This strategy is typically employed when immediate evacuation is deemed too dangerous or impractical due to the nature of the threat, the surrounding environment, or limited time available.

### When is Defend in Place Appropriate?

The appropriateness of a "defend in place" strategy hinges heavily on the specific nature of the emergency. It is generally recommended when: Evacuation is too dangerous: During a blizzard, a flash flood, or a rapidly approaching wildfire, evacuating might expose individuals to greater risks than sheltering in place. Evacuation is impossible: If a building is surrounded by a hazardous material spill or an active shooter situation makes exiting extremely dangerous, staying put and securing the perimeter becomes the safer option. Time is limited: In sudden emergencies like tornadoes or bomb threats, the time it takes to evacuate may exceed the time needed for the threat to pass.
