so ungeheuerlich es auch klingen mag der zweite weltkrieg ist nicht von adolf hitler sondern von franklin d roosevelt geplant worden wie historische dokumente zeigen hatte das weiße haus seit herbst 1938 politischen druck auf polen frankreich und england ausgeübt und sie zu einem krieg gegen deutschland genötigt hiermit so die hauptaussage dieses buches haben sich die usa einer indirekten kriegsentfesselung schuldig gemacht das motiv das roosevelt dabei verfolgte bestand keineswegs darin die welt von der pest des nationalsozialismus zu befreien es bestand auch nicht darin hitlers vermeintliche pläne einer eroberung der welt oder einer auslöschung der juden zu vereiteln das motiv war wie bei nahezu allen kriegen rein ökonomischer natur roosevelt war mit seiner neuen wirtschaftspolitik dem new deal gescheitert wie hitler so hatte auch roosevelt bei seiner wahl versprochen sein volk wieder in lohn und brot zu bringen anders als hitler konnte roosevelt sein versprechen aber nicht einlösen von den 14 millionen menschen die 1933 arbeitslos waren waren 1938 immer noch 10 millionen arbeitslos wie schon der erste weltkrieg so sollte nun auch der zweite weltkrieg die wirtschaft ankurbeln die arbeitslosigkeit beseitigen und der rüstungs und der finanzindustrie riesige gewinne ermöglichen tatsächlich sorgte der kriegseintritt der usa schon 1943 für vollbeschäftigung zudem übernahm amerika geopolitisch wichtige stützpunkte des britischen imperiums und schließlich sorgte der krieg sogar dafür dass die vereinigten staaten von amerika zu der größten weltmacht auf erden wurden

an explorer archaeologist scholar writer and policymaker gertude bell was a colourful figure who played an outsize role in the history of the middle east in the early twentieth century this book carefully examines bell s published and unpublished letters diaries notes and publications to reconstruct and reevaluate bell s intentions and legacy in the middle east in the aftermath of the first world war it focuses on her correspondence with senior figures to examine the well networked bell as a policymaker in waiting it also reappraises bell s role in the formation of the kingdom of iraq assessing her public statements in support of faisal iraq s future king against the doubts regarding britain s mission in the region as she previously understood the colonial enterprise centering her own experience and reflections in the context of wider events this book adds nuance to perceptions of bell as a one sided agent of the british empire and explores the legacy of her actions in iraq and the west middle east relations today

caught between the ottoman empire to the west the russian sphere of influence in the north and the british colonial territories in india and the middle east iran at the end of the nineteenth century was a hotly contested strategic battleground the ruling gajar dynasty was led by a young and inexperienced king and the british were busy extending their reach through unbalanced treaties and resource concessions meanwhile powerful tribal leaders like sheikh khaz al sought to retain their traditional positions and block efforts to unite the country under a strong central government with the discovery of oil and britain s need to fuel her war machine in world war i increased attention on iran demanded a modernization of her policies and government reza khan an otherwise unknown soldier united the armed forces and swept to power bringing with him the unity and structure needed to take iran into the emerging modern world after disposing of the former rulers he became the new shah and fought to rebuild his country after centuries of abuse and manipulation by foreign powers what was at stake was the autonomy of iran s lifeline iran s golden state khuzestan province a province with abundant rich oil and gas reservoirs natural resources with a strategic importance to the warm waters of the persian gulf the full sovereignty by others could have exponentially undermined iran s position and role on the world stage both politically and economically and even more so in the turbulent

middle east of today events of the time period of this book are very pertinent to the current geopolitical conversation struggles and developments in the region this is the story of the dynamic power play for dominance robust diplomacy and political rivalries between colonial powers powerful tribes and government actors in the iranian southwest theater the emergence of a powerful regime in iran and the superpowers radical shifts in foreign policy and in the regional engagements in the post world war i significantly contributed to averting this geopolitical crisis of a historic proportion it is an extensively researched and definitive history of iran at the turn of the twentieth century that is required reading for anyone seeking to understand the history of colonialism oil exploration and the ongoing political tensions of the middle east

in frontier fictions firoozeh kashani sabet looks at the efforts of iranians to defend if not expand their borders in the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries and explores how their conceptions of national geography influenced cultural and political change the frontier fictions or the ways in which the iranians viewed their often fluctuating borders and the conflicts surrounding them played a dominant role in defining the nation on these borderlands new ideas of citizenship and nationality were unleashed refining older ideas of ethnicity kashani sabet maintains that land based conceptions of countries existed before the advent of the modern nation state her focus on geography enables her to explore and document fully a wide range of aspects of modern citizenship in iran including love of homeland the hegemony of the persian language and widespread interest in archaeology travel and map making while many historians have focused on the concept of the imagined community in their explanations of the rise of nationalism kashani sabet is able to complement this perspective with a very tangible explanation of what connects people to a specific place her approach is intended to enrich our understanding not only of iranian nationalism but also of nationalism everywhere

a brilliant narrative history tracing today s troubles back to the grandiose imperial overreach of great britain and the united states kingmakers is the gripping story of how the modern middle east came to be as told through the lives of the britons and americans who shaped it some are famous lawrence of arabia and gertrude bell others infamous harry st john philby father of kim some forgotten sir mark sykes israel s godfather and a t wilson the territorial creator of iraq all helped enthrone rulers in a region whose very name is an anglo american invention the aim of this engrossing character driven narrative is to restore to life the colorful figures who gave us the middle east in which americans are enmeshed today

by the 1930s fascist dictator benito mussolini reached the conclusion

that italy faced a clear choice expand its power at the expense of the british and french empires or face stagnation and decline he believed that the regimes in the democratic west would not be able to contain their inherent hostility toward fascist dynamism while their demographic and political weaknesses provided the opportunity for the younger demographically virile fascist italy to carve a new empire in the mediterranean status quo through his intervention in the spanish civil war and his attempts to challenge french power in europe and british imperial domination of the middle east and east africa mussolini sought to decisively change italy s long standing position as the least of the great powers although the pact of steel did not always function smoothly mussolini remained loyal to its principles eventually throwing italy into the second world war where he would belatedly discover that his regime had signally failed to prepare his legions for fighting in a modern war

this book examines the career of sir orme sargent one of the most important and distinguished british diplomats of the twentieth century for almost a quarter of century sargent helped shape british policy towards europe covering the period from 1926 to 1949 this study explores sargent and foreign office responses during a tumultuous period which included the collapse of weimar germany the rise of fascism the second world war anglo soviet relations and the dawn of the cold war in doing so it sheds light on an important but largely neglected historical figure in the study of twentieth century british foreign policy the book will be of use and interest to scholars students and general researchers in the fields of twentieth century foreign policy british history diplomatic relations and britain s relationship with europe

the origins of the second world war remain clouded in churchillian mythology sixty years on peter neville s controversial book provides an essential reassessment of the appeasement myths by examining a central yet understudied figure sir nevile henderson has been vilified as our nazi ambassador in berlin by historians and popular memory alike he has remained in disgrace despite the widespread historical rethinking of appeasement in recent years yet there has never before been a book length study of henderson despite his central role as britain s ambassador peter neville s important reassessment draws upon primary documents to overturn orthodox interpretations while henderson s analysis of the nazi regime was seriously flawed history has vastly overstated his influence in presenting the first full and close analysis of what henderson himself called the failure of a mission the author has made a pathbreaking contribution to the history of appeasement

for decades the gabor dynasty was the epitome of glamour and fairy tale success but as biographer film historian and gabor family friend sam staggs reveals behind the headlines is a true story more dramatic fabulous and surprising than their self styled legend would have you believe in 1945 after barely escaping hitler s invasion of hungary followed by liberation of the country by the red army three members of the gabor family jolie her ex husband vilmos and their daughter magda arrived in new york city in hollywood their other daughters zsa zsa and eva had worked feverishly throughout the war years to secure their rescue from the nazis plan to exterminate the jews stepping off the boat jolie the iron willed matriarch already had a golden future mapped out for her sharp witted cosmopolitan beauties over the next six decades with twenty three husbands between them suave all about eve star george sanders would wed both zsa zsa and magda scores of lovers and roller coaster rides in film television theater and business the elegant yet gloriously bawdy addictively watchable gabors carved a niche in the entertainment industry that made them world famous pop culture icons but beneath the artifice of dior and diamonds was another side to the story they never revealed the whole truth this first verifiable history of the gabors casts a startling new light on these extraordinary women finding zsa zsa reveals the tumultuous and often unforgiven battles between mother and daughter sister and sister wife and husband eva s bearded romance with merv griffin that allowed them both to seek same sex lovers zsa zsa s involuntary confinement in a mental hospital her life long struggle with bipolar disorder and her last unconsummated marriage to the manipulating faux prince frederic von anhalt here too is the untold story of zsa zsa s daughter francesca hilton a gifted photographer who eschewed the gabor lifestyle and paid a sad price for her independence the story of family patriarch vilmos gabor who returned to hungary only to be trapped behind the iron curtain reads like a cold war spy thriller culled from new interviews with family colleagues and confidantes and the unpublished memoirs of the author s friend francesca hilton finding zsa zsa finally introduces fans to the gabor family they never knew including many never before seen photos it s a riveting outrageously funny bittersweet and affectionately honest read of four women who were vulnerable tough charitable endlessly fascinating and always glamorous to a fault

henry george farmer 1882 1965 was a pioneering musicologist who

specialized in arab music in 1932 he participated in the first international congress of arab music in cairo during which he maintained a journal recording his daily activities interactions with fellow delegates and dignitaries and varied perambulations throughout the city this journal and the detailed minutes he kept for his chaired commission on history and manuscripts were never published they reveal aspects and inner workings of the congress that have hitherto remained unknown the illustrations and photos contained therein as well as additional photos that were never seen provide visual documentation of the congress s participants and musical ensembles

this work investigates how various sacred spaces in ottoman and republican turkey interfaced with british foreign policy it considers how these spaces impacted upon british prestige in the context of its dealings with turkey chiefly as well as other great powers the period covered is from the demise of the levant company in 1825 to the deconsecration of the crimean memorial church in istanbul in 1976 other sacred spaces discussed include the british embassy chapel the crimean war cemeteries various british churches and cemeteries in izmir the gallipoli cemeteries connected with the campaign of 1915 and the phanar the ecumenical patriarch s home in istanbul the book considers how and to what extent the foreign office in london and its staff in turkey intervened to secure those spaces and why the politics of the patriarchate intruded into the foreign office s geo strategic considerations it considers the limits of that support and how dealings over sacred space intermeshed generally with british policy towards turkey it further explores the motives not just of diplomats and consuls who were instrumental in establishing or safeguarding those spaces but also the aims of other organisations and of expatriate britons who were similarly involved it also considers instances where such support became attenuated or was withdrawn the book is unique in illuminating in a broad fashion the role of sacred space in the context of anglo turkish relations and british power projection in the near east

egypt s liberal experiment 1922 1936 invites readers to delve into egypt s transitional years when it grappled with the influences of colonial rule nationalism and burgeoning self governance with the sensitivity of an insider and the rigor of a historian the author offers a nuanced portrayal of the forces that shaped egypt s experiment with liberal democracy echoing geneticists and psychologists who posit that individuals and societies inherit and carry collective memories this work suggests that egyptian political culture is rooted in a deep seated historical consciousness the book traces the continuity of egypt s struggles aspirations and the resilience of its people through centuries of foreign domination here the desire for national autonomy was not a departure but an expression of egypt s long standing ethos revealing a collective memory of resistance and survival that binds egyptian identity and differentiates it from other nations rather than seeing the modern eqyptian state as a break from its past eqypt s liberal experiment contextualizes the 1922 1936 period as a phase within an unbroken historical lineage despite the swift pace of 20th century change this period was characterized by both progress and enduring challenges industrialization educational reforms and social shifts interwove with political instability and external control the author highlights the period s socio political forces that although constrained by british influence and monarchical power fostered a budding sense of egyptian self determination this complex legacy laid the groundwork for future developments bridging traditional values with the emerging ideals of modern nationhood and making this book essential for understanding egypt s unique path toward political autonomy and national identity this title is part of uc press s voices revived program which commemorates university of california press s mission to seek out and cultivate the brightest minds and give them voice reach and impact drawing on a backlist dating to 1893 voices revived makes high quality peer reviewed scholarship accessible once again using print on demand technology this title was originally published in 1977

this business history analyzes the connections between private business disarmament and re armament as they affected arms procurement and military technology transfers in eastern europe from 1919 to 1939 rather than focusing on the negotiations or the political problems involved with the disarmament conferences this study concerns itself with the business effects of the disarmament discussions accordingly schneider creusot Škoda vickers and their respective business activities in eastern european markets serve as the chief subjects for this book and the core primary sources relied upon include their unpublished corporate archival documents shifting the scope of analysis to consider the business dimension allows for a fresh appraisal of the linkages between the arms trade disarmament and re armament the business approach also explodes the myth of the merchants of death from the inside it concludes by tracing the armaments business between 1939 and 1941 as it transitioned from peacetime to war

sir harold nicolson 1886 1968 is well known as a diarist man of letters diplomatic historian gardener and broadcaster nicolson s bestselling diaries and letters his many biographies including the highly acclaimed official life of king george v and his numerous essays and broadcasts have made him in the words of his friend and fellow mp robert bernays an international figure of the second degree yet there was more to this urbane man than his finely observed diary stylish writing and sissinghurst castle garden in kent the joint creation of nicolson and his wife the writer v sackville west he also produced a rich and ambitious corpus of writing on the theory and practice of international relations nicolson s aristocratic background and upbringing in a diplomatic household followed by an oxford classical education and twenty years in diplomacy combined to forge his distinctive philosophy of international affairs as a young attaché in constantinople before the great war and in whitehall during the conflict at the paris peace conference of 1919 and en poste in persia and germany throughout the 1920s nicolson was ideally placed to observe the maelstrom of international politics as an anti appeasement and wartime mp 1935 1945 he became a highly regarded authority on international relations during and after world war ii he turned his mind to the issues of european integration world government and the ultimate possibility of global peace nicolson has been the subject of two fine biographies this is the first study of his contribution to international thought he emerges from it as an important international thinker alongside theorists as diverse as e h carr and leonard woolf nicolson s international thought contains elements of realism and idealism while retaining a distinctive character and a breadth and consistency that render it unique

these essays reveal the role of british intelligence in the roundups of european refugees and expose the subversion of democratic safeguards they examine the oppression of internment in general and its specific effect on women as well as the artistic and cultural achievements of internees

a wide ranging and authoritative study of british foreign policy in the critical years after the 1919 paris peace conference policy towards western and eastern europe russia turkey the middle east united states and far east is examined alongside such themes as the role of prime minister foreign secretary and cabinet in policy formulation the evolution and execution of policy is set alongside the limitations imposed on british statesmen by the dominions armed forces economic weakness and domestic politics

traces the life of isma il sidqi twice egyptian prime minister in 1930 and in 1946 and opponent of egypt s disastrous 1948 decision to intervene in palestine and seeks to interpret his motives and actions in the light of his own statements

drawing on long classified documents target italy is the official history of the war waged by britain s special operations executive on benito mussolini s fascist italy it is the first full account of soe s clandestine efforts to strike at italy and sever its alliance with nazi germany uncovering missions as remarkable as a plot to assassinate mussolini and plans to arm the mafia it is also the first in depth history of soe s attempts at causing trouble inside an enemy country as opposed to an enemy occupied one issuing a sobering reminder of the terrible dangers that foreign agencies can encounter when trying to encourage resistance to powerful authoritarian regimes this is a compelling tale of desperate daring and sacrifice climaxing in one of the most extraordinary episodes of the war the delicate and dramatic dealings between the allies and the italians that led to italy s surrender in 1943

the end of the gajar era in iran despite the accepted narrative of decline was in fact an occasion of modern and forward thinking nationalism iran developed an imperial nationalism which was informed by its experiences under british and russian hegemony and the absorption of western modern ideas and practices and which now looked towards a future as a sovereign and independent state within the foundational framework of its previous empire emboldened by post wwi notions of self determination and the development of international institutions devoted to peace iran spearheaded its new found diplomacy by sending a delegation to the peace talks in paris in 1919 this book shows how iran s immediate post war diplomacy came about the conduct of iran s delegation to paris frustrations with the anglo persian agreement and ultimately how iran s progress became the victim of british imperialism throwing a spotlight on an under researched period of iranian history it will be of interest to readers of iranian history and those interested in the paris peace conference of 1919

first published in 1986 the arab league founded in 1945 was regarded by many as a ploy of the british to secure the cooperation and goodwill of the arabs during the second world war and as an instrument to ensure the british presence in the middle east after the war this book presents a different picture the british policy was a far cry from supporting the arab unity movement on the contrary the british government tried to forestall that movement or at least to postpone its implementation until after the end of the second world war anthony eden s famous mansion house speech of may 1941 was not intended to signal a drastic change in the british middle eastern policy but rather to fore stall a strongly pro zionist proposal which had been put forward by winston churchill it is true that there were some british personalities mainly unofficial who supported the arab unity trend but the thrust of their positive argument was that a broader framework of arab federation would be instrumental in helping to solve the intractable problem of palestine what might surprise some readers is the fact that some highly important zionist leaders were the main protagonists of that idea believing that if the arabs were to obtain satisfaction of their national aspirations through unity they the arabs would adopt a much more moderate attitude towards the zionist movement in palestine the arab leaders and rulers tried to bring about a higher degree of cooperation or even a federation of their countries either for dynastic or political reasons but the british negative reaction was not always crystal clear owing to the more favourable attitude typical of many including the top british representatives in the middle east

the post first world war period was pivotal in global history international relations and geopolitics and no more than in south asia where for decades the great game in geopolitical rivalry of the two greatest modern empires britain and russia had dominated international relations but with the advent of communism in russia and growing nationalism and pan islamism in afghanistan persia and india britian s imperial standing was under threat faced with these problems some in the british government such as lord curzon the dominant imperialist in the british foreign office fell back on what they knew old patterns of rivalry and high handedness that characterised the great game not all however agreed with curzon and with war in afghanistan civil unrest in india and rising tensions in persia those who opposed this great game mindset advocated a new way forward for british foreign relations

in 1930 wealthy scottish socialite dorothy brooke followed her new husband to cairo where she discovered thousands of suffering former british war horses leading lives of toil and misery brought to the middle east by british forces during the great war these ex cavalry horses had been left behind at the war s end abandoned as used equipment too costly to send home grant hayter menzies chronicles not only the lives and eventual rescue of these noble creatures who after years of deprivation and suffering found respite in the old war horse memorial hospital established by dorothy but also the story of the challenges of founding and maintaining an animal rescue institution on this scale the legacy of the old war horse memorial hospital and its founder endures today in the dozens of international brooke animal welfare facilities dedicated to improving the lives of working horses donkeys and mules across africa asia and latin america

describes how attempts to create a modern egyptian self free from the colonial gaze were enacted through discourses of gender and sexuality during the british colonial period
