in this new book bauman examines how we have moved away from a heavy and solid hardware focused modernity to a light and liquid software based modernity this passage he argues has brought profound change to all aspects of the human condition the new remoteness and un reachability of global systemic structure coupled with the unstructured and under defined fluid state of the immediate setting of life politics and human togetherness call for the rethinking of the concepts and cognitive frames used to narrate human individual experience and their joint history this book is dedicated to this task bauman selects five of the basic concepts which have served to make sense of shared human life emancipation individuality time space work and community and traces their successive incarnations and changes of meaning liquid modernity concludes the analysis undertaken in bauman s two previous books globalization the human consequences and in search of politics together these volumes form a brilliant analysis of the changing conditions of social and political life by one of the most original thinkers writing today

zygmunt bauman s liquid sociology confronts the awesome task of reminding individual men and women that an alternative way of living together is within our eminent capabilities if only we start to think differently about our world the metaphor of liquidity which has become such a prominent feature of his writings since 2000 provides us with just such a new interpretation with a novel way of seeing each chapter in this unique collection takes seriously bauman s analysis of modernity as liquid throwing new light upon global social problems as well as opening up a space for assessing the nature of bauman s contribution to sociology and for understanding what may be gained and lost by embracing an artistic sensibility within the social sciences with contributions from internationally renowned scholars this book will appeal to all those interested in bauman s work especially within sociology social political and cultural theory and to anyone curious about the value of metaphor in interpreting the social world

based in sociologist zygmunt bauman s theory of liquid modernity this volume describes and critiques key aspects and practices of liquid education education as market driven consumption short life span of useful knowledge overabundance of information through a systematic comparison with ancient greek paideia and medieval university education producing a sweeping analysis of the history and philosophy of education for the purpose of understanding current higher education positing a more holisitic alternative model in which students are embedded in a learning community that is itself embedded in a larger society if liquid modernity has left a vacuum where according to bauman the pilot s cabin is empty this volume argues that no structure is better positioned to fill this vacuum than the university and outlines a renewed vision of social transformation through higher education

this book discusses the rationale of nazi ethics and the moral conditioning of nazi perpetrators aimed at developing a kind of ethnic conscience which restricted moral obligations to members of their own race community it reconstructs how the universal ethics of humanism got turned upside down and replaced with the particularistic selective racial ethics and the pragmatics of eugenics and racial exterminatory politics it shows how ordinary germans became willing executioners of criminal and immoral deeds neither did they act without any moral orientation nor in the awareness that what they were doing was morally reprehensible as perpetrators with a clear conscience

they were convinced that the humiliation persecution deportation and finally killing of the jews was the right thing to do

influenced most notably by Émile durkheim and zygmunt bauman dawson outlines how this long neglected stream of socialist theory can help us more fully understand and possibly move beyond the problems of neoliberalism and our conceptions of political individualism

mark davis offers a critical enquiry into the sociology of zygmunt bauman focusing on his english language writings from the 1960s onwards the book contributes to sociological debates about modern society by offering an interpretation of bauman's work b

this book puts to the test the prominent claim that social class has declined in importance in an era of affluence choice and the waning of tradition arguing against this view this study vividly uncovers the multiple ways in which class stubbornly persists

the passage from solid to liquid modernity has created a new and unprecedented setting for individual life pursuits confronting individuals with a series of challenges never before encountered social forms and institutions no longer have enough time to solidify and cannot serve as frames of reference for human actions and long term life plans so individuals have to find other ways to organise their lives they have to splice together an unending series of short term projects and episodes that don t add up to the kind of sequence to which concepts like career and progress could meaningfully be applied such fragmented lives require individuals to be flexible and adaptable to be constantly ready and willing to change tactics at short notice to abandon commitments and loyalties without regret and to pursue opportunities according to their current availability in liquid modernity the individual must act plan actions and calculate the likely gains and losses of acting or failing to act under conditions of endemic uncertainty zygmunt bauman s brilliant writings on liquid modernity have altered the way we think about the contemporary world in this short book he explores the sources of the endemic uncertainty which shapes our lives today and in so doing he provides the reader with a brief and accessible introduction to his highly original account developed at greater length in his previous books of life in our liquid modern times

this collection of essays brings together zygmunt bauman and a number of internationally distinguished legal scholars who examine the influence of bauman s recent works on social theory of law and socio legal studies contributors focus on the concept of liquid society and its adoption by legal scholars the volume opens with bauman s analysis of fears and policing in liquid society and continues by examining the social and legal theoretical context and implications of bauman s theory

this book investigates desert islands in postwar anglophone popular culture exploring representations in radio print and screen advertising magazine cartoons cinema video games and comedy drama and reality television drawing on zygmunt bauman s theory of liquid modernity desert island texts are analysed in terms of their intersections with repressive and seductive mechanisms of power chapters focus on the desert island as a conflictively in coherent space that characterises identity as deferred and structured by choice a location whose remoteness undermines satirical critiques of communal identity formation a site whose ambivalent relationship with home and otherness destabilises patriarchal western subjectivity a space bound up with mobility and instantaneity and an expression of radical individuality and underdetermined identity the desert island in popular culture is shown to reflect endorse and critique a profoundly consumerist society that seduces us with promises of coherence with the threat of repression looming if we do not conform

this book explores the transformation of ideas of the material in late twentieth and early twenty first century musical composition new music of this era is argued to reflect a historical moment when the idea of materiality itself is in flux engaging with thinkers such as theodor adorno sara ahmed zygmunt bauman rosi braidotti and timothy morton the author considers music s relationship with changing material conditions from the rise of neo liberalisms and information technologies to new concepts of the natural world drawing on musicology cultural theory and philosophy the author develops a critical understanding of musical bodies objects and the environments of their interaction music is grasped as something that both registers material changes in society whilst also enabling us to practice materiality differently

listens to sermons dances to music and interviews the people sitting in the pews all with the aim of understanding how spiritual power enables these churches to function as agents within their contemporary society ecclesiastical communities in africa draw upon divine power in order to engage in modernity related topics humans are not unresponsive to global flows of meaning they are integrative agents who fashion their world by living in it the kind of modernity arising from these churches does not blindly follow western forms but flows from its own internal logic in which spiritual power occupies central hermeneutical function theological resources contribute to the formation of sociological expressions divine power pertains directly to human constructs which then allows the churches to actively image god for the development of unique forms of modernity arising on the continent

this book develops a comprehensive analysis of contemporary regionalism in the americas which the authors characterise as liquid regionalism given its unstable flexible and loose characteristics it innovates by introducing a new concept to assess regional initiatives in the american continents contributing to latin american and comparative regionalism research agendas the book analyses major regional projects in the americas and develops these into a novel typology of consultation cooperation and integration this typology helps explain the level of commitments and institutional depth of regional initiatives across the continent the book is for scholars postgraduate and undergraduate students interested in the regional and political dynamics of the americas across the social sciences including international relations political science sociology international political economy international trade and history

this book awakens the sociology of sport to the possibilities of re imagining deviance and offers an evocative approach which will appeal both to academics and students alike
