on solidifying his own knowledge of his ancestors to push back on this narrative of blacks as savages promoted for hundreds of years by european scholars whose writings are designed to continue the hundreds of years of disenfranchisement of blacks about the author karl c pierce grew up in richmond ca but lived his adult years in oakland where he currently resides he is the father of three adult daughters and the proud grandpa of two grandchildren pierce s education and work history are both in the architectural engineering planning aep fields and he is now happily retired he holds a degree in urban studies from san jose state university he is also a former member of the american institute of certified planners aicp

black people of america we need to stop reading books about thug life and street life we need to read books that will open our minds to ideas and issues that will help us and our families and the future of black generations of this country black people of america we were here before most of the other nationalities that are here now we should be in a much better

financial situation than we are in now most of us are at the bottom or near the bottom of the economic scale as a whole we have to learn from the foreigners that stick together and open up businesses in our community plus we have to stop giving our hard earned money to other nationalities and none to ourselves in a way we are still slaves i wrote this book to inspire black americans to open there eyes to the positive changes we need to make to help our families and future black generations in america this book shows how we are living compared to other nationalities in america as well as the factors that are holding us back as a whole we must remember our ancestors and the sacrifices they made when they were slaves they were the strongest people in the world and we are their descendants i feel they were superhuman beings to make that trip from africa to america we as black americans have that same ability in us to survive remember we are the alpha race we need to wake up and stop hitting the snooze button may god bless this book and everyone that reads it

few of dr ben s books are written with co authors the black man s north and east africa is an exception written with one of his early colleagues george e simmonds this work attacks the racist manipulation of african and black history by educators and authorities on africa defenders of the africans right to tell their own story the authors insist that black people must take responsibility for their own history until african black people are willing and do write their own experience past and present we will continue being slaves mentally physically and spiritually to caucasian and semitic racism and religious bigotry

ten years ago mark anthony neal s new black man put forth a revolutionary model of black masculinity for the twenty first century one that moved beyond patriarchy to embrace feminism and combat homophobia now neal s book is more vital than ever urging us to imagine a new black man whose strength resides in family community and diversity part memoir part

using the slave narratives of henry bibb and frederick douglass as well as the work of w e b du bois james baldwin walter mosley and barack obama ronda c henry anthony examines how women s bodies are used in african american literature to fund the production of black masculine ideality and power in tracing representations of ideal black masculinities and femininities the author shows how black men s struggles for gendered agency are inextricably entwined with their complicated relation to white men and normative masculinity the historical context in which this study couches these struggles highlights the extent to which shifting socioeconomic circumstances dictate the ideological cultural and emotional terms upon which black men conceptualize identity yet anthony quickly moves to texts that challenge traditional constructions of black masculinity in these texts she traces how the emergence of collaboratively gendered discourses or a blending of black female male feminist consciousnesses are reshaping black masculinities femininities and intraracial relations for a new century

a compelling expose of the truth behind society s racial and sexual stereotypes of black men this book offers a wide historical perspective and insights into such recent racially charged events as the clarence thomas hearings the o j simpson trial and the million man march hutchinson brilliantly counters the image of black men as a population entrenched in crime drugs and violence

a provocative candid study of the romantic relationships between white women and black men offers a psychological explanation for the phenomenon as well as analyzing the influence of the entertainment industry exposing stereotypes and assessing the global implications of black and white relationships

this book is the first to explore the history of a powerful category of illicit sex in america s past liaisons between southern white women and black men martha hodes tells a series of stories about such liaisons in the years before the civil war explores the complex ways in which white southerners tolerated them in the slave south and shows how and why these responses changed with emancipation hodes provides details of the wedding of a white servant woman and a slave man in 1681 an antebellum rape accusation that uncovered a relationship between an unmarried white woman and a slave and a divorce plea from a white farmer based on an adulterous affair between his wife and a neighborhood slave drawing on sources that include courtroom testimony legislative petitions pardon pleas and congressional testimony she presents the voices of the authorities eyewitnesses and the transgressors themselves and these voices seem to say that in the slave south whites were not overwhelmingly concerned about such liaisons beyond the racial and legal status of the children that were produced only with the advent of black freedom did the issue move beyond neighborhood dramas and into the arena of politics becoming a much more serious taboo than it had ever been before hodes gives vivid examples of the violence that followed the upheaval of war when black men and white women were targeted by the ku klux klan and unprecedented white rage and terrorism against such liaisons began to erupt an era of terror and lynchings was inaugurated and the legacy of these sexual politics lingered well into the twentieth century
