The imperial and metric systems have different origins and base units, resulting in an approximate conversion factor. 5. What if I need to convert kilograms to ounces or pounds? First, convert kilograms to grams ($1\text{kg} = 1000\text{g}$), then use the gram-to-ounce conversion factor. To convert ounces to pounds, remember that there are 16 ounces in one pound.
