the global demand for tourism continues to increase as economic growth creates opportunities for its consumption as a lifestyle option across cultures the spatial reach of recreational tourism into remoter environments reflects a desire to reconnect to nature that is partially created by the global trend toward urbanisation at the same time anthropogenic created environmental problems have led us to re evaluate our relationship to nature and the values that are held by the environment this third edition of environment and tourism incorporates additional material on environmental philosophies and ontologies of nature and how these influence our understanding of tourism s relationship with the natural environment in an epoch representing a critical juncture for the future well being of the planet based on our relationship to nature the text has been updated to reflect the growth in significance of the interaction between tourism and the natural environment as a part of this discourse it communicates a range of key conceptual debates on the ethics and economics of the consuming nature for tourism and relates these to real world examples whilst evaluating environmental planning and management responses the

book seeks to highlight the relevance of the significance of tourism for nature within the framework of society as a system of inter connected places across space and time exploring the relationship of the environments of where tourists come from with the ones that they travel to the updated features include new chapters on philosophies and constructs of the environment environmental ethics and tourist consumption an extensive range of international case studies used to illustrate the theoretical ideas presented boxes offering bite sized insights and think points designed to encourage students to further engage with the topics discussed environment and tourism emphasises a holistic view of the tourism system and how it interacts with nature illustrating the positive and negative effects of this relationship it emphasises how ontologies of the environment influence the planning and management of tourism for natural resource conservation and human development it is an invaluable tool for anyone studying human geography tourism and environmental studies as well as for policy makers and consultants working in the field of tourism development

classicists have been slow to take advantage of the important advances in the way that literacy is viewed in other disciplines including in particular cognitive psychology socio linguistics and socio anthropology on the other hand historians of literacy continue to rely on outdated work by classicists mostly from the 1960 s and 1970 s and have little access to the current reexamination of the ancient evidence this timely volume attempts to formulate new interesting ways of talking about the entire concept of literacy in the ancient world literacy not in the sense of whether 10 or 30 of people in the ancient world could read or write but in the sense of text oriented events embedded in a particular socio cultural context the volume is intended as a forum in which selected leading scholars rethink from the ground up how students of classical antiquity might best approach the question of literacy in the past and how that investigation might materially intersect with changes in the way that literacy is now viewed in other disciplines the result will give readers new ways of thinking about specific elements of literacy in antiquity such as the nature of personal libraries or what it means to be a bookseller in antiquity new constructionist questions such as what constitutes reading communities and how they fashion themselves new takes on the public sphere such as how literacy intersects with commercialism or with the use of public spaces or with the construction of civic identity new essentialist questions such as what book and reading signify in antiquity why literate cultures develop or why literate cultures matter the book derives from a conference a semple symposium held in cincinnati in april 2006 and includes new work from the most outstanding scholars of literacy in antiquity e g simon goldhill joseph farrell peter white and rosalind thomas

at ease making life and death decisions between breaths maître d armes nicholas pasquale proposes marriage to a beautiful

in autonomy nicholas brown theorizes the historical and theoretical argument for art s autonomy from its acknowledged character as a commodity refusing the position that the distinction between art and the commodity has collapsed brown demonstrates how art can in confronting its material determinations suspend the logic of capital by demanding interpretive attention he applies his readings of marx hegel adorno and jameson to a range of literature photography music television and sculpture from cindy sherman s photography and the novels of ben lerner and jennifer egan to the wire and the music of the white stripes he demonstrates that through their attention and commitment to form such artists turn aside the determination posed by the demand of the market thereby defeating the foreclosure of meaning entailed in commodification in so doing he offers a new theory of art that prompts a rethinking of the relationship between art critical theory and capitalism

contemporary popular music provides the soundtrack for a host of recent novels but little critical attention has been paid to the intersection of these important art forms write in tune addresses this gap by offering the first full length study of the relationship between recent music and fiction with essays from an array of international scholars the collection focuses on how writers weave rock punk and jazz into their narratives both to develop characters and themes and to investigate various fan and celebrity cultures surrounding contemporary music write in tune covers major writers from america and england including don delillo jonathan franzen zadie smith and jim crace but it also explores how popular music culture is reflected in postcolonial latino and australian fiction ultimately the book brings critical awareness to the power of music in shaping contemporary culture and offers new perspectives on central issues of gender race and national identity

first published in 1965 a s byatt s degrees of freedom examined the first eight novels of iris murdoch identifying freedom as a central theme in all of them and looking at murdoch s interest in the relations between art and goodness master and slave and the novel of character in the nineteenth century sense drawing on iris murdoch s own critical and philosphical writing a s byatt discussed her interest in the thought of sartre plato freud and simone weil and related this to the form of the novels themselves this edition of degrees of freedom has an added dossier of later essays and reviews of iris murdoch s work by a s byatt taking us up to the publication of the book and the brotherhood in 1987 it also includes a substantial pamplet written for the british council which follows murdoch s fiction as far as the good apprentice

this uncommon book is a journey of discovery in the truest sense of those words a journey to unseen inner worlds mario mantese s thorough investigation of internal frontiers and parallel worlds are depicted here and the reader is awe struck by his

extraordinary sensitivity and his almost unlimited spiritual capabilities and how he employs them to cross over secret invisible boundaries what he saw experienced and had to endure is fascinating and simply inconceivable for the human intellect his contacts with various masters and the manner in which these events occurred are deeply touching and invite the reader into unfathomable depths of our existence this book is certainly one of the most unusual autobiographies ever to be published in the field of spiritual literature

metaphors are ubiquitous and yet or for that very reason go largely unseen we are all variously susceptible to a blindness or blurry vision of metaphors yet even when they are seen clearly we are left to situate the ambiguities conflations and contradictions they regularly present logically aesthetically and morally david larocca s book serves as a set of reminders of certain features of the natural history of our language especially the tropes that permeate and define it as part of his investigation larocca turns to ralph waldo emerson s only book on a single topic english traits 1856 which teems with genealogical and generative metaphors blood birth plants parents family names and race in the first book length study of english traits in over half a century larocca considers the presence of metaphors in emerson s fertile text a unique work in his expansive corpus and one that is regularly overlooked as metaphors are encountered in emerson s book and drawn from a long history of usage in work by others a reader may realize or remember what is inherent and encoded in our language but rarely seen how metaphors circulate in speech and through texts to become the lifeblood of thought

how much meditation is good for you why visualize an enlightened being are there places that meditation doesn t reach all of these questions and very many more are tackled in this substantial compilation of sangharakshita s teachings on meditation drawn from previously published works and from the unpublished transcripts of seminars discussions reveal how sangharakshita learned the practices on which his system of meditation an organic living system is based and how that system has evolved over the years

the golden book of spirit and sense the holy writ of beauty oscar wilde published to equal parts scandal and acclaim in 1873 the renaissance inspired a generation of oxford undergraduates who adapted its credo of arts for art s sake for their aesthetic movement combining the skepticism of empirical philosophy the materialism of 19th century science and the determinism of evolutionary theory this book defies categorization and endures as an innovative example of cultural criticism an oxford don who led a quiet scholarly life walter pater was shocked at the reactions his writings provoked i wish they would not call me a hedonist he remarked it gives such a wrong impression to those who do not know greek his essays on the individuals he viewed as embodiments of the renaissance spirit encompass artists whose careers span the middle ages through the 18th century pater s elegant fluid prose examines the works of pico della mirandola leonardo michelangelo botticelli and others he crowns his compendium of reflections with his notorious conclusion in which he asserts that to burn always with this hard gemlike flame to maintain this ecstasy is success in life one of victorian england s most talked about books the renaissance

exerted a crucial influence on the art criticism of the past century and it remains a work of unusual importance to those interested in art history and english literature
