this book examines the status of private actors as subjects of law under the rules of the international law of the sea providing a methodology for the notion of a single legal personality it provides a clear understanding of membership in international law in order to establish to what extent private actors can be rights holders or duty bearers it does this by taking a theoretical perspective which allows the reader to interpret their relevance in international law this unique and innovative work makes a significant contribution to the current scholarly debates on private actors in international law

globalisation and technological innovation have been fuelling the need for increasing levels of trust in private actors such as companies or special interest groups to regulate and enforce significant aspects of people s daily lives from environmental and social protection to the areas of food safety advertising and financial markets this book investigates the trust vested in private actors from the perspective of european citizens it answers the question of whether private actors live up to citizens expectations or whether more should be done as to the safeguarding of citizens interests several cross cutting studies explore how private

regulation and enforcement are embedded in eu law the book offers an innovative approach to private regulation and enforcement by focusing on the specific eu context which unlike the national and transnational ones has not yet been widely explored this context merits a stand alone analysis because of the unique normative framework of the eu as a particular polity itself but also in relation to its member states with an overall analysis of the main aspects of private regulation and enforcement across different policy fields of the eu the book adds a missing tile to the mosaic of public private governance studies

this book assesses the recent growth and future prospects of private transnational environmental certification and standards regimes examining in detail to what degree and under what circumstances do these transnational regimes truly influence industrial environmental practices in developing countries

this volume explores a variety of forms of transnational private governance where non state actors cooperate across borders to establish rules and standards accepted as legitimate by other agents transnational private governance is a core feature of the devolution of power that we observe in the global realm and that is bringing about new forms of authority transnational private governance provides theoretically and empirically informed insights into the interactions between states and non state actors including domains beyond intergovernmental organizations conventional non governmental organizations and multinational enterprises covering a wide range of arrangements from highly formal devolutions of power to lax and informal platforms of interaction between private actors contributing to the latest generation of globalization studies the authors consider the relationship between states and markets as closely integrated and seek to broaden the scope of enquiry by including new patterns and agents of change on a transnational basis this book will be of great interest to researchers and students of political science international political economy economics business studies globalisation and law

over the past twenty years private military and security companies pmscs have become significant elements of national security arrangements assuming many of the functions that have traditionally been undertaken by state armies given the centrality of control over the use of coercive force to the functioning and identity of the modern state and to international order these developments clearly are of great practical and conceptual interest this edited volume provides an interdisciplinary overview of pmscs what they are why they have emerged in their current form how they operate their current and likely future military political social and economic impact and the moral and legal constraints that do and should apply to their operation the book focuses firstly upon normative issues raised by the development of pmscs and then upon state regulation and policy towards pmscs examining finally the impact of pmscs on civil military relations it takes an innovative approach bringing theory and empirical research into mutually illuminating contact includes contributions from experts in ir political theory international and corporate law and economics and also breaks important new

ground by including philosophical discussions of pmscs

since anu bradford s groundbreaking book on the brussels effect there is a vastly evolving literature on the eu as a global regulatory actor as well as the global reach of eu law this edited collection connects to this debate yet it shifts the focus from the currently predominant public law focus to investigating european and eu private law and to connecting to literature and research on transnational law to that end it proceeds first conceptually by introducing and giving shape to the notion of a european transnational private law through four conceptual contributions by the editors secondly it focuses on several sectors finance taxation investment consumer law labour law and topics climate litigation global value chains non discrimination to trace sector specifically the role of eu private law in relation to transnational legal ordering

rethinking private authority examines the role of non state actors in global environmental politics arguing that a fuller understanding of their role requires a new way of conceptualizing private authority jessica green identifies two distinct forms of private authority one in which states delegate authority to private actors and another in which entrepreneurial actors generate their own rules persuading others to adopt them drawing on a wealth of empirical evidence spanning a century of environmental rule making green shows how the delegation of authority to private actors has played a small but consistent role in multilateral environmental agreements over the past fifty years largely in the area of treaty implementation this contrasts with entrepreneurial authority where most private environmental rules have been created in the past two decades green traces how this dynamic and fast growing form of private authority is becoming increasingly common in areas ranging from organic food to green building practices to sustainable tourism she persuasively argues that the configuration of state preferences and the existing institutional landscape are paramount to explaining why private authority emerges and assumes the form that it does in depth cases on climate change provide evidence for her arguments groundbreaking in scope rethinking private authority demonstrates that authority in world politics is diffused across multiple levels and diverse actors and it offers a more complete picture of how private actors are helping to shape our response to today s most pressing environmental problems

speaking private authority the construction of sustainability in forests and fisheries expands upon current understandings of the emergent global phenomenon that is private authority as private authority is becoming increasingly important in the conduct of global governance broadening our collective understanding of it will prove beneficial roberto j flores argues that private actors are not simply outgrowths of existent social structures or material conditions rather they are purposive agents strategically pursuing an agenda therefore explaining private authority requires an examination of the constitutive elements that underlie this social phenomenon to which the author applies an analytical framework that

combines social network theory with discourse analysis the author applies these tools to two cases taken from the environmental sector forests and fisheries and finds that as environmental politics takes on an increasingly networked character the actors that are best able to generate and wield private authority are those that strategically place themselves in between networks through the construction of discursive nodal points around which competing actors are forced to converge at the level of identity the case studies specifically look at how particular actors leveraged construction of the sustainable development concept in order to strategically place themselves in advantageous positions for exercising private authority

this book contributes to the literature on organized crime by providing a detailed account of the various nuances of what happens when criminal organizations misuse or penetrate legitimate businesses it advances the existing scholarship on attacks infiltration and capture of legal businesses by organized crime and sheds light on the important role the private sector can play to fight back it considers a range of industries from bars and restaurants to labour intensive enterprises such as construction and waste management to sectors susceptible to illicit activities including transportation wholesale and retail trade and businesses controlled by fragmented legislation such as gambling organized criminal groups capitalize on legitimate businesses beleaguered by economic downturns government regulations natural disasters societal conflict and the covid 19 pandemic to survive some private companies have even become the willing partners of criminal organizations thus the relationships between licit businesses and organized crime are highly varied and can range from victimization of businesses to willing collusion and even exploitation of organized crime by the private sector albeit with arrangements that typically allow plausible deniability in other words these relationships are highly diverse and create a complex reality which is the focus of the articles presented here this book will appeal to students academics and policy practitioners with an interest in organized crime it will also provide important supplementary reading for undergraduate and graduate courses on topics such as transnational security issues transnational organized crime international criminal justice criminal finance non state actors international affairs comparative politics and economics and business courses

this is the first in depth conceptual and empirical analysis of the political issues processes and themes associated with private security provision and its growth in the postwar era examining why private security has become so prominent what its relationship to the state is and how it can be controlled

credit rating agencies play a powerful and contentious role in the governance of global financial markets introducing an original framework for delegating political authority to private actors this book explains common trends in the regulatory use of private ratings for public purposes and analyzes regulatory changes after the financial crisis

governments today are too often unwilling to intervene in global commerce and international organizations are too often unable to govern effectively in their place firms increasingly cooperate internationally to establish the rules and standards of behavior for themselves and for others taking on the mantle of authority to govern specific issue areas are they stepping into the breach to supply needed collective goods or are they organizing themselves in order to prevent governments from interfering in their business this book explores the meaning of this private international authority both for theory and policy through case studies of specific industries associations and issue areas in both contemporary and historical perspective contributors include pamela burke lynn mytelka and michel delapierre liora salter susan sell timothy sinclair deborah spar and michael webb

the book explores the role of new modes of governance in helping future member states to cope with their accession to the eu it examines the extent to which civil society and business have assisted the governments of southern central and eastern european accession countries in taking on the ever more comprehensive body of eu laws and regulations

voluntary sustainability standards vss and other private governance instruments e g fair trade forest stewardship council fair wear foundation globalgap are increasingly regulating global production processes and economic activities vss verify the compliance of products or production processes with sustainability standards the importance of voluntary sustainability standards is now widely recognized after being operational for more than two decades they have established themselves as private governance instruments this recognition is also exemplified by their integration in public regulatory approaches governments and international organizations are partnering with voluntary sustainability standards to pursue sustainable development policies we witness the integration of vss in the regulatory approaches of local and national governments in countries around the world the integration of vss in trade policies the emergence of public private initiatives to govern global supply chains and the inclusion of private initiatives in experimentalist governance regimes this special issue seeks to bring together research on the interface between private and public governance we welcome contributions which analyze specific case studies on the emergence and development of these private public interactions the design of public private governance the effectiveness of these governance arrangements and critical perspectives on the possibilities and limitations of such public private forms of governance we welcome multi disciplinary perspectives including contributions from economics political science law sociology geography and anthropology papers selected for this special issue are subject to a peer review procedure with the aim of rapid and wide dissemination of research results developments and applications

the tanzania private health sector assessment provides information on the size location and characteristics of non state health service providers in tanzania it also identifies challenges and opportunities for the government of tanzania and international community to leverage the potential of these providers to achieve

the field of peacemaking is in turbulent change there are more peacemaking actors than before but fewer success stories and an increasing number of violent conflicts tend to resist negotiated agreements tools and practices created for traditional inter and intra state conflicts have become ineffective and revision of old mediation practices is called for this book examines how the private peacemaking organisations have faced this challenge in the 21st century private peacemakers have become a central part of peace diplomacy and have appeared as flexible actors whose innovative thinking paves the way for reconsidering and reinventing old practices of mediation instead of emphasizing the act of resolution a new emphasis is given to the transformation of violence into a peace system the complexity of conflict and the inadequateness of rational management furthermore this shift has brought civic society actors from the field of reconciliation to the field of peace mediation this new pragmatic approach under development can be called dialogic mediation

this book seeks to understand the investigation and settlement of employer employee disputes within companies it argues that there is effectively no democratic knowledge about or control over corporate security due to companies preference for private out of court settlements when faced with norm violations raised by employees this book fills the knowledge gap by providing an overview of the corporate security sector including legal frameworks and an analysis of the role and powers of private investigative services inhouse security forensic

accountants and forensic legal investigators it draws on close observation case studies and interviews with practitioners in and around the industry corporate investigations corporate justice and public private relations also looks at public private relationships in this sector to propose policy remedies applicable to all corporate security providers regardless of the disparate professional backgrounds and skill sets of their staff

there has been rapid proliferation of public private partnerships in areas of human rights environmental protection and development in global governance this book demonstrates how different forms of partnership legitimacy and accountability interact and pinpoints trade offs between democratic values in partnership operations

the relevance of contracting and self regulation in consumer markets has increased rapidly in recent years in particular in the platform economy online platforms provide opportunities for businesses and consumers to connect with strangers often across borders trading products and services in this new economy platform operators create apply and enforce their own rules in their contractual relationships with users this book examines the substance of these rules and the space for private governance beyond the reach of state regulation vanessa mak explores recent developments in lawmaking beyond the state with case studies focusing on companies such as airbnb and amazon the book asks how common values and objectives of eu law such as consumer protection and contractual fairness can be safeguarded when lawmaking shifts to a space outside the reach of state law

many of the interests protected by public law are regularly violated by powerful private actors analyzing the application of public law rights to the private sphere this book develops a theoretical framework for the application of human and constitutional rights in relations between private parties

partnerships are now pervasive in global education and development but are they creating equitable cooperative and positive relationships through case studies of prominent multistakeholder partnerships including the education cannot wait fund and global partnership for education as well as a comprehensive analysis of the global education network this book exposes clear power imbalances that persist in the international aid environment the author reveals how actors and organizations from high income countries continue to wield disproportionate influence while the private sector holds a growing degree of authority in public policy circles in light of such evidence this book questions if partnerships truly ameliorate power asymmetries or if they instead reproduce the precise inequities they are meant to eliminate the use of partnerships for international aid and development has become ubiquitous and their value has been too little questioned for education francine menashy s book remedies this with a detailed probing analysis of such partnerships in theory and practice from the foreword by steven j klee university

how does eu internal market law in particular the rules on free movement and competition apply to private regulation what issues arise if a bar association were to regulate advertising when a voluntary product standard impedes trade or when a sporting body restricts the cross border transfer of a football player covering the eu s free movement and competition rules from a general and sector specific angle focusing specifically on the legal profession standard setting and sports this book is the first systematic study of eu economic law in areas where private regulation is both important and legally controversial mislav mataija discusses how the interpretation of both free movement and competition rule adapts to the rise of private regulation and examines the diminishing relevance of the public private distinction as private regulators take on increasingly important tasks the legal scrutiny over their measures becomes broader and moves towards what mataija describes as regulatory autonomy this approach broadly disciplines but also recognizes the legitimacy of private regulators granting them an explicit margin of discretion and focusing on governance and process considerations rather than on their impact on trade and competition the book also demonstrates how the application of eu internal market law fits in the context of strategic attempts by the eu institutions to negotiate substantive reforms in areas where private regulation is pervasive surveying recent case law of the court of justice of the european union and the practice of the european commission mataija demonstrates how eu internal market law is used as a control mechanism over private regulators

this research agenda provides a broad and comprehensive overview of the field of multilevel governance illustrating theoretical and normative approaches and identifying prevailing gaps in research it offers a cutting edge agenda for future investigations

this book explores the nature and scope of the provision requiring states to ensure respect for international humanitarian law ihl contained within common article 1 of the 1949 geneva conventions it examines the interpretation and application of this provision in a range of contexts both thematic and country specific accepting the clearly articulated notion of respect for ihl it builds on the existing literature studying the meaning of ensure respect and outlines an understanding of the concept in situations such as enacting implementing legislation diplomatic interactions regulating private actors targeting detaining persons under ihl in non

international armed conflict protecting civilians including internally displaced populations and prosecuting war crimes it also considers topical issues such as counter terrorism and foreign fighting the book will be a valuable resource for practitioners academics and researchers it provides much needed practical reflection for states as to what ensuring respect entails so that governments are able to address these obligations

hailed by some as fundamental pillar of global governance and criticized by others as manifestation of top down globalism multi stakeholder partnerships have become the new mantra of policy makers around the globe however our understanding of what drives success and failure in these hybrid institutions remains scetchy and incomplete this book will introduce a production theory of partnering which describes how the contributions actors add to a partnership are translated into results the objective of this new perspective on collaboration is to make sense of the complex dynamics partnerships face and to derive fundamental propositions on how governance structures should be designed to make partnerships succeed

since the turn of the millennium world wide initiatives from the private sector have turned the regulatory environment for food businesses upside down for the first time in legal literature this book analyses private law initiatives relating to the food chain often referred to as private voluntary standards or schemes private standards are used to remedy flaws in legislation in order to reach higher levels of consumer protection than the ones chosen by the eu legislature and to manage risks and liability beyond the traditional limits of food businesses we see that litigation is no longer solely framed by legislative requirements but ever more by private standards such as globalgap brc ifs sqf and iso these private standards incorporate public law requirements thus embedding them in contractual relations and exporting them beyond the jurisdiction of public legislators other standards focus on corporate social responsibility or sustainability this book also addresses how private religious standards such as kosher and halal play a role in defining specific markets of growing importance it is noted that organic standards have found an interesting symbioses with public law another development on this topic is that food businesses are inspected more often by private auditors than by public inspectors effects in terms of receiving or being denied certification far outweigh public law sanctions in short private law has changed an entire legal infrastructure for the food sector it emerges as competing with the public law regulatory infrastructure this book is of interest to all who concern themselves with food law legislation and litigation and the evolving role of private standards on changing the landscape of food chains and innovation

in the past few years numerous authors have highlighted the emergence of transnational climate initiatives such as city networks private certification schemes and business self regulation in the policy domain of climate change while these transnational governance arrangements can surely contribute to solving the

problem of climate change their development by different types of sub and non state actors does not imply a weakening of the intergovernmental level on the contrary many transnational climate initiatives use the international climate regime as a point of reference and have adopted various rules and procedures from international agreements rethinking authority in global climate governance puts forward this argument and expands upon it using case studies which suggest that the effective operation of transnational climate initiatives strongly relies on the existence of an international regulatory framework created by nation states thus this book emphasizes the centrality of the intergovernmental process clustered around the united nations framework convention on climate change unfccc and underscores that multilateral treaty making continues to be more important than many scholars and policy makers suppose this book will be of great interest to students and scholars of global environmental politics climate change and sustainable development

the concepts and values that underpin traditional constitutionalism are increasingly being challenged by political realities that place substantial power beyond the state among the few certainties of a global economy is the growing incongruity between the political the world of things that need to be ordered collectively in order to sustain society and the state the major institution of authoritative political decision making during modern times the consequences and possible remedies of this double disjunction of politics and state and of state and constitution form the centre of an open debate about constitutionalism beyond the state the essays gathered in this collection explore the range of issues raised by this debate the effects of recent changes on two of the main building blocks of constitutionalism statehood and democracy are examined in parts i and ii since the movement of overcoming statehood has arguably been advanced furthest in the european context the question of the future of constitutionalist ideas in the framework of the eu provides the key theme of part iii the remaining parts consider possible transformations or substitutes the engagement of constitutions with international law offers one line of transmutation of constitutionalism part iv and the diffusion of constitutionalism into separate social spheres provides an alternative way of pursuing constitutionalism in a new key part vi finally the ability of the theory of global administrative law examined in part v to offer an alternative account of the potential of jurisdictional control of global governing processes is examined through these explorations the book offers cross disciplinary insights into the impact of recent political and economic changes on modern constitutionalism and an assessment of the prospects for constitutionalism in a transnational environment
