ferdinand gregorovius 1821 1891 was a celebrated german medieval historian after studying
 philosophy and theology at the university of königsberg gregorovius moved to rome in 1852
 and became immersed in researching the medieval history of the city first published in 1872
 his monumental study of medieval rome was the first modern account of the subject and
 became the standard reference this english translation of the fourth german edition appeared

between 1894 and 1902 in his work gregorovius discusses the political social and cultural changes in the city from 400 to 1534 making extensive use of primary sources gregorovius also includes the renaissance in his study showing how medieval thought and events influenced political and cultural life and thought during the renaissance volume 8 part 2 covers the period 1522 1534 it examines the effects of the reformation on the papacy and discusses the sack of rome in 1527

the first modern study of the history of medieval rome translated between 1894 and 1902 from the fourth german edition

medieval rome analyses the history of the city of rome between 900 and 1150 a period of major change in the city this volume doesn't merely seek to tell the story of the city from the traditional church standpoint instead it engages in studies of the city's processions material culture legal transformations and sense of the past seeking to unravel the complexities of roman cultural identity including its urban economy social history as seen across the different strata of society and the articulation between the city's regions this new approach serves to underpin a major reinterpretation of rome's political history in the era of the reform papacy one of the greatest crises in rome's history which had a resonance across the entire continent medieval rome is the most systematic analysis ever made of two and a half centuries of rome's history one which saw centuries of stability undermined by external crisis and the long period of reconstruction which followed

english summary this second volume of the catalog of medieval churches in rome is dedicated to the first christian basilica the papal cathedral st giovanni in laterano which was founded by constantine for the first time written and pictorial sources allow for the formation of a description of the medieval exterior and interior of the structure which was fully transformed during the baroque period and again in the 18th and 19th centuries reconstructions of the fallen facade of the 13th century apse and of the ciborium from the magdalene altar as well as studies of the medieval tombs and the magnificent cloister enrich the work in the context of church reform and in competition with the basilica of st peter the lateran clergy developed an ideological self image based on legends from the 11th century onwards this becomes evident

both in construction and interior design and is also manifested in the significant innovations of the 13th and 14th centuries.
