worms natural history is riddled with them literature is crawling with them from antiquity to today the ubiquitous and multiform worm provokes an immediate discomfort and unconscious distancing it remains us against them in anthropocentric anxiety so there is always something muddled or dirty or even offensive when talking about worms rehabilitating the lowly worm into a powerful aesthetic trope janelle a schwartz proposes a new framework for understanding such a strangely animate nature worms she declares are the very matter with which the romantics rethought the relationship between a material world in constant flux and the human mind working to

understand it worm work studies the lesser known natural historical records of abraham trembley and his contemporaries and the familiar works of erasmus darwin charles darwin william blake mary shelley and john keats to expose the worm as an organism that is not only reviled as a taxonomic terror but revered as a sign of great order in nature as well as narrative this book traces a pattern of cultural production a vermiculture that is as transformative of matter as it is of mind it distinguishes decay or division as positive processes in romantic era writings compounded by generation or renewal and used to represent the biocentric complex structuring of organicism offering the worm as an archetypal figure through which to recast the evolution of a literary order alongside questions of taxonomy from 1740 to 1820 and on schwartz unearths romanticism as a rich humus of natural historical investigation and literary creation

thomas chalmers in his classic sermon entitled the expulsive power of a new affection correctly ascribes subjective power to subjective affections for love does have an expulsive power whether one loves god to the despising of self or loves self to the despising of god but he incorrectly sides with objective justification full pardon and gracious acceptance as the power that creates love and the engine that empowers sanctification he is right to suggest that a new affection has expulsive power but wrong to suggest that the source and power of a new affection is primarily in the indicative benefits jonathan edwards on the other hand sided with regeneration for the obvious reason that without a new nature the natural man can only be constrained by outside considerations the indicatives to superficially walk in newness of life the imperatives such considerations might produce change that rises as high as the outward performance of the legalist but it is still only the superficial height that self love alone can achieve the spirit's work of illuminating the higher glory and beauty of christ to the soul is the only source of an affection that can be called new if the expulsive power of a new affection does not dethrone self as one's primary concern in life and theology then what exactly is being expelled by the power of the gospel if one's religion does not surpass one's primary concern for what's in it for oneself then one's self love may have an expulsive power but it will be the light of the glory of god in the face of christ jesus that is expelled by the power of self love the irony of the cross was that christ was crucified by those who already had a knowledge of god's steadfast love and rejoiced in spiritual privileges the proper force and source behind the believer's love for god is not found in the objective benefits as they reflect upon the believer's high privileges but god's power alone as it is exerted in the soul by the spirit imparting a new heart new affections and a new principle of action that did not exist prior good fruit is produced only by a good tree and however constrained by outside forces a bad tree cannot be manipulated to produce fruit contrary to its nature

a plato reader offers eight of plato s best known works euthyphro apology crito meno phaedo symposium phaedrus and republic unabridged expertly introduced and annotated and in widely admired translations by c d c reeve g m a grube alexander nehamas and paul woodruff the collection features socrates as its central character and a model of the examined life its range allows us to see him in action in very different settings and philosophical modes from the elenctic socrates of the meno and the dialogues concerning his trial and death to the erotic socrates of the symposium and phaedrus to the dialectician of the republic of reeve s translation of this final masterpiece lloyd p gerson writes taking full advantage of s r slings new greek text of the republic reeve has given us a translation both accurate and limpid loving attention to detail and deep familiarity with plato s thought are evident on every page reeve s brilliant decision to cast the dialogue into direct speech produces a compelling impression of immediacy unmatched by other english translations currently available

this collection features plato s writings on sex and love in the preeminent translations of stanley lombardo paul woodruff and alexander nehamas d s hutchinson and c d c reeve reeve s introduction provides a wealth of historical information about plato and socrates and the sexual norms of classical athens his introductory essay looks closely at the dialogues themselves and includes the following sections socrates and the art of love socrates and athenian paiderastia loving socrates love and the ascent to the beautiful the art and psychology of love explained and writing about love

this work by the english puritan jeremiah burroughs 1599 1646 is based on hebrews 11 25 choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of god than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season it is a masterful treatise on suffering and self denial this is the first modern edition of this rare work since its initial printing in 1641

a model of the kind of text one needs for lecture courses the translation is extremely readable and made even more accessible by intelligent printing decisions on dividing the text spacing for clarification etc the notes are kept to a minimum but appear when they are really needed for comprehension and are truly informative and the introduction admirably presents both basic information and a sense of current scholarly opinion s g nugent princeton university

around her she is soon to find that her luck is running out it becomes apparent to contessa that she needs a little protection of her own when a dark figure from her past comes back to haunt her when the monster that killed her parents comes looking for revenge contessa is forced to return to her childhood home to save her brother in a life or death battle contessa is forced to put aside her pride and let someone else take care of her for once

the afterlife of eden tells the story of one woman s transformation from a wistful girl trapped in her hometown to a vicious bloodthirsty monster after her father dies suddenly during a hunting trip eden rosewood is forced to live with her abusive mother dreaming of a new life free from her mother s cruel hand one fateful night eden runs away into city lost and unsure little does eden know the city holds a dark side after she is attacked by a mysterious man eden feels her body change her sense of smell is heightened her heart stops beating and she feels the undeniable hunger for human blood about the author a l crisp is currently studying to become a tattoo and piercing artist she has a deep interest in the occult and paranormal which she uses as inspiration for her writing

britney summers is still fighting to know why she lost her memory though she is starting to believe more and more that her lost memories are the work of her evil and biological father devolin voltron who also happens to be a wizard who has been trying to kill her for the past two years the only hope britney has of regaining her memories and defeating devolin is her adoptive brother andy summers but to help britney kill the wizard andy must also try to recall a connection of family blood with britney that he does not remember having so the question now becomes can their family love overcome their foe even though they are only britneys adoptive family

drawing on both historical analysis and theories from the modern affective sciences shakespeare and disgust argues that the experience of revulsion is one of shakespeare s central dramatic concerns known as the gatekeeper emotion disgust is the affective process through which humans protect the boundaries of their physical bodies from material contaminants and their social bodies from moral contaminants accordingly the emotion provided shakespeare with a master category of compositional tools poetic images thematic considerations and narrative possibilities to interrogate the violation and preservation of such boundaries whether in the form of compromised bodies compromised moral actors or compromised social orders designed to offer both focused readings and birds eye coverage this volume alternates between chapters devoted to the sustained analysis of revulsion in specific plays titus andronicus timon of athens coriolanus othello and hamlet and chapters presenting a general overview of shakespeare s engagement with certain kinds of prototypical disgust elicitors including food disease bodily violation race and sex disgust disgust the book argues is one of the central engines of human behaviour and somewhat surprisingly it must be seen as a centrepiece of shakespeare s affective universe

obscene poetry servants slanders against their masters the diabolical acts of those who committed massacre and regicide this is a book about the harmful outward manifestation of inner malice villainy in french culture 1463 1610 in pre modern france villainous offences were countered if never fully contained by intersecting legal and literary responses combining the methods of legal anthropology with literary and historical analysis this study examines villainy across juridical documents criminal records and literary texts whilst few people obtained justice through the law many pursued out of court settlements of one kind or another literary texts commemorated villainies both fictitious and historical literature sometimes instantiated the process of redress and enabled the transmission of conflicts from one context to another villainy in france follows this overflowing current of pre modern french culture examining its impact within france and across the english channel scholars and cultural critics of the

anglophone world have long been fascinated by villainy and villains this book reveals the subject s significant frenchness and establishes a transcultural approach to it in law and literature in this study villainy s particular significance emerges through its representation in authors remembered for their less than respectable even criminal activities françois villon clément marot françois rabelais pierre de l estoile christopher marlowe ben jonson john marston and george chapman villainy in france affords legal literary comparison of these authors alongside many of their lesser known contemporaries in so doing it reinterprets french conflicts within a wider european context from the mid fifteenth century to the early seventeenth century
