in the 1960s americans combined psychedelics with buddhist meditation to achieve direct experience through altered states of consciousness as some practitioners became more committed to buddhism they abandoned the use of psychedelics in favor of stricter mental discipline but others carried on with the experiment advancing a fascinating alchemy called psychedelic buddhism many think exploration with psychedelics in buddhism faded with the revolutionary spirit of the sixties but the underground practice has evolved into a brand of religiosity as eclectic and challenging as the era that created it altered states combines interviews with well known figures in american buddhism and psychedelic spirituality including lama surya das erik davis geoffrey shugen arnold sensei rick strassman and charles tart and personal stories of everyday practitioners to define a distinctly american

religious phenomenon the nuanced perspective that emerges grounded in a detailed history of psychedelic religious experience adds critical depth to debates over the controlled use of psychedelics and drug induced mysticism the book also opens new paths of inquiry into such issues as re enchantment the limits of rationality the biochemical and psychosocial basis of altered states of consciousness and the nature of subjectivity

in these wide ranging essays erik davis explores the codes spiritual cultural and embodied that people use to escape the limitation of their lives and enrich their experience of the world these include asian religious traditions and west african trickster gods western occult and esoteric lore postmodern theory and psychedelic science as well as festival scenes such as burning man of which davis is the best known chronicler articles on media technology further explore themes davis took up in his acclaimed book techgnosis while his profiles of west coast poets musicians and mystics extend the california terrain he previously mapped in the visionary state whether his subject is collage art or the magical realism of horror writer h p lovecraft transvestite burmese spirit mediums or ufology tripster king terence mckenna or dub maestro lee perry davis writes with keen yet skeptical sympathy intellectual subtlety and wit and unbridled curiosity the common thread running through all these pieces is what davis calls modern esoterica which he describes in his preface as a no man s land located somewhere between anthropology and mystical pulp between the zendo and the metal club between cultural criticism and extraordinary experience whether psychedelic or yogic or technological such an ambiguous and startling landscape demands that the intrepid adventurer shed any territorial claims and go nomad davis wanders with sharp eyes and an open mind which is why peter lamborn wilson calls him the best of all guides to modern american spirituality

naturally occurring dmt may produce prophecy like states of consciousness and thus represent a bridge between biology and religious experience reveals the striking similarities between the visions of the hebrew prophets and the dmt state described by strassman s research volunteers explains how prophetic and psychedelic states may share biological mechanisms presents a new top down theoneurological model of spiritual experience after completing his groundbreaking research chronicled in dmt the spirit molecule rick strassman was left with one fundamental question what does it mean that dmt a simple chemical naturally found in all of our bodies instantaneously opens us to an interactive spirit world that feels more real than our own world when his decades of clinical psychiatric research and buddhist practice were unable to provide answers to this question strassman

began searching for a more resonant spiritual model he found that the visions of the hebrew prophets such as ezekiel moses adam and daniel were strikingly similar to those of the volunteers in his dmt studies carefully examining the concept of prophecy in the hebrew bible he characterizes a prophetic state of consciousness and explains how it may share biological and metaphysical mechanisms with the dmt effect examining medieval commentaries on the hebrew bible strassman reveals how jewish metaphysics provides a top down model for both the prophetic and dmt states a model he calls theoneurology theoneurology bridges biology and spirituality by proposing that the divine communicates with us using the brain and dmt whether naturally produced or ingested is a critical factor in such visionary experience this model provides a counterpoint to neurotheology which proposes that altered brain function simply generates the impression of a divine human encounter theoneurology addresses issues critical to the full flowering of the psychedelic drug experience perhaps even more important it points the way to a renewal of classical prophetic consciousness the soul of hebrew bible prophecy as well as unexpected directions for the evolution of contemporary spiritual practice

why do people seek a connection to something beyond the social dimensions of the world ecstatic experiences are often labelled religious spiritual mystical or even sacred however ecstasy is not just extraordinary for many people throughout the world it is an ordinary part of daily life the handbook highlights the diverse individuals who have experienced ecstasy in the past and present from ordinary people to mystics pastors healers spirit mediums and urban neo therapeutic shamans chapters show that ecstasy may be experienced during trance possession prayer and even through the use of drugs such as soma peyote ayahuasca ibogaine mushrooms lsd and other substances while institutional expressions of religion may be on the decline experiences of religious ecstasy and interactions among living people and gods saints angels and demons individually and collectively are happening everywhere occurring at home online in the community and through prayer dance song possession and the ingestion of drugs ecstatic religious experience as this handbook shows provides meaning belonging and for some profit in the late capitalist marketplace

cadre of monks drawing on interviews with noted teachers and lay practitioners as well as a survey completed by members of seven north american buddhist centers coleman depicts the colorful variety of new buddhists today from dilettantes to devoted students and the dedicated teachers who guide their spiritual progress he also details the problems that have arisen because of some western influences especially with regard to gender roles sex and power exploring the appeal of this exotic faith in postmodern society and questioning its future in a global consumer culture the new buddhism provides a thorough and fascinating guide to western buddhism today

concerned with scholarly popular and religious backdrops that understand the connection between psychedelics and mystical experiences to be devoid of moral concerns and ethical dimensions a position supported empirically by the rise of acid fascism and psychedelic cults by the late 1960s psychedelic mysticism transforming consciousness religious experiences and voluntary peasants in postwar america traces the development of sixties psychedelic mysticism from the deconditioned mind and perennial philosophy of aldous huxley to the sacramental ethics of timothy leary richard alpert and ralph metzner to the altruistic religiosity practiced by stephen gaskin and the farm building directly off the pioneering psychedelic writing of huxley these psychedelic mystics understood the height of psychedelic consciousness as an existential awareness of unitive oneness a position that offered worldly alternatives to the maladies associated with the postwar moment e g vapid consumerism and materialism lifeless conformity unremitting racism heightened

militarism in opening a doorway to a common world morgan shipley locates how psychedelics challenged the coherency of western modernity by fundamentally reorienting postwar society away from neoliberal ideologies and toward a sacred understanding of reality defined by mutual coexistence and responsible interdependence in 1960s america psychedelics catalyzed a religious awakening defined by compassion expressed through altruism and actualized in projects that sought to ameliorate the conditions of the least advantaged among us in the exact moments that historians and cultural critics often locate as signaling the death knell of the counterculture gaskin and the farm emerged not as a response to the perceived failures of the hippies nor as an alternative to sixties politics but in an effort to fulfill the religious obligation to help teach the world how to live more harmoniously today as we continue to confront issues of socioeconomic inequality entrenched differences widespread violence and the limits of religious pluralism psychedelic mysticism serves as a timely reminder of how religion in america can operate as a tool for destabilization and as a means to actively reimagine the very basis of how people relate such a legacy can aid in our own efforts to build a more peaceful sustainable and compassionate world
