of the three physicians at the battle of the little big horn doctor george edwin lord 1846 76 was the lone commissioned medical officer an assistant surgeon with the united states army s 7th cavalry one more soldier caught up in the u s government s efforts to fulfill what many people believed was the young country s manifest destiny a life cut short at the little big horn tells lord s story for the first time notable for its unique angle on custer s last stand and for its depiction of frontier era medicine the book is above all a compelling portrait of the making of an army medical professional in mid nineteenth century america drawing on newly discovered documents todd e harbun describes lord s education and training at bowdoin college in maine and the chicago medical college detailing what the study of medicine entailed at the time for a young man of promise held in universal esteem lord s time as a contract physician with the army took him in 1874 to the u s northern boundary survey from there harbun recounts how after a failed romance and the rigors of the u s army medical board examination the young doctor proceeded to his first and only appointment as a post surgeon at fort buford in dakota territory what followed of course was lord s service and his death in the little big horn campaign which this book shows us for the first time from the unique perspective of the surgeon a portrait of a singular figure in the milieu of the american military s nineteenth century medical elite a life cut short at the little big horn offers a close look at a familiar chapter in u s history and a reminder of the humanity lost in a battle that resonates to this day

in two years below the horn engineer andrew taylor vividly recounts his experiences and accomplishments during operation tabarin a landmark british expedition to antarctica to establish sovereignty and conduct science during the second world war when mental strain led the operation's first commander to resign taylor a military engineer with extensive prewar surveying experience became the first and only canadian to lead an antarctic expedition as commander of the operation taylor oversaw construction of the first permanent base on the antarctic continent at hope bay from there he led four man teams on two epic sledging journeys around james ross island overcoming arduous conditions and correcting cartographic mistakes made by previous explorers the editors detailed afterword draws on taylor's extensive personal papers to highlight taylor's achievements and document his significant contributions to polar science this book will appeal to readers interested in the history of polar exploration science and sovereignty it also sheds light on the little known contribution of a canadian to a distant theatre of the second world war the wartime service of major taylor reveals important new details about a groundbreaking operation that laid the foundation for the british antarctic survey and marked a critical moment in the transition from the heroic to the modern scientific era in polar exploration

new orleans is a kind of mecca for jazz pilgrims as whitney balliett once wrote this memoir tells the story of one aspiring pilgrim clive wilson who fell in love with new orleans jazz in his early teens while in boarding school in his native england it is also his story of gradually becoming disenchanted with his family and english environment and ultimately finding acceptance and a new home in new orleans the timing of his arrival at age twenty two just a few weeks after the signing of the 1964 civil rights act and the end of legal segregation placed him in a unique position with the mostly african american musicians in new orleans they showed him around brought him into their lives gave him music lessons and even hired him to play trumpet in brass bands in short wilson became more than a pilgrim he became an apprentice and for the first time legally in new orleans he could make that leap time of my life a jazz journey from london to new orleans tells the story of wilson's journey as he discovers the contrast between his imagined new orleans and its reality throughout he delivers his impressions and interactions with such local musicians as fat man williams manuel manetta punch miller and billie and dede pierce as his playing improves invitations to play in local bands increase eventually he joins in the jam and by doing so integrates the original tuxedo jazz band which had been in continuous existence since 1911 except for a brief epilogue this memoir ends in 1979 when wilson assembles his own band for the first time the original camellia jazz band with musicians who had been among his heroes when he first arrived in new orleans
