this book offers a detailed analysis of the gospel of thomas in its historic and literary context providing a new understanding of the genesis of the jesus tradition discovered in the twentieth century the non canonical gospel of thomas is an important early text whose origins and place in the history of christianity continue to be subjects of debate aiming to relocate the thomasine community in the wider context of early christianity this study considers the gospel of thomas as a bridge between the oral and literary phases of the christian movement it will therefore be useful for religion scholars working on biblical studies coptic codices gnosticism and early christianity

heresy is a central concept in the formation of orthodox christianity where does this notion come from this book traces the construction of the idea of heresy in the rhetoric of ideological disagreements in second temple jewish and early christian texts and in the development of the polemical rhetoric against heretics called heresiology here author robert royalty argues one finds the origin of what comes to be labelled heresy in the second century in other words there was such as thing as heresy in ancient jewish and christian discourse before it was called heresy and by the end of the first century the notion of heresy was integral to the political positioning of the early orthodox christian party within the roman empire and the range of other christian communities this book is an original contribution to the field of early christian studies recent treatments of the origins of heresy and christian identity have focused on the second century rather than on the earlier texts including the new testament the book further makes a methodological contribution by blurring the line between new testament studies and early christian studies employing ideological and post colonial critical methods

this volume three of a three volume set covers books not included in the new testament these books include the writings of the apostolic fathers who were church leaders and writers of the late first to mid second centuries along with apocryphal books both orthodox and gnostic among these apocryphal books are some that have received much publicity of late and from which many people derive their ideas of early christian history

what is love popular culture bombards us with notions of the intoxicating capacities of love or of beguiling women who can bewitch or heal to the point that it is easy to believe that such images are timeless and universal not so argues laine doggett in love cures aspects of love that are expressed in popular music such as love is a drug sexual healing and love potion number nine trace deep roots to old french romance of the high middle ages a young woman heals a poisoned knight a mother prepares a love potion for a daughter who will marry a stranger in a faraway land how can readers interpret such events in contrast to scholars who have dismissed these women as fantasy figures or labeled them witches doggett looks at them in the light of medical and magical practices of the high middle ages love cures argues that these practitioners as represented in romance have shaped modern notions of love love cures seeks to engage scholars of love marriage and magic in disciplines as diverse as literature history anthropology and philosophy

in seeking the imperishable treasure johnson tracks the use of a single saying of jesus over time and among theologically divergent authors and communities he identifies six different versions of the saying in the canonical gospels and epistles mark matthew luke john james and colossians as well as the gospel of thomas and q after tracing the tradition and redaction history of this wisdom admonition he observes at least two distinctly different wisdom themes that are applied to the saying the proper disposition of wealth and the search for knowledge wisdom or god what he discovers is a saying of jesus with roots in jewish wisdom and pietistic traditions as well as popular greek philosophy that proved amazingly adaptable in its application to differing social and rhetorical contexts of the first century

this collection of essays pursues two new approaches to q the speeches of jesus paralleled in the gospels of matthew and luke the essays in part one suggest that recent work in ethnopoetics the ethnography of performance and theory of verbal art especially that of john miles foley both complements and challenges standard approaches to the teaching of jesus they explore how q speeches might be appreciated as oral performance that resonates with listeners in a community context by referencing israelite popular tradition the essays in part two examine how the work of anthropologist and political scientist james c scott on popular tradition the moral economy of the peasant and hidden transcripts may illuminate the social context and political implications of q speeches from publisher s description
