andy tackles his guilt and grief in the first book of sharon m draper s award winning hazelwood high trilogy tigers don t cry or do they after the death of his longtime friend and fellow hazelwood tiger in a car accident andy the driver blames himself and cannot get past his guilt and pain while his other friends have managed to work through their grief and move on andy allows death to become the focus of his life in the months that follow the accident the lives of andy and his friends are traced through a series of letters articles homework assignments and dialogues and it becomes clear that tigers do indeed need to cry

in august of 1962 civilian medical doctor jay hoyland became an active duty captain and medical officer in the u s army medical corps during the vietnam war for the next twelve months hoyland provided medical support as a flight surgeon to the ninety third helicopter companythe soc trang tigers it was a year that would prove to be pivotal for vietnam the united states and hoyland himself through the eyes of a tiger is the story of one mans tour of duty in the mekong delta from november of 1962 through november of 1963 with the help of hoylands wartime journals and letters sent home to his family he recreates an unvarnished account of his life during this tumultuous time whether it is a heartbreaking visit to a catholic orphanage the adrenaline of combat the unique relationship between brothers in arms or the horrors of the hospital ward hoylands vivid imagery and thoughtful prose paint a realistic portrait of war set against the broader historical context of the vietnam war through the eyes of a tiger is a worthy addition to the scholarship available on the vietnam war but more importantly it reveals the dramatic impact of war both present and future on the soldier himself

blood of the tiger takes readers on a wild ride to save one of the world's rarest animals from a band of chinese billionaires many people think wild tigers are on the road to recovery but they are in greater danger than ever from a menace few experts saw coming there may be only three thousand wild tigers left in the entire world more shocking is the fact that twice that many some six thousand have been bred on farms not for traditional medicine but to supply a luxury goods industry that secretly sells tiger bone wine tiger skin décor and exotic cuisine enjoyed by china's elite two decades ago international wildlife investigator j a mills went undercover to expose bear farming in china and discovered the plot to turn tigers into nothing more than livestock thus begins the story of a personal crusade in which mills mobilizes international forces to awaken the world to a conspiracy so pervasive that it threatens every last tiger in the wild in this memoir of triumph heartbreak and geopolitical intrigue mills and a host of heroic comrades try to thwart a chinese cadre's plan to launch billion dollar industries banking on the extinction of not just wild tigers but also elephants and rhinos her journey takes her across asia into the jungles of india and nepal to russia and africa traveling by means from elephant back to presidential motorcade in the company of man eaters movie stars and world leaders she also journeys to the us where we meet people like carole baskin of big cat rescue who work tirelessly to end cub petting and ban private ownership and breeding of tigers and other big cats she finds reason for hope in the increasing number of chinese who do not want the blood of the last wild tigers to stain their beloved culture and motherland set against the backdrop of china's ascendance to world dominance blood of the tiger tells of a global fight to rein in the forces of greed on behalf of one of the world's most treasured and endangered animals

the figure of the white hunter sahib proudly standing over the carcass of a tiger with a gun in hand is one of the most powerful and enduring images of the empire this book examines the colonial politics that allowed british imperialists to indulge in such grand posturing as the rulers and protectors of indigenous populations this work studies the history of hunting and conservation in colonial india during the high imperial decades of the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries at this time not only did hunting serve as

r k narayan and his social perspective deals with the caste ridden hindu society which narayan presents in his novels his characters are fatalists with explicit faith in the invisible the book presents their half hearted attempts at self assertion however their so called sentimentalism does not bear fruit and they fall back to their former position accepting defeat in life the book brings out vividly narayan s atti tude to life his firm grip of hindu ethos of which he is the product and his failure to come out of it though the west wind has blown much of its dust however detached he sounds himself to the readers his true spirit finds vivid expression in the book at any rate r k narayan is a thoroughly indian novelist par excellence and the aspect is hardly to be overlooked

as the last golden furred tiger shifter in existence charisma gains knows that his best chance to find his soulmate is on the all hallows eve full moon with an enchanted medallion in hand charisma casts the spell for his soulmate hoping against hope that the necklace will find the one woman meant to be his unless he finds his other half he ll go feral his beast slowly taking over when valerie winter sees a beautiful necklace with the image of a tiger on it at a flea market she s overcome with the desire to own it with the cryptic words of the merchant ringing in her ears she takes the necklace home and puts it on before the moon rises on all hallows eve she passes out and wakes up in the woods face to face with a big cat valerie is asked to believe the impossible that shifters exist that the man before her can change into a tiger at will and that she was destined to own the necklace because they re soulmates charisma knows it won t be easy to convince valerie of the truth in the span of a day but if she refuses his advances the necklace will return her to her home and he ll lose her forever what he doesn t expect is interference from the very wiccan who helped him and for valerie s life to be on the line
