this classic is one of the most cited and novel approaches to psychology ever written hans eysenck presents a descriptive and causal model of human personality in accord with the major concepts of experimental psychology and the physiological and neurological mechanisms that form the biological basis of behavior patterns his proposal for an alliance between personality and physiology represented a major innovation in the field of psychology distinguished his research from his contemporaries and set the stage for a wealth of research to come before this foundational work eysenck had initially constructed a model of personality

in such works as dimensions of personality and the experimental study of personality but these were primarily descriptive in nature a second phase of research included his dynamics of anxiety and hysteria and experiments with drugs where he provided causal analysis by reference to concepts then current in experimental psychology the biological basis of personality represents eysenck s third phase when he dug deeper to find biological causes underlying the psychological concepts of emotion excitation and inhibition which had formed the building blocks of his earlier efforts in this work the causal links he postulates between personality variables and neurological and physiological discoveries establish a realistic model that takes theory out of the field of mere speculation as sybil eysenck makes clear in her new preface this book paved the way for a marriage of the experimental and individual difference approach in personality psychology

an outcome of the 1930 series of lane medical lectures at stanford university to develop the completed personality a long series of interactions between the original basis and the surrounding environment is essential a discussion of the effects on developing personalities of uniting entire individuals and of transplanting organs and parts leads to a convincing demonstration of the high improbability of the inheritance of acquired characters from the chapter on exaggerated deviations from racial types in which the author treats of dwarfs and giants we are led into a section on deviations in structural types among various breeds of dogs the closing chapters treat mainly of the two normal adult types the dolichocephalic linear long headed and the brachycephalic lateral short headed their characteristics geographic distribution and age modifications a brief section is devoted to the sex glands senility and rejuvenation the author demonstrating that the sex gland rejuvenation idea is based upon an entirely erroneous conception man s deviation from his nearest animal relatives namely intellectual achievement has probably been initiated by two evolutionary changes 1 some mutation which has resulted in the retention of head proportions comparable to those found in the fetal stages of the higher mammals this gives a disproportionately large cranium and big brain with small facial region as compared to the reverse adult proportions among other mammals 2 a germinal mutation resulting in an exaggerated prolongation of childhood and the stages of immaturity to more than twenty years thus extending enormously the learning period of man there are considerable experimental material over seventy figures and a bibliography of 260 titles

personality pathology which is characterized by a pervasive maladaptive and inflexible pattern of thoughts emotions and behaviors has long been considered a set of categories that are distinct from each other and from normal personality research over the past three decades however has challenged that assumed separation and instead suggests that abnormal personality is merely a maladaptive extension of the same features that describe the personalities of all humans using basic personality research to inform the personality disorders will present the work of prominent thinkers at the intersections of social personality developmental and clinical psychology to consider theoretical and empirical issues relevant to how basic personality research can inform the scientific understanding of personality pathology surveying cutting edge research on the science of basic personality and demonstrating how these ideas and methods can be applied to the conceptualization of pathology the book first provides a historical overview followed by an account of the current state of the personality disorder literature ensuing chapters highlight critical issues in the assessment and conceptualization of personality its development across the life course and biological underpinnings these chapters are valuable primers on the basic science of personality from specific genes to complex social interactions furthermore each chapter aims not only to elucidate current understandings of personality but to demonstrate its direct application to clinical diagnosis and conceptualization using basic personality research to inform the personality disorders is the first edited volume to present such diverse perspectives across biological developmental clinical and social psychology from leading researchers in basic and disordered personality and will be of interest to a broad range of students scientists and practitioners
