this book responds to a growing interest in death dying and the dead within and beyond the field of death studies the collection defines an understanding of difficult death and examines the differences between death dying and the dead as well as exploring the ethical challenges of researching death in mediated form the collection is attendant to the ways in which difficult deaths are imbricated in power structures both before and after they become mediated in culture as such the work navigates the many political and social complexities and inequalities what might be deemed the difficulties of death dying and the dead the book seeks to expand understandings of the difficulty of death in media and culture through a wide range of chapters from different contexts focused on literature film television and in online environments as well as several chapters examining news reportage of difficult deaths

in late medieval catholicism mourners employed an array of practices to maintain connection with the deceased most crucially the belief in purgatory a middle place between heaven and hell where souls could be helped by the actions of the living in the early sixteenth century the reformation abolished purgatory as its leaders did not want attention to the dead diminishing people s devotion to god but while the reformation was supposed to end communication between the living and dead it turns out the result was in fact more complicated than historians have realized in the three centuries after the reformation protestants imagined continuing relationships with the dead and the desire for these relations came to form an important and since neglected aspect of protestant belief and practice in speaking with the dead in early america historian erik r seeman undertakes a 300 year history of protestant communication with the dead seeman chronicles the story of protestants relationships with the deceased from elizabethan england to puritan new england and then on through the american enlightenment into the middle of the nineteenth century with the explosion of interest in spiritualism he brings together a wide range of sources to uncover the beliefs and practices of both ordinary people especially women and religious leaders this prodigious research reveals how sermons

elegies and epitaphs portrayed the dead as speaking or being spoken to how ghost stories and gothic fiction depicted a permeable boundary between this world and the next and how parlor songs and funeral hymns encouraged singers to imagine communication with the dead speaking with the dead in early america thus boldly reinterprets protestantism as a religion in which the dead played a central role

the forms by which a deceased person may be brought to rest are as many as there are causes of death in most societies the disposal of the corpse is accompanied by some form of celebration or ritual which may range from a simple act of deportment in solitude to the engagement of large masses of people in laborious and creative festivities in a funerary context the term ritual may be taken to represent a process that incorporates all the actions performed and thoughts expressed in connection with a dying and dead person from the preparatory pre death stages to the final deposition of the corpse and the post mortem stages of grief and commemoration the contributions presented here are focused not on the examination of different funerary practices their function and meaning but on the changes of such rituals how and when they occurred and how they may be explained based on case studies from a range of geographical regions and from different prehistoric and historical periods a range of key themes are examined concerning belief and ritual body and deposition place performance and commemoration exploring a complex web of practices
