the anniversary edition marks thirty years of offering an indispensable review and analysis of thinkers who have exerted a profound influence on contemporary rhetorical theory i a richards ernesto grassi chaïm perelman and lucie olbrechts tyteca stephen toulmin richard weaver kenneth burke jürgen habermas bell hooks jean baudrillard and michel foucault the brief biographical sketches locate the theorists in time and place showing how life experiences influenced perspectives on rhetorical thought the concise explanations of complex concepts are clear engaging insightful and highly accessible serving as an excellent primer for reading the major works of these scholars the critical commentary is carefully chosen to highlight implications and to place the theories within a broader rhetorical context each chapter ends with a complete bibliography of works by the theorists

the realm of rhetoric follows in the tradition of the author s the new rhetoric hailed for its wide ranging and innovative approaches to argumentation in this new study chaïm perelman continues to develop his ideas on the theory of rhetoric now even more cogently and persuasively presented pruned of much detail present in the

earlier book this new work captures the essence of his thought in a style and presentation suitable to the program and needs of an english speaking audience it is an ideal instruction medium for students approaching theories of informal argumentation for the first time perelman raises the questions how do claims to reasonableness arise in prose that is not formally logical and what does reasonableness mean for some who speaks of reasonable men or beyond reasonable doubt he then shows how claims to rationality are embedded in a number of verbal structures heretofore considered exclusively ornamental or dispositional he identifies and discusses many argumentative techniques in addition to the quasi logical methods conventionally treated in textbooks and notes numerous subforms of argumentation within each of the general types he identifies

providing fully developed rhetorical theories from feminist perspectives this book offers coherent systematic overviews of complex large bodies of work and ideas relevant to rhetoric and communication the book presents theories developed from the work of nine feminist theorists each from diverse standpoints demonstrating the diversity of both feminism and feminist rhetorical theories chris kramarae bell hooks gloria anzaldúa mary daly starhawk paula gunn allen trinh t minh ha sally miller gearhart and sonia johnson the resulting theories differ substantially from traditional rhetorical theories and will encourage scholars to rethink many traditional rhetorical constructs

with writing without teachers oup 1975 and writing with power oup 1995 peter elbow revolutionized the teaching of writing his process method and its now commonplace free writing techniques liberated generations of students and teachers from the emphasis on formal principles of grammar that had dominated composition pedagogy this new collection of essays brings together the best of elbow's writing since the publication of embracing contraries in 1987 the volume includes sections on voice the experience of writing teaching and evaluation implicit throughout is elbow's commitment to humanizing the profession and his continued emphasis on the importance of binary thinking and nonadversarial argument the result is a compendium of a master teacher's thought on the relation between good pedagogy and good writing it is sure to be of interest to all professional teachers of writing and will be a valuable book for use in composition courses at all levels

historically and interrogating the definitions it proposes a glossary providing explanations of important concepts periods and individuals a selection of perspectives by major scholars and a collection of 13 readings and related commentaries focusing on the relationship of rhetoric to other fields

during their lives gilles deleuze and felix guattari were two of france s most prominent thinkers and their work continues to be a vital and influential part of critical theory the essays in this collection written by prominent scholars offer a new approach to their work unique in its emphasis on guattari both in conjunction with deleuze and independently this volume features an essay by deleuze himself and includes a comprehensive bibliography of guattari s and deleuze s work the body of work explored here spans three decades and cuts across the lines of philosophy political theory geography literature aesthetics and even the applied sciences readers unfamiliar with deleuze and guattari will gain a broad sense of their work from these pages specialists will discover new and different methods of understanding the contributions of these writers the essays map out a set of applications that rather than explain deleuze and guattari aim to extend and reinvent their thought in new and real life domains from cinema to the gulf war from quantum mechanics to the l a riots and from israel s deportation of palestinians to jean jacques rousseau s masochism overall the collection demonstrates the wide range of potential applications of deleuze s and guattari s theories and expands current readings of their work

images often circulate and transform across media genre and location at viral rates a four part case study of shepard fairey's now iconic obama hope image elucidates how images reassemble collective life as they actualize in different versions enter into various relations and spark a firework of activity across the globe while intent on tracking the rhetorical life of a single multiple image still life with rhetoric is most concerned with studying rhetoric in motion to account for an image's widespread circulation and emergent activities gries introduces iconographic tracking a digital research method for tracing an image's divergent rhetorical becomings yet gries also articulates a dynamic set of theoretical principles for studying rhetoric as a distributed generative and unforeseeable event that is applicable beyond the study of visual rhetoric with an eye toward futurity the strands of time beyond a thing's initial moment of production and delivery still life with rhetoric intends to be taken up by those interested in visual rhetoric research methods and theory

in a comparative appraisal of normative power ville sinkkonen constructs a three pronged analytical framework for the analysis of normative power a theoretical concept recently associated with studying the international role of the european union this toolkit allows him to compare the foreign policy conduct of the eu and the united states in the context of the january 25th 2011 revolution in egypt along three dimensions norms and identity means and paradoxes these components permit an in depth analysis of western norm promotion in the midst of the upheaval building on a large pool of source documents the monograph broadens the remit of normative power through its empirical bent comparative research set up and focus on a swiftly unfolding revolution transition complex in the process the prevalent discourse of the eu as a benign international actor is subjected to rigorous analytical scrutiny

the question of being was integral to the philosophy of martin heidegger 1889 1976 and was a large factor in the development of his political and aesthetic thought in heidegger and the question of national socialism bernhard radloff investigates the philosophical foundations and cultural context of heidegger s conception of being focusing on the idea of gestalt as the guiding thread that determined german conservative thought throughout the 1930s in doing so heidegger s philosophy is related to the whole of german society at the time a society in which gestalt was the guiding light and the ultimate aspiration of artists technicians and politicians throughout the book heidegger s own understanding of gestalt is used as a window to his thoughts on being which is conceived of as incorporated finite and historically situated in beings concentrating on the years between 1933 and 1942 radloff seeks to capture the response of heidegger s philosophy to national socialism examining key works and relating them to the literature of the german conservative revolution heidegger and

the question of national socialism is therefore a thorough treatment of his political philosophy as it relates to the question of being adopting both a historical and phenomenological approach to the subject this book is equally an examination of german conservative ideology a critique of technological determinism and a study of one of the most controversial philosophers of twentieth century

a classic in its field this pathbreaking book humanized the scientific rhetoric of economics to reveal its literary soul economics needs to admit that it like other sciences works with metaphors and stories its most mathematical and statistical moments are properly dominated by comparison and narration that is to say human persuasion the book was mccloskey s opening move in the development of a humanomics and unification of the sciences and the humanities on the field of ordinary business life

this pathbreaking study integrates the histories of rhetoric literacy and literary aesthetics up to the time of augustine focusing on western concepts of rhetoric as dissembling and of language as deceptive that swearingen argues have received curiously prominent emphasis in western aesthetics and language theory swearingen reverses the traditional focus on rhetoric as an oral agonistic genre and examines it instead as a paradigm for literate discourse she proposes that rhetoric and literacy have in the west disseminated the interrelated notions that through learning rhetoric individuals can learn to manipulate language and others that language is an unreliable manipulable and contingent vehicle of thought meaning and communication and that literature is a body of pretty lies and beguiling fictions in a bold concluding chapter swearingen aligns her thesis concerning early western literacy and rhetoric with contemporary critical and rhetorical theory with feminist studies in language psychology and culture and with studies of literacy in multi and cross cultural settings

this third volume like its predecessors adds to the growing body of literature concerned with the history of biblical interpretation with eighteen essays on nineteen biblical interpreters volume 3 expands the scope of scholars both traditional and modern covered in this now multivolume series each chapter provides a biographical sketch of its respective scholar s an overview of their major contributions to the field explanations of their theoretical and methodological approaches to interpretation and evaluations and applications of their methods by focusing on the contexts in which these scholars lived and worked these essays show what defining features qualify these scholars as pillars in the history of biblical interpretation while identifying a scholar as a pillar is somewhat subjective this volume defines a pillar as one who has made a distinctive contribution by using and exemplifying a clear method that has pushed the discipline forward at least within a given context and time period this volume is ideal for any class on the history of biblical interpretation and for those who want a greater understanding of how the field of biblical studies has developed and how certain interpreters have played a formative role in that development
