copying and transmission of texts over thousands of years and they do not suggest deliberate falsification of the text for dogmatic purposes such discrepancies do not alter the overall message of the bible that god so loved the world that he gave his one and only son so that everyone who believes in him will have eternal life john 3 16 the true message of jesus christ fails to persuasively demonstrate that man has corrupted the bible that the qur an is god s true and divinely inspired book and that jesus true message is that he is merely a prophet of allah rather than god s sacrificial lamb offered as the atoning sacrifice for our sins and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world 1 john 2 2 ultimately the book fails to defeat the hope given to all who put their faith and trust in jesus christ

## The Osteoclast: A Bone-Resorbing Powerhouse – A Q&A Approach

This ruffled border increases the surface area for efficient enzyme secretion and acidification.

II. The Mechanism of Bone Resorption: Q: How do osteoclasts break down bone? A: Osteoclasts achieve bone resorption through a tightly regulated multi-step process:

1. Attachment: Osteoclasts tightly adhere to the bone surface via integrins, proteins that act as "anchors." This forms a sealed compartment called the "resorption lacuna."

4. Transcytosis: The degraded bone components are then transported across the osteoclast and released into the extracellular space.
