in 1910 isaiah shembe was struggling he had left his family and quit his job as a sanitation worker to become a baptist evangelist but he ended his first mission without much to show little did he know that he would soon establish the nazaretha church as he began to attract attention from people left behind by industrial capitalism in south africa by his death in 1935 shembe was an internationally known prophet and healer described by his peers as better off than all the black people in a prophet of the people isaiah shembe and the making of a south african church historian lauren v jarvis provides a fascinating and intimate portrait of one of south africa s most famous religious figures and in turn the making of modern south africa following shembe from his birth

in the 1860s across many environments and contexts jarvis illuminates the tight links between the spread of christianity strategies of evasion and the capacious forms of community that continue to shape south africa today

in the people's zion joel cabrita tells the transatlantic story of southern africa's largest popular religious movement zionism it began in zion city a utopian community established in 1900 just north of chicago the zionist church which promoted faith healing drew tens of thousands of marginalized americans from across racial and class divides it also sent missionaries abroad particularly to southern africa where its uplifting spiritualism and pan racialism resonated with urban working class whites and blacks circulated throughout southern africa by zion city's missionaries and literature zionism thrived among white and black workers drawn to johannesburg by the discovery of gold as in chicago these early devotees of faith healing hoped for a color blind society in which they could acquire equal status and purpose amid demoralizing social and economic circumstances defying segregation and later apartheid black and white zionists formed a uniquely cosmopolitan community that played a key role in remaking the racial politics of modern southern africa connecting cities regions and societies usually considered in isolation cabrita shows how zionists on either side of the atlantic used the democratic resources of evangelical christianity to stake out a place of belonging within rapidly changing societies in doing so they laid claim to nothing less than the kingdom of god today the number of american zionists is small but thousands of independent zionist churches counting millions of members still dot the southern african landscape

this book tells the story of one of the largest and most influential african churches in south africa

this work looks at the period of south african history before the mineral age and particularly the years of british rule up to the 1850s and establishes its

importance in the shaping of south african society it argues that the roots of the 20th century racial state lie in this period when the cape was first integrated into the british empire of free trade

this work briefly records the lives and achievements of 502 men and women who contributed or are still contributing to the natural history of the free state and lesotho between 1829 and 2013

the idea that the period of social turbulence in the nineteenth century was a consequence of the emergence of the powerful zulu kingdom under shaka has been written about extensively as a central episode of southern african history considerable dynamic debate has focused on the idea that this period the mfecane left much of the interior depopulated thereby justifying white occupation one view is that the time of troubles owed more to the delagoa bay slave trade and the demands of the labour hungry cape colonists than to shaka s empire building but is there sufficient evidence to support the argument the mfecane aftermath investigates the very nature of historical debate and examines the uncertain foundations of much of the previous historiography

when sister emma and the five women who accompanied her from england crossed the orange river early in 1874 they exchanged the comfortable mainstream of anglican church life for the rigours of pioneering new works in an undeveloped country living conditions were primitive travel was hard and money was always in short supply the newly formed community of st michael and all angels opened the first girls schools north of the orange and the first hospital in the free state at kimberley sister henrietta achieved a world first through her successful campaign for the state registration of nurses four sisters were besieged in kimberley during the anglo boer war and in bloemfontein their mother house became a military hospital by faith and determination the community recovered st michael s school was raised to new standards of excellence while the sisters expanded their mission to include

the autobiography of sir harry smith 1st baronet of aliwal is as exciting varied and adventurous as the epic life that he led he joined the british army in the 1st battalion of the 95th rifles whose dark green uniform he was proud to wear and despite an inauspicious posting along with the disastrous expedition to montevideo in 1807 his talents began to emerge these talents were to be brought to bear on three other continents in the service of the british a contemporary of and good friend of other famed writers of the rifles such as sir john kincaid major george simmons and jonathan leach these characters appear in their varied guises throughout the narrative to give it a distinctly rifle brigade feeling the autobiography was originally published in two parts however in terms of phases or major periods of his life it is best to describe them in three distinct eras the napoleonic period covers sir harry s career in the 95th through out the peninsular war fighting in the light division from victory to victory his peninsular medal when issued in 1847 came with 12 clasps coruna busaco fuentes d onoro ciudad rodrigo badajoz salamanca vittoria pyrences nivelle nive orthez toulouse to represent the hard fought and glorious victories he had participated in however perhaps his most fortuitous discovery during this period was juana his wife who having seen all here property destroyed in badajoz came to the british lines to seek protection sir harry also participated in the waterloo campaign in 1815 and provides a number of

vivid anecdotes and flashes of action the second period was in the emergent british empire in india where he trained and fought alongside native forces in the first anglo sikh war his victory at aliwal on the sutlej in which he was outnumbered almost two to one is widely regarded as the turning point of the war and led to further expansion what would become the raj of the battle itself the following quote might serve mr b genn late of the 15th hussars who had served under him in india in 1846 and who had fired over his grave as soon as i had opened the door a fine engraving of sir harry greeted me it had been bought at a sale the old veteran spoke of his commander always as the dear old man when i asked him if he thought him a good general he fired up quickly why think of the battle of aliwal not a mistake anywhere smith s next major positing was to the south africa where he played a major role in shaping the form of the colony the evident differences between the natives boers and the administration that would flare up over the forty years since the ending of smith s time are littered amongst the pages of his writing of lasting fame can still be found here in the naming of numerous towns not least of which the city of ladysmith named after his wife juana a passionate man often wild of temper but brilliant and balanced nevertheless an anecdote reported in his autobiography gives a little flavour of the man it was a common habit with sir harry smith to threaten to jump down people s throats boots spurs and all and he once on a field of battle sent a message seasoned with some fearful expletives to a colonel that if he kept his regiment so much to the front he d have him knee haltered but the fine old general drew a line at swearing and never allowed of personal abuse text taken whole and complete from the 1902 edition in one volume published in london by john murray original 800 pages author lieutenant general sir harry henry george wakelyn smith bart g c b 1787 1860 editor george charles moore smith 1858 1940 linked toc and 16 illustrations

george mccall theal 1837 1919 was a prolific south african historian and civil servant after working as a missionary between 1875 1880 he was appointed magistrate of tamacha before taking a position as a clerk in the government and became keeper of the cape colony archives he was appointed colonial

historiographer in 1891 these volumes first published in 1908 contain theal s detailed history of south africa between 1795 1894 focusing on the political history of the country theal explores the british control of cape colony and the reactions of the dutch setters to increasing british immigration discussing the political consequences of the establishment of the various boer republics and the growth of zulu power in south africa these volumes provide valuable details on the political history of south africa and reveal contemporary attitudes towards the history and ideas of colonisation volume 3 covers the colonies between 1846 1860

originally published in 1927 and edited by lady winifred anne henrietta christiana herbert burghclere this book is a collection of the duke of wellington s letters to one of his regular correspondents and friend mary catherine gascoyne cecil marchioness of salisbury the letters in this volume cover the years 1850 1852 the last two years of the duke of wellington s life it ends with the duke s final note dated september 13 1952 the eve of his death the duke s actions were sometimes mistaken his judgments sometimes faulty but the advocatus diaboli can find nothing to challenge in the limpid sincerity of his selfless motives in these letters too the man s kindliness the good nature he proclaimed as so important an ingredient even in public affairs is markedly apparent it is also an illustration of the force of willpower to see an octogenarian able to put through the business which every day brought him he might grumble that every animal but the duke of wellington is allowed a rest but the myriad tasks the countless courtesies and kindnesses were achieved largely by his lifelong system to do the business of the day in the day it is therefore to be hoped that the perusal of these letters will give their readers a more intimate acquaintance with one whose whole career and character must be a source of pride to those of his own race illustrated with portraits
