understanding of these extremely subtle texts and fully justifies his wider approach to the collection as a whole arguing that Spenser's relationship to literary tradition is more complex than is often thought Brown suggests that Spenser was a self-conscious innovator whose gradual move away from traditional poetics is exhibited by the different texts in the complaints he further suggests that the complaints are a poetics in practice which progress from traditional ideas of poetry to a new poetry that emerges through Spenser's transformation of traditional complaint
