perhaps more than any other european country spain has undergone a remarkable transformation in the post war period to the surprise of many it has succeeded in making the leap from a predominantly agricultural and politically repressed country to a modern european democracy with a diversified economy containing important manufacturing and service sectors yet despite the fact that at the beginning of the twenty first century spain is the world s eighth largest economy old stereotypes that see the iberian nation as an inflexible unchanging society persist as such scholars will welcome this new study which challenges the picaresque and outdated notions of spanish economic development replacing them with a picture of rapid and profound modernization building upon the recent work of historians and economists the authors provide a thoughtful and compelling overview of the subject that clearly elucidates both the positive and negative aspects of modern spanish development thus as well as charting the undoubted successes achieved persistent problems most notably high unemployment are also explored written in a straightforward and engaging manner this book engages with research from a wide variety of disciplines and will be of interest to anyone with a specific interest in modern spain or a wider interest in economic development within the framework of the european union

unravelling the debate about the spanish nation and its identity in the new democracy this book looks at the issue as both a historical debate and a contemporary political problem particularly complex due to the legacy of the francoist dictatorship which deeply eroded the legitimacy of spanish nationalism during and since the transition spanish

nationalist discourse has evolved to meet the challenge of new concepts of nation and identity these formulations argue very different configurations of the relationship between nation and state while the constitution of 1978 defines spain as a nation of nationalities many politicians and intellectuals now claim that spain is a nation of nations others that it is a nation of nations and regions or a post traditional nation state or post national state for the peripheral nationalists it is merely a state of nations and regions what is at issue is not whether spain exists or not as a nation rather it is the traditional ways of seeing spain from both the centre and the periphery that are being challenged the reinvention of spain examines the ways in which spanish and regional identities are projected and how influence the external actions of the spanish state it also analyses the dynamic of comparative grievance and competition between regions deriving from the peculiar architecture of the state in spain and their effect on social and political cohesion finally it examines scenarios of change that might foster solutions but asserts that spain will continue to reinvent itself

spain has been a fruitful locus for the european imagination for centuries and it has been most often perceived in black and white oppositions either as a tyrannical and fanatical force in the early modern period or as an imaginary geography of a romantic spain in later centuries however the image of spain its culture and its inhabitants did not evolve inexorably from negative to positive from the early modern period onwards it responded to an ambiguous matrix of conflicting hispanophobic and hispanophilic representations just as in the nineteenth century latent negative stereotypes continued to resurface even in the romantic heyday in the early modern period appreciation for spain was equally undeniable when spain was a political and military superpower it also enjoyed cultural hegemony

with a literary golden age producing internationally hailed masterpieces literary hispanophobia and hispanophilia in britain and the low countries 1550 1850 explores the protracted interest in spain and its culture and it exposes the co existent ambiguity between scorn and fascination that characterizes western historical perceptions in particular in britain and the low countries two geographical spaces with a shared sense of historical connectedness and an overlapping sometimes complicated history with spain
