die spannende biographie eines der grÖssten werke der weltliteratur mehr als die bibel hat dantes göttliche komödie unsere vorstellung von hölle und paradies geprägt wie konnte ein werk italienischer sprache aus dem 14 jahrhundert das schon zeitgenossen nur mit hilfe von kommentaren entschlüsselten ein globales kulturgut werden wie gelangte etwa dantes herrscher der hölle luzifer in japanische manga die romanistin franziska meier folgt der verschlungenen geschichte dieses jahrtausendbuchs an dessen ruhm nur homers odyssee und shakespeares dramen heranreichen wie kommt es dass ein 700 jahre altes buch so vielen menschen ein begriff ist obwohl es nur die wenigsten gelesen haben auch bücher haben ein mitunter langes leben der erfolg der göttlichen komödie allerdings war und ist im höchsten maße unwahrscheinlich dantes dichtung ist im grunde unübersetzbar dennoch liegt die commedia inzwischen selbst in den entlegensten sprachen vor szenen und bilder des noch ganz dem mittelalterlichen weltbild entstammenden werkes namentlich der besuch in der hölle wurden immer wieder umgedeutet und so kreativ weitergesponnen dass vom original manchmal wenig übrigblieb für europa wurde dieses jahrtausendbuch zur blaupause und dichtern aus früheren kolonien diente das im exil verfasste werk als modell um über das ihnen zugefügte leid zu schreiben franziska meier geht den überraschenden lebensspuren der commedia nach die sie um die ganze welt führen die weltweite wirkungsgeschichte der divina commedia dantes werk prägt unsere vorstellungen von paradies und hölle bis heute

the life and times of dante s soaring poetic allegory of the soul s redemptive journey toward god written during his exile from florence in the early 1300s dante alighieri s divine comedy describes the poet s travels through hell purgatory and paradise

focusing on modern day fiction set in the middle ages or that incorporates medieval elements this study examines storytelling components and rhetorical tropes in more than 60 works in five languages by more than 40 authors medievalist fiction got its postmodern start with such authors as calvino fuentes carpentier and eco its momentum increased since the 1990s with writers whose work has received less critical attention like laura esquivel tariq ali matthew pearl matilde asensi ildefonso falcones andrew davison bernard cornwell donnal woolfolk cross ariana franklin nicole griffith levi grossman conn iggulden edward rutherfurd javier sierra alan moore and brenda vantrease the author explores a wide range of medievalizing tropes discusses the negative responses of postmodernism and posits four hard problems in medievalist fiction

it s one of the most successful and surprising of phenomena in the entire crime fiction genre detectives and protodetectives solving crimes in earlier eras there is now an army of historical sleuths operating from the mean streets of ancient rome to the cold war era of the 1950s and this astonishingly varied offshoot of the crime genre as well as keeping bookshop tills ringing is winning a slew of awards notably the prestigious cwa historical dagger barry forshaw one of the uk s leading experts on crime fiction has written a lively wide ranging and immensely informed history of the genre historical noir began in earnest with ellis peters crime solving monk brother cadfael in the 1970s and umberto eco s the name of the rose in 1980 and has now taken readers to virtually every era and locale in the past as in nordic noir euro noir brit noir and american noir forshaw has produced the perfect reader s guide to a fascinating field every major writer is considered often through a concentration on one or two key books and exciting new talents are highlighted

finalist for the 2021 the next generation indie book award in the autobiography biography category presented by the independent book publishing professionals group bronze winner 2020 foreword indies book of the year award in the biography category in 1977 a thirty nine year old italian american professor of renaissance literature a bartlett giamatti was chosen as the next president of yale university a radical act that was immediately perceived as a threat to the university s embedded eugenics driven anglo saxon mentality eugenics as practiced in america and especially at yale locked into place those who were deemed unfit due to beliefs about their ethnicity class and racial character beliefs that had endured for decades and to which giamatti s selection as an italian american and therefore to some one of the unfit was an open rebuke in fearless neil thomas proto explores the origins of giamatti s ethical convictions including his insistence on fairness his respect for the duty of responsible citizenship and his advocacy for people on the margins proto argues that these convictions which would inform giamatti s time at yale as well as his brief tenure as commissioner of major league baseball can be understood only in the context of giamatti s family and the deeply entwined and conflicted histories of yale and new haven itself a history that giamatti who had been both a student and a professor at yale and who had italian american relatives in new haven knew very well historian sean wilentz wrote that bart giamatti was a phenomenon who lived the lives of several men even though his own ended tragically early giamatti confirmed his underlying imperative through to the end of his life rest he wrote will come by never resting fearless is a story about persistence against forces ugly embedded and more pernicious than simply racial and ethnic discrimination and about the principled embrace of civic duty passed on generationally and used fully as the ethical sword and shield necessary to challenge them

such as these after ernest hemingway survived two near fatal plane crashes during an african safari he perused his obituaries and sipped champagne on a canal side terrace in venice washington irving s wisteria draped cottage in the hudson valley was once occupied by members of the van tassel family immortalized in the legend of sleepy hollow a mysterious incident at a stone tower near dublin made such a vivid impression on james joyce that he drew on it for the opening scene of ulysses sir arthur conan doyle consulted on the mystery of agatha christie s 1926 disappearance before she resurfaced under an assumed name in northern england nathaniel hawthorne s the house of the seven gables was inspired by a seaside manse in salem massachusetts infamous witch trials in which his ancestor played a role

a richly detailed graveyard history of the florentine poet whose dead body shaped italy from the middle ages and the renaissance to the risorgimento world war i and mussolini s fascist dictatorship dante whose divine comedy gave the world its most vividly imagined story of the afterlife endured an extraordinary afterlife of his own exiled in death as in life the florentine poet has hardly rested in peace over the centuries like a saint s relics his bones have been stolen recovered reburied exhumed examined and above all worshiped actors in this graveyard history range from lorenzo de medici michelangelo and pope leo x to the franciscan friar who hid the bones the stone mason who accidentally discovered them and the opportunistic sculptor who accomplished what princes popes and politicians could not delivering to florence a precious relic of the native son it had banished in dante s bones guy raffa narrates for the first time the complete course of the poet s hereafter from his death and burial in ravenna in 1321 to a computer generated reconstruction of his face in 2006 dante s posthumous adventures are inextricably tied to major historical events in italy and its relationship to the wider world dante grew in stature as the contested portion of his body diminished in size from skeleton to bones fragments and finally dust during the renaissance a political and literary hero in florence in the nineteenth century the ancestral father and prophet of italy a nationalist symbol under fascism and amid two world wars and finally the global icon we know today

i m not yours i snap my eyes narrowing into slits as i glare at him a wicked grin curls on his lips oh but you are little deer how can you even begin to deny it he leans in closer his breath hot against my neck as he drags his nose along my skin inhaling deeply you let me touch you now you are mine i shake my head vigorously my voice trembling as i stammer i i wasn t awake i didn t know it was you i thought it was him the words spill out more an attempt to convince myself than to sway him his dark sinister laugh reverberates as he presses closer pinning me against the wall his body a cage around mine yet your eyes were fixed on his face weren t they little deer even as you came so hard around my fingers he s right my heart pounds as i recall the moment my gaze locked on justin terrified he would wake and discover us luna thought she had everything she wanted a loving relationship with her boyfriend justin and a life that felt secure but everything changed in a single haunting night for years luna had been living under the shadow of a mysterious stalker someone who invaded her apartment left unsettlingly sweet gifts and even stole her clothing she never imagined that the danger was closer than she could have ever suspected after a night of partying luna drifts off to sleep between justin and his best friend dante but what she doesn t know is that dante the man she trusted is the very stalker who has been obsessing over her for years and now with her so close his twisted desires are becoming impossible to resist luna is about to discover that the real threat has always been lying right beside her

the guiding principle of this volume is the concept of the artes liberales the trivium and quadrivium as branches of learning that are rooted in dante alighieris mind the present volume contains essays by leading international scholars on the various scientific and artistic disciplines which form the background sources and presence in dante s opus

paradise remains one of the essential works of world literature at least fifty english language versions of the inferno the first part of dante s poem appeared in the twentieth century alone if dante s divine comedy speaks to our present condition it is because it tells the story of everyman who sets out in search of salvation in this world dante composed his great poem in the spoken italian of his time he wrote about suffering bodies and human weakness and about divine ecstasy in words that have resonated with readers and writers for the last seven hundred years
