this text discusses how W. B. Yeats, Aleister Crowley, Ezra Pound and Robert Graves had access to the forbidden knowledge of the goddess these four poets experienced a confrontation with their unconscious and let the grace of the goddess touch their heart strings consequently through this surrendering they created avant garde poetry and were inspired to write seditious manifestos that would teach humanity an esoteric creed this creed based on humans eternal divine essence aspires to liberate the eternal feminine these poets became the instruments of the goddess as defenders of the light they took arms against the forces of inertia and proclaimed the Eleusis of a new faith this creed pledges to overthrow the anachronistic religious and social institutions and initiate a new world order and a new divinity based on the

ancient rites of the great goddess no matter how disparate these four were in character they shared the vision of transmitting esoteric knowledge to profane humanity they were specifically chosen by the goddess as her troubadours and they pave her way to the religious consciousness of the people

president his pivotal role in the velvet revolution and the modern czech republic makes him a key figure of the twentieth century michael zantovsky was one of havel s closest confidants they lived through the revolution and during havel s first presidency zantovsky was his press secretary speech writer and translator their friendship endured until havel s death in 2011 making him a rare witness to this most extraordinary life

chancellor rieger is leaving office but does leaving office necessarily mean that he his mistress and his extended family have to leave the state villa which has been their home for years while his former secretary and the former secretary to his former secretary grapple with the mechanics of change and his family prepare to vace an uncertain future the chancellor himself considers his legacy amid visits from journalists an infatuated student and his arch rival and possible successor patrick klein with echoes of both king lear and the cherry orchard vaclav havel s leaving addresses the themes of change dispossession and the transfer of power from one generation to the next the play received its english language world premiere at the orange tree theatre richmond in september 2008 leaving is vaclav havel s first play since he was propelled to political office in 1989

symbolism and politics is a timely intervention into ongoing debates around the function of political symbols in a historical period characterized by volatile electoral behaviour fragmented societies in search of collective identifications and increasingly polarized political models symbols are central features of organized human life helping to define perception shaping the way we view the world and understand what goes on within it but despite this key role in shaping understanding there is never a single interpretation of a symbol that everyone within the community will accept and the way in which symbols can mobilize antagonistic political factions demonstrates that they are as much a central element in power struggles as they are avenues to facilitate processes of identification this dual potential is the object of discussion in the chapters of this book which sheds new light on our understanding of the political function of symbols in a historical period symbolism and politics will be of great interest to scholars working on political symbols nationalism regime change and political transitions the chapters originally published as a special issue of politics religion ideology

the encyclopedia of american poetry the twentieth century contains over 400 entries that treat a broad range of individual poets and poems along with many articles devoted to topics schools or periods of american verse in the century entries fall into three main categories poet entries which provide biographical and cultural contexts for the author s career entries on individual works which offer closer explication of the most resonant poems in the 20th century canon and topical entries which offer analyses of a given period of literary production school thematically constructed category or other verse tradition that historically has been in dialogue with the poetry of the united states

with the canon debate prominent in literary criticism since the early 1970s as the sounding board the study aims at investigating and discussing in critical perspective the function of considerations to do with canon for literary criticism at the formation stage it focuses on the interaction between a critic s canonical preferences versions of the past and his desire for improved cultural and or aesthetic conditions visions of

the future in the criticism of eliot leavis frye and bloom

critical tradition has established a certain way of reading ezra pound one that places the meanings of the words on the page at the centre of interest and neglects poetic communication the present study contributes to the recent challenge to this critical orthodoxy which has led to his canonization as a difficult poet by investigating the pragmatic dimension of pound s work in its effort to reconstruct the dynamic communicative interface of pound and his audiences in the early period of his career 1908 1925 this study draws on relevance theory a recent sharpening in pragmatic theory not so much to produce a new reading of his poetry but to suggest how pound became difficult it is argued that the relative success and failure of his poetry to enhance cognitive and civic renewal depended on the dialectic between his presumptions of audience and the interpretive expectations and skills of his actual historical readers

the first full length study of heaney s poetics professing poetry explores heaney s unusual concept of influence and the various ways in which heaney interacts with other writers

collecting in full for the first time the correspondence between ezra pound and members of leo frobenius forschungsinstitut für kulturmorphologie in frankfurt across a 30 year period this book sheds new light on an important but previously unexplored influence on pound s controversial intellectual development in the fascist era ezra pound s long term interest in anthropology and ethnography exerted a profound influence on early 20th century literary modernism these letters reveal the extent of the influence of frobenius concept of paideuma on pound s poetic and political writings during this period and his growing engagement with the culture of nazi germany annotated throughout the letters are supported by contextualising essays by leading modernist scholars as well as relevant contemporary published articles by pound himself and his leading correspondent at the institute the american douglas c fox

this book examines orpheus as a figure who bridges the experience of the greek tribal

shaman and the modern poet stéphane mallarmé the father of modernism first mentioned in 600 b c orpheus was present at the moment when the apolline forms of western culture were being encoded he appears again at the opposite moment embodied in the language crisis at the end of the nineteenth century which inaugurated the break up of those forms and ushered in the dionysian mallarmé s orphic moment when orpheus s scattered limbs first begin to stir back to life enacts a dance at the boundary of apollo and dionysos marking the collapse of apolline form back into its dionysian ground in nietzsche s the birth of tragedy

derived from the parent guide to literature in english this volume offers in concise form over 4 000 entries on literature in english from cultures throughout the world writers and major works from the uk and the usa are represented as are those from canada the caribbean australia india and africa the coverage is broad from the classics of english literature to the best of modern writing additionally the guide has a wealth of entries on literary movements groups or schools in literature and criticism literary magazines genres and sub genres critical concepts and rhetorical terms

in the half century between 1890 and 1950 a variety of fields and disciplines from musicology and literary studies to biology psychology genetics and eugenics expressed a profound interest in the subject of rhythm in this book michael golston recovers much of the work done in this area and situates it in the society politics and culture of the modernist period he then filters selected modernist poems through this archive to demonstrate that innovations in prosody form and subject matter are based on a largely forgotten ideology of rhythm and that beneath modernist prosody is a science and an accompanying technology in his analysis golston first examines psychological and physiological experiments that purportedly proved that races responded differently to rhythmic stimuli he then demonstrates how poets like ezra pound w b yeats mina loy and william carlos williams either absorbed or echoed the information in these studies using it to hone the innovative edge of modernist practice and fundamentally alter the way poetry was written golston performs close readings of canonical texts such as pound s cantos yeats s lake isle of innisfree and william carlos williams s paterson and examines the role the sciences of rhythm played in racist discourses and fascist political thinking in the years leading up to world war ii recovering obscure texts written in france germany england and america golston argues that rhythmic was instrumental in generating an international modern art and should become a major consideration in our reading of reactionary avant garde poetry

the city is an essential theme of modernity in literature architecture photography and film this book first focuses on ardent reactions to the metropolitan explosion in the nineteenth century with baudelaire and poe as key figures more recent

representations of the city are then investigated in europe and the united states lombardo reflects on the way in which the changes in human perception created by urbanization are expressed in the various arts in terms of form and content

provides up to date profiles on the careers of leading and emerging poets

what exactly is modernism and how and why has its definition changed over time modernism evolution of an idea is the first book to trace the development of the term modernism from cultural debates in the early twentieth century to the dynamic contemporary field of modernist studies rather than assuming and recounting the contributions of modernism s chief literary and artistic figures this book focuses on critical formulations and reception through topics such as the evolution of modernism from a pejorative term in intellectual arguments through its condemnation by pope pius x in 1907 and on to its subsequent centrality to definitions of new art by t s eliot laura riding and robert graves f r leavis edmund wilson and clement greenberg new criticism and its legacies in the formation of the modernist canon in anthologies classrooms and literary histories the shifting conceptions of modernism during the rise of gender and race studies french theory marxist criticism postmodernism and more the new modernist studies and its contemporary engagements with the politics institutions and many cultures of modernism internationally with a glossary of key terms and movements and a capacious critical bibliography this is an essential survey for students and scholars working in modernist studies at all levels

this collection offers for the first time criticism biographical essays analysis translation studies and reminiscences of ezra pound s extensive interaction with spain and spanish culture from his earliest visits to spain in 1902 and 1906 and his study of significant spanish writers to the dedication of the first monument erected anywhere to pound in the small spanish village of medinaceli in 1973 divided into two sections part one on ezra pound and the spanish world includes a general introduction on pound s lifelong involvement with spain together with chapters on pound s study of classical spanish literature the spanish dimension in the cantos pound s contemporary spanish connections and his legacy in contemporary spanish letters part two ezra pound and the spanish world a reader then gathers for the first time pound s own writings postcards letters and essays concerning spain and spanish writers as well as his correspondence with spanish poets migeul de unamuno and juan ramón jiménez and with josé vázquez amara! the first spanish translator of the cantos in its entirety the volume includes reminiscences by spanish novísimos poets antonio colinas and jaime siles written explicitly for this collection besides providing a thorough exploration into pound s engagement with spain this volume pays homage to pound s considerable influence on spanish culture
