a lengthy historical novel written because joan of arc was clemens favorite historical character he stated it means more to me than anything i have ever undertaken clemens devoted twelve years to researching and writing this novel harper s magazine serialized it first in three monthly installments april 1895 april 1896 without his name he used the pseudonym sieur louis de conte to prevent the work s not being taken seriously under his own name while the name of the translator jean francois alden is referred to as a pun on john alden this edition contains many of the fine drawings that had appeared in the periodical from a centennial for tom sawyer

casual stargazers are familiar with many classical figures and asterisms composed of bright stars e g orion and the plough but this book reveals not just the constellations of today but those of yesteryear the history of the human identification of constellations among the stars is explored through the stories of some influential celestial cartographers whose works determined whether new inventions survived the history of how the modern set of 88 constellations was defined by the professional astronomy community is recounted explaining how the constellations described in the book became permanently extinct dr barentine

addresses why some figures were tried and discarded and also directs observers to how those figures can still be picked out on a clear night if one knows where to look these lost constellations are described in great detail using historical references enabling observers to rediscover them on their own surveys of the sky treatment of the obsolete constellations as extant features of the night sky adds a new dimension to stargazing that merges history with the accessibility and immediacy of the night sky

this excellent collection brings together mark twain s longer major books and a fine selection of shorter pieces and science fiction books this books created and collected in mark twain s most important works illuminate the life and work of one of the most individual writers of the xx century a man who elevated political writing to an art samuel langhorne clemens november 30 1835 april 21 1910 known by his pen name mark twain was an american writer humorist entrepreneur publisher and lecturer he was lauded as the greatest humorist the united states has produced and william faulkner called him the father of american literature his novels include the adventures of tom sawyer 1876 and its sequel the adventures of huckleberry finn 1884 the latter often called the great american novel twain was raised in hannibal missouri which later provided the setting for tom sawyer and huckleberry finn he served an apprenticeship with a printer and then worked as a typesetter contributing articles to the newspaper of his older brother orion clemens he later became a riverboat pilot on the mississippi river before heading west to join orion in nevada he referred humorously to his lack of success at mining turning to journalism for the virginia city territorial enterprise 5 his humorous story the celebrated jumping frog of calaveras county was published in 1865 based on a story that he heard at angels hotel in angels camp california where he had spent some time as a miner the short story brought international attention and was even translated into french 6 his wit and satire in prose and in speech earned praise from critics and peers and he was a friend to presidents artists industrialists and european royalty twain earned a great deal of money from his writings and lectures but he invested in ventures that lost most of it such as the paige compositor a mechanical typesetter that failed because of its complexity and imprecision he filed for bankruptcy in the wake of these financial setbacks but in time overcame his financial troubles with the help of henry huttleston rogers he eventually paid all his creditors in full even though his bankruptcy relieved him of having to do so twain was born shortly after an appearance of halley s comet and he predicted that he would go out with it as well he died the day after the comet made its closest approach to the earth this collection included tom sawyer series the adventures of
