The 2003 Invasion of Iraq: A Decade of Consequences

The 2003 invasion of Iraq, launched by a US-led coalition under the presidency of George W. Bush, remains one of the most consequential and debated military interventions of the 21st century. The ground invasion, involving US, UK, and other coalition forces, quickly overwhelmed the Iraqi army, resulting in the fall of Baghdad on April 9th. This initial phase demonstrated the overwhelming technological superiority of the coalition forces. For example, the precision bombing campaigns minimized civilian casualties compared to previous conflicts, although this claim is still debated. However, the swift military victory marked only the beginning of a protracted and complex occupation, characterized by an insurgency that proved far more resilient and challenging than anticipated.

The post-invasion period was marked by a surge in violence as various insurgent groups, including Sunni and Shia militias, Al-Qaeda in Iraq, and other factions, engaged in a protracted conflict against coalition forces and the newly established Iraqi government. This insurgency significantly destabilized the country, leading to widespread sectarian violence, the displacement of millions of civilians, and the creation of a humanitarian crisis. Furthermore, the war strained relations between the US and its allies, especially those who opposed the invasion on legal and moral grounds.
